How to find empty folders in Windows

Find empty Windows folders via Windows Explorer

In the Windows Explorer interface, enter the search command in the search bar **kind:folder size:empty or empty** and press Enter.

The search function will show all empty files and folders.

Use Command Prompt to find empty folders

You **open the Run dialog box** then **type cmd** in the search bar and **press Ctrl + Shift + Enter** to run as Admin.

Next, type the file path starting with 'cd' and press Enter, for example 'cd %USERPROFILE%\Documents'.

In a directory, your command format would be `dir [/drive letter] /B [lists file names] /S [if you want to search subdirectories] | find '0 Folder(s)`. Press Enter to search the contents.

Use PowerShell to find empty folders
