

How to save page scroll positions on Chrome

The Scroll In Chrome extension will save the location of the page scroll, helping you find the right content position.

There is already a bookmark feature on the browser to save the web page when you need to find and read the content, but if you want to find the right location, you have to search manually. If you want to quickly find the content that has scrolled to the website, you can install the Scroll In utility. The utility will save all positions on the page that users scroll until they save. When you want to reopen the content, the Scroll In utility will move to that location. This saves users time searching and scrolling. The following article will show you how to use the Scroll In utility on Chrome.

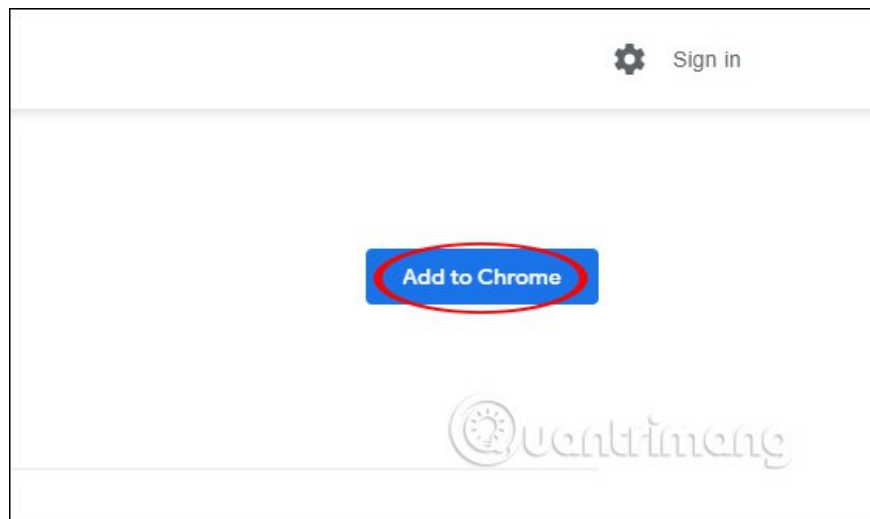

Instructions for saving page scrolling locations in Chrome

Step 1:

Users install the Scroll In utility for Chrome browser by following the link below.

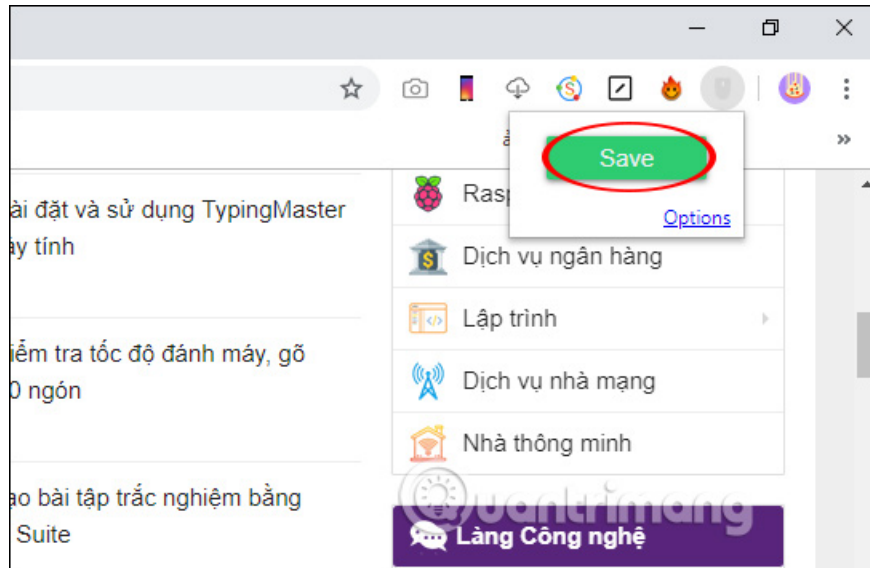
1. Download the Scroll In extension on Chrome



Step 2:

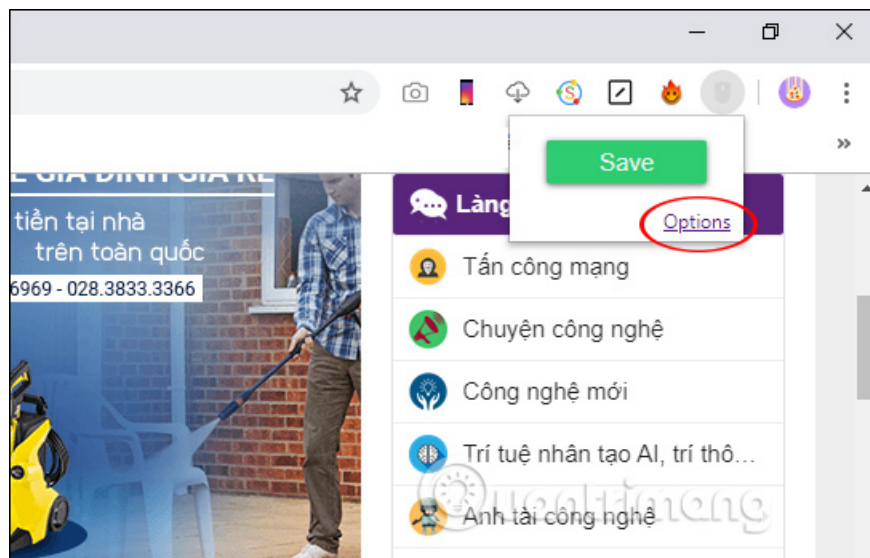
Now open the web page and **scroll to the location where you want to save the content** , then click **the Scroll In utility icon again** on the browser toolbar.

Display a small frame, click **the Save button** to save the correct location on the site.

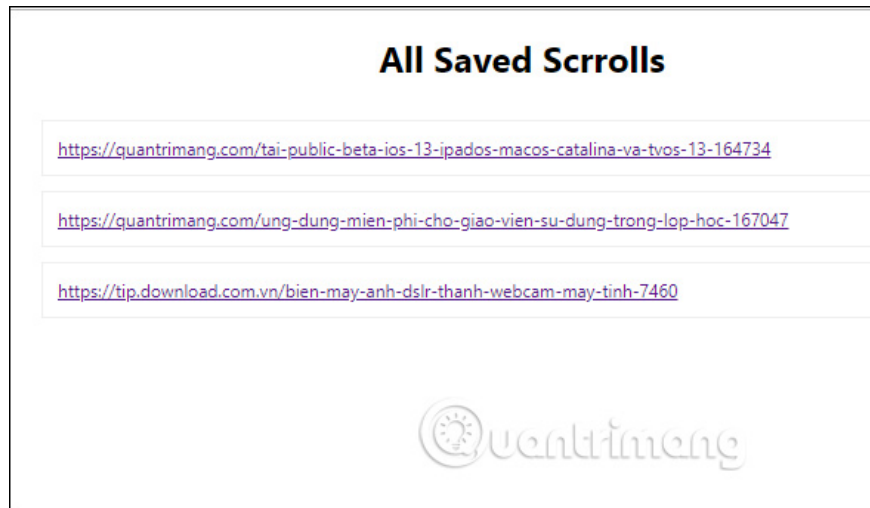


Step 3:

Now you need to revisit the saved location, then click the Scroll In icon again. Continue to click the **Options** .

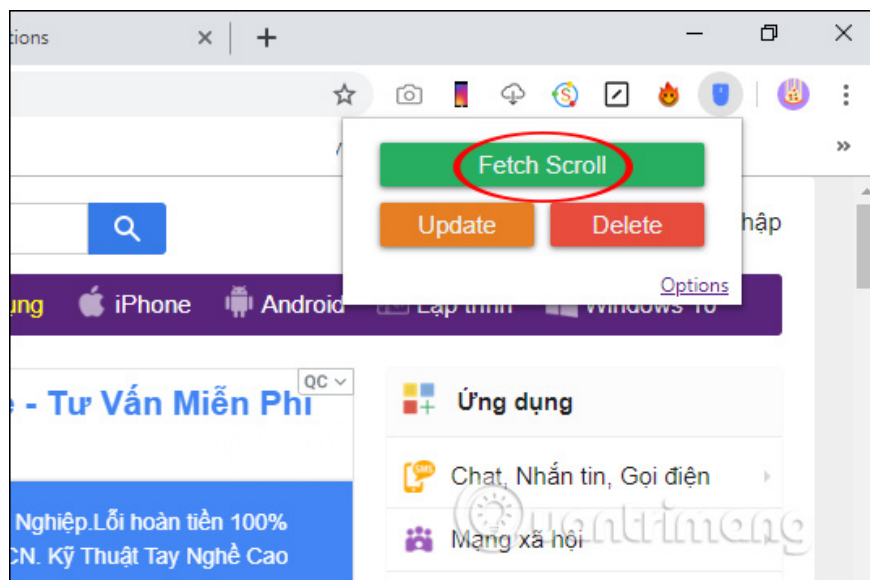


The user is then redirected to the new interface with the web page where the user has saved the page scrolling position. Here you click on the site to find content.



Step 4:

At the web page where you have saved the location of the scroll, we click on the widget icon in the address bar of the browser and then click on Fetch Scroll. At that point, you will be moved to the position where the previous page scrolled. In addition, in this interface, users will also see the Delete option to delete the saved scroll location and Update to change the new saving location.



With the help of the browser Scroll In utility, the Chrome browser helps users to browse the web faster. All web pages that have been saved location will be saved as browser bookmarks.
