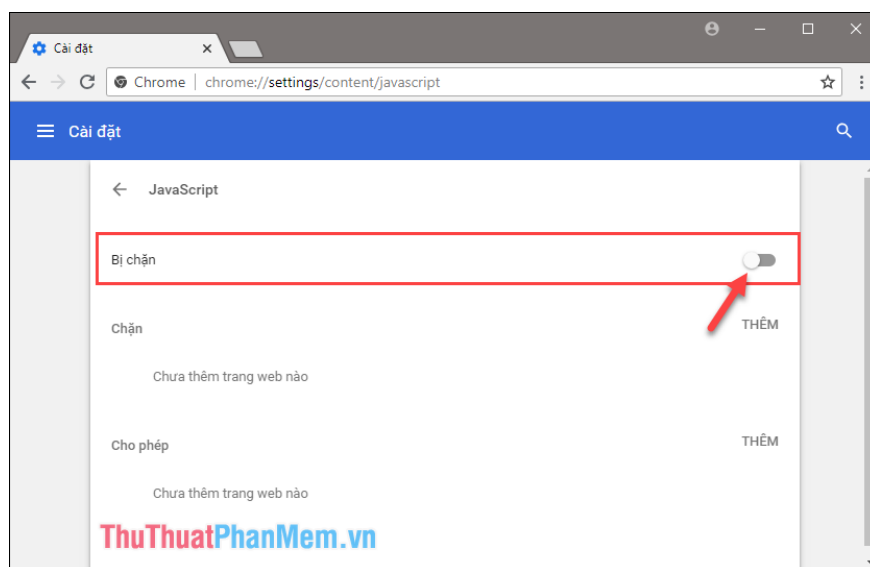
In the process of surfing the web, you will probably come across some websites that block the copy feature or block the right-click menu to prevent the copying of content and images from that website. But nothing is impossible, we can still completely copy the content of that site with just a few simple steps. To know how to do it, please follow the article below of TipsMake.com.

Method 1: Disable JavaScript

The essence of the anti-copy is that they will use a javascript (js) code to disable the right-click menu, so we just need to turn off the browser js to be able to use the right-click menu normal.

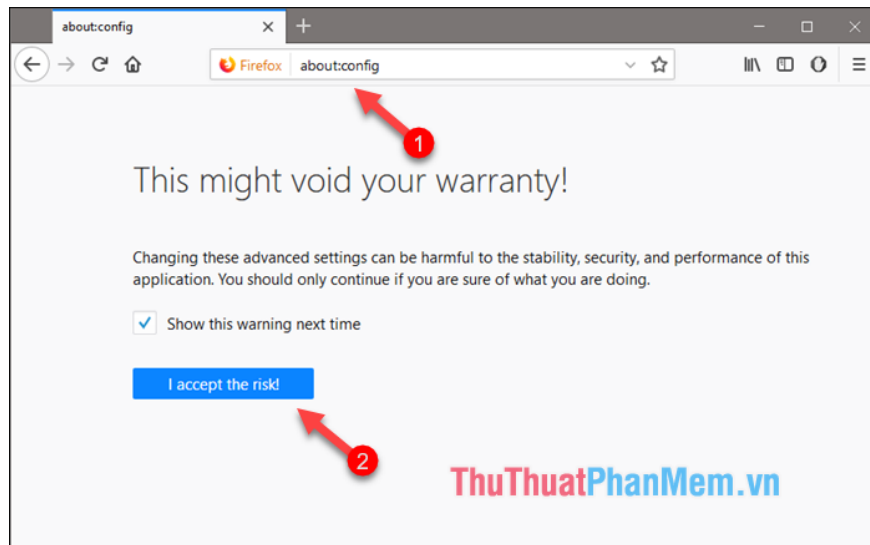
To disable Javascript in **Chrome**, please copy the following link in the address box and press Enter: **chrome://settings/content/javascript**

You will be taken to the javascript settings page, where you can turn off js by pushing the button to the status of **Blocked** :

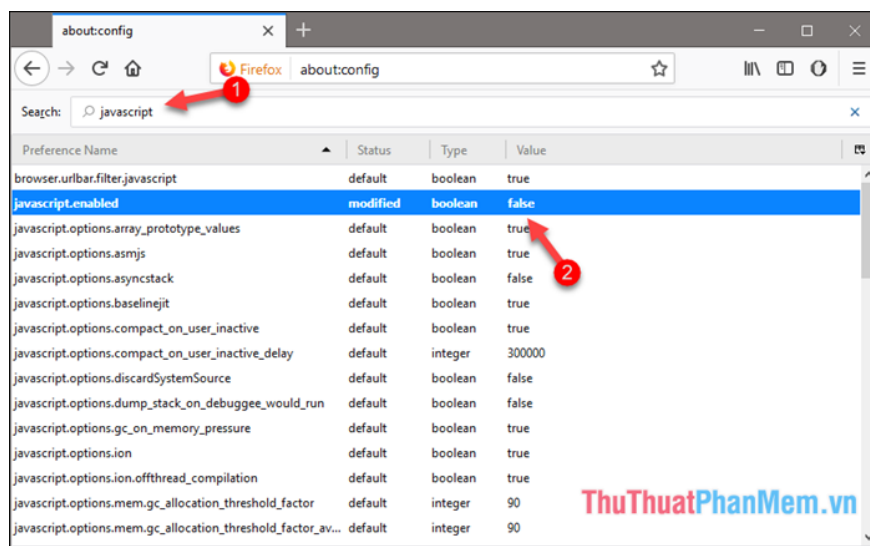


After turning off javascript, please reload the website and copy as usual.

For FireFox browser enter **about: config** in the address box and press Enter, then click **I accept the risk!**



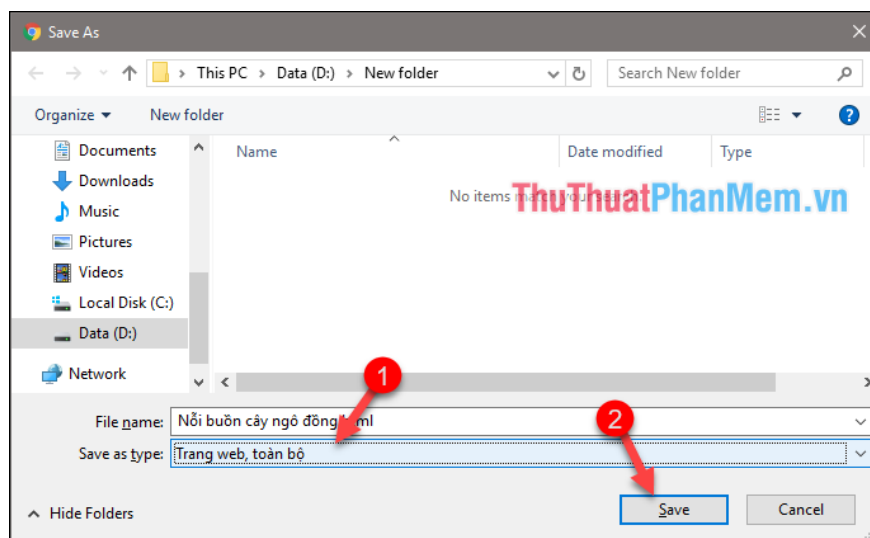
In the new window, enter Javascript in the search box, then find **Javascript.enabled** and double click so that the value changes from **true** to **false** .



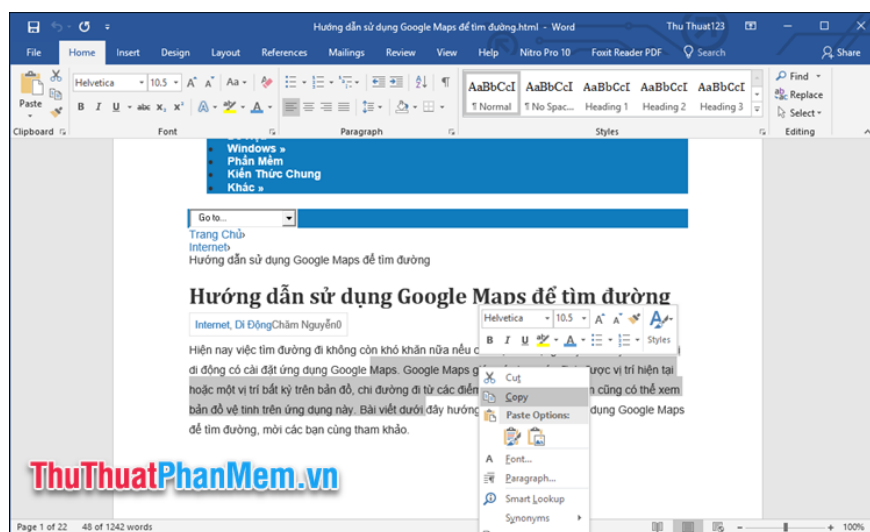
Now you can reload the page and copy normally. Note after the copy is complete you turn on javascript.

Method 2: Save the web page to copy image content

This way you open the site to copy the content then press **Ctrl + S** , a new window appears, choose to save the entire website and then click **Save**.



After downloading, we will have an html file and a folder, in this folder will contain all the images on that website. If you want to copy the content, right-click on the HTML file and select **Open with -> Word** and now you can copy the content of the web page easily.



Method 3: Use the printer mode

Open the website you want to copy content and press **Ctrl + P** to open print mode. At this time, the print window appears, you can highlight the content of the website and copy as usual, but this way, you can only copy text, not images.
