

How to schedule automatic file deletion in the folder Download Windows 10

On Windows 10, there is a new feature that automatically deletes the data in the Download section within 30 days, if the user does not have any changes.

In addition to using additional system cleaning software such as CCleaner or Clean Master, we can use automatic scanning of junk files on Windows 10 systems.

On Windows 10 there is a set of Storage Sense with features to automatically delete junk files, file cache or even files in the Downloaded folder under fixed time for about 30 days. When users turn on these options, we will not have to delete the junk files manually. This is also considered to be one of the ways **to speed up Windows 10 computers** , preventing junk files from taking up memory on the system.

And according to the default settings, the Storage Sense feature including deleting files in the Download section is turned off on the system so users need to re-enable the feature manually, with the following article of Network Administrator. .

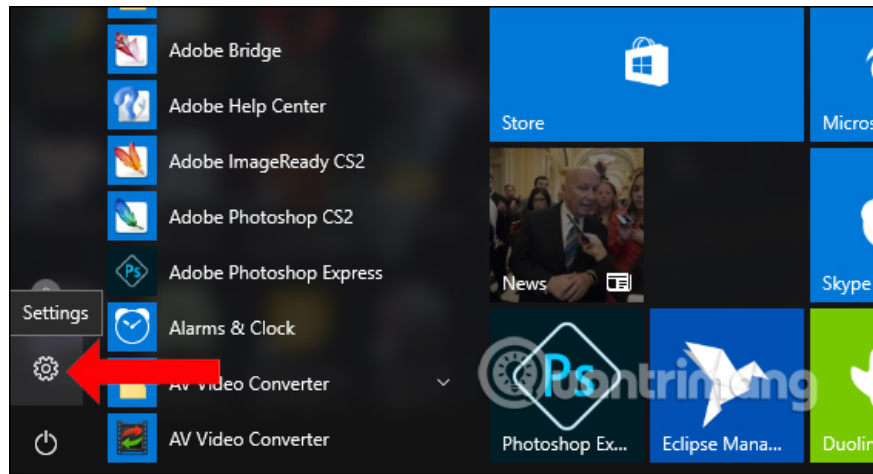

How to delete downloaded files automatically after 30 days

Note to users , not all data in Download will delete automatically after 30 days. Only files that do not have any changes after 30 days will be deleted from the directory only. Files that have changed, such as installing certain software files in the Download section, or editing certain files in this folder will be kept.

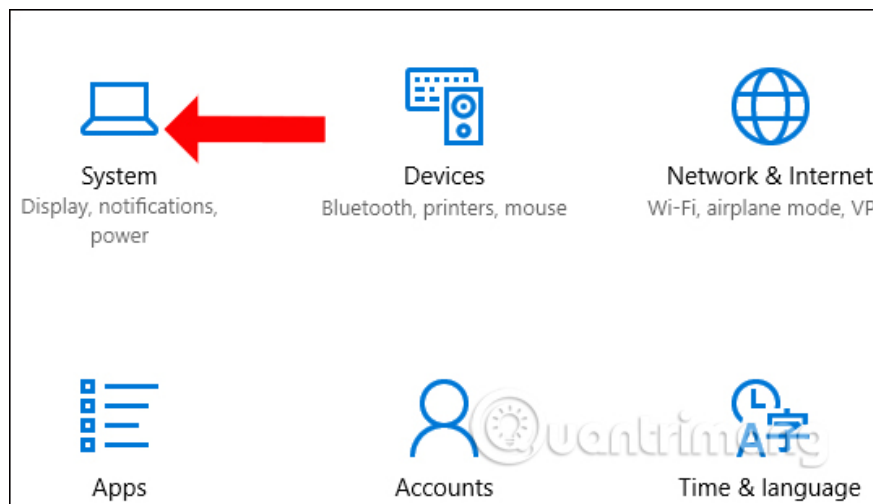
Step 1:

First, go to Settings on the system or press Windows + I key combination to quickly open the Windows Settings interface on the system.



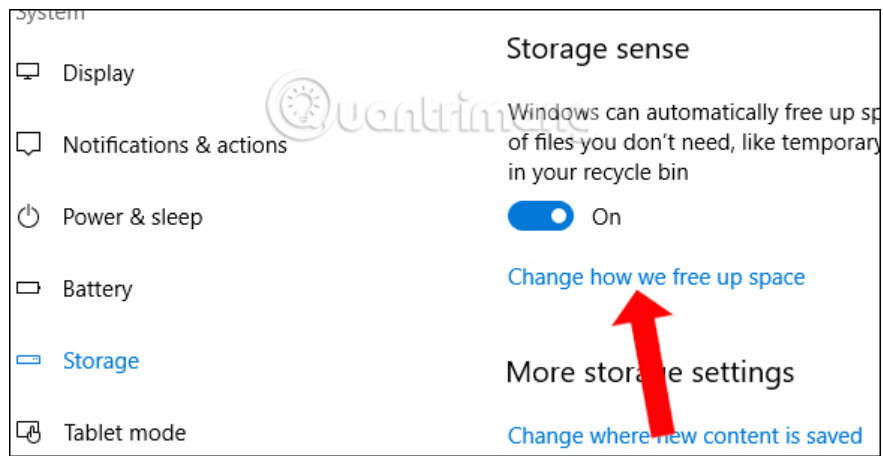
Step 2:

At the new interface, we click on **System settings** .



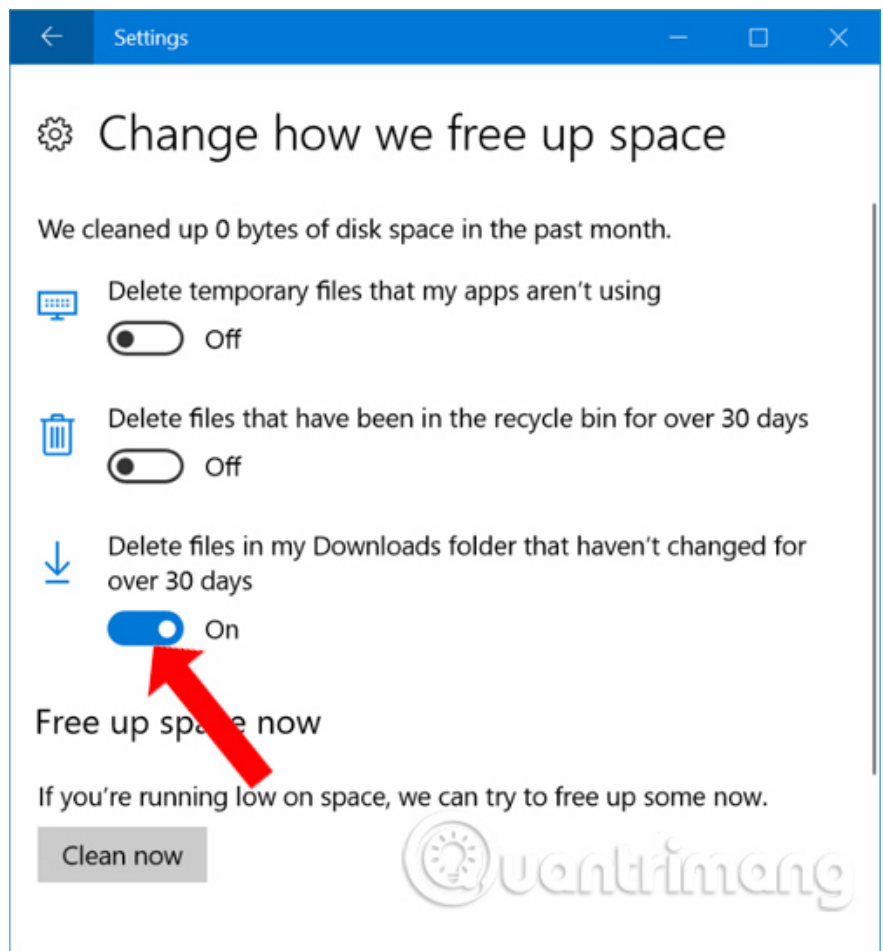
Step 3:

Switch to the new interface, users click on **Storage settings** in the list to the left of the interface. Look to the right of the **Storage Sense** section, turn on the switch to **On mode** . Continue to click **Change how we free up space** .



Step 4:

In the Change how we interface free up space, **push the horizontal bar to the right in Delete files in my Downloads folder that has not been changed for over 30 days**, to turn on the feature to automatically delete data in the Download folder.



Thus, with the feature to automatically delete the data in the Download folder of drive C, the files without changes, use will be deleted after 30 days of storage. In addition, you should also enable automatic deletion of data in the trash, and delete temporary files of applications that are no longer used and installed on the computer.
