

How to share original quality photos via AirDrop on iOS 13

With a new feature in AirDrop iOS 13 that helps users retain the quality of video or image when sharing.

AirDrop is a very useful data sharing feature on iOS devices without the need for additional cables or supporting applications. With iOS 13, AirDrop has been upgraded to add some features to improve data sharing. Especially to mention sharing photos and videos with high quality equivalent to the original file. In addition, this feature retains all sharing history, as well as descriptions, keywords of photos and videos.

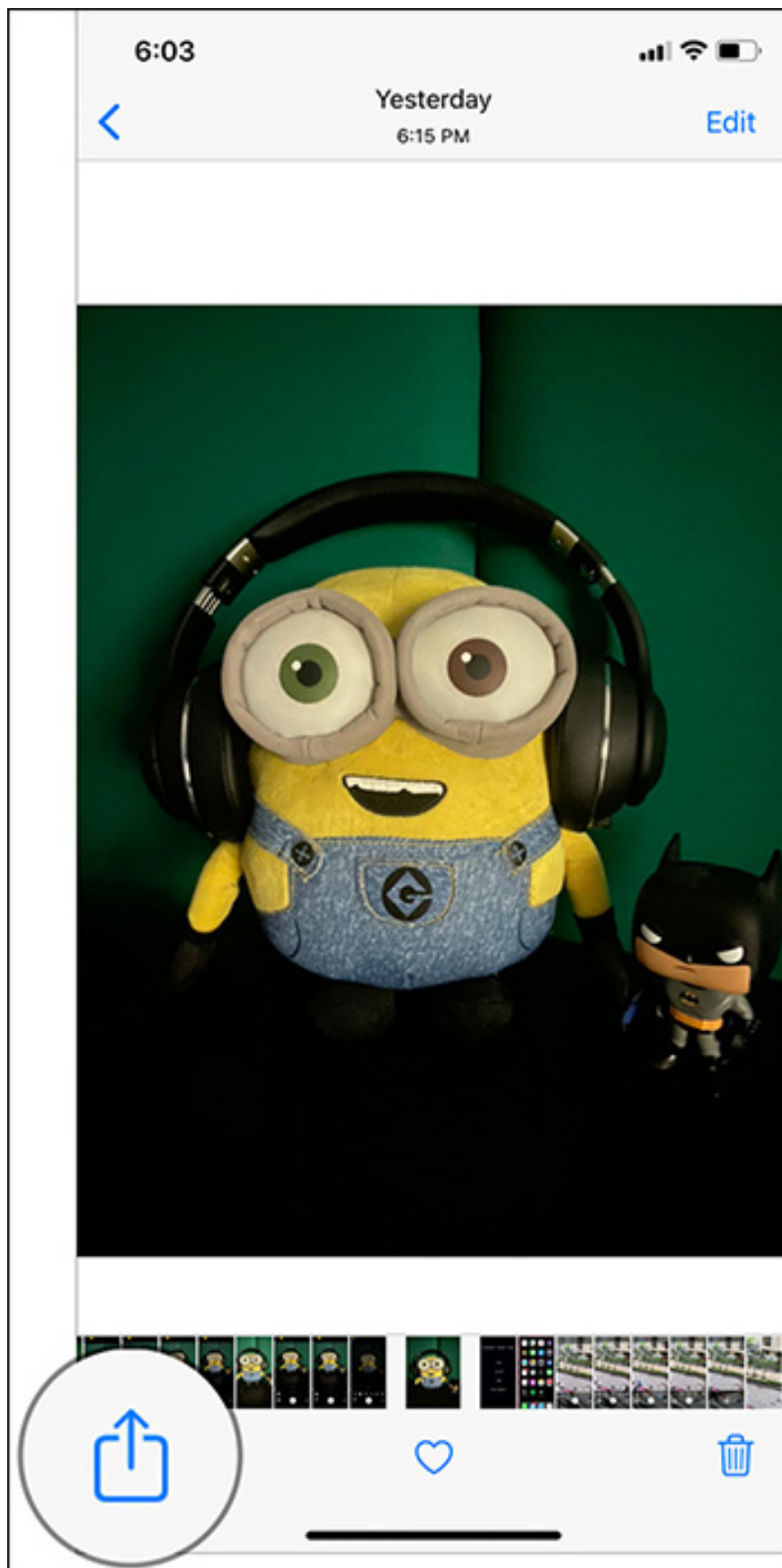

Instructions to share photos on AirDrop iOS 13

Step 1:

Open the Photos app on your iOS device then tap the image or video the user wants to share. Click **the share icon** in the bottom left corner of the screen.



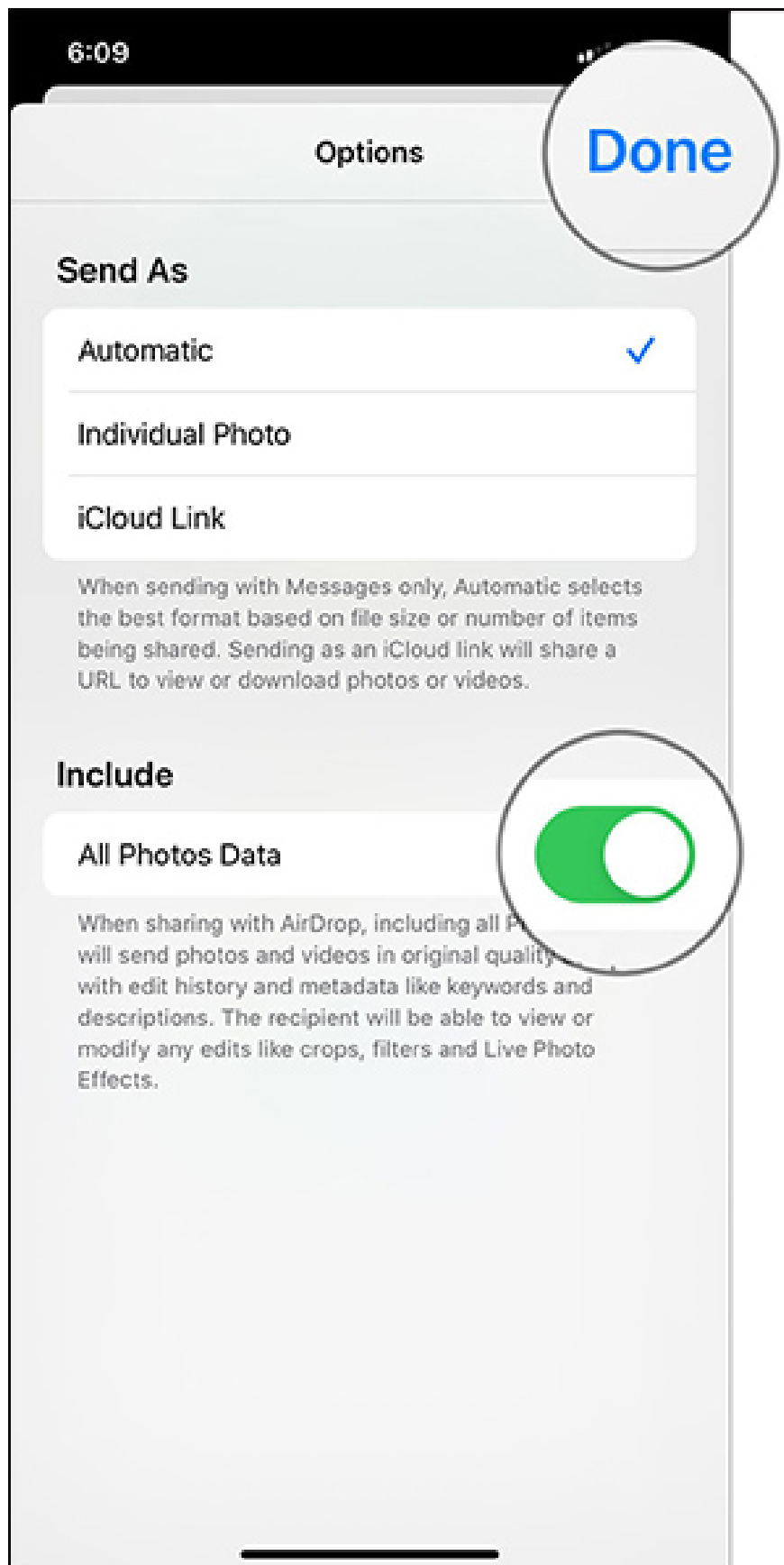
Step 2:

Display image sharing, users click on the **word Options** at the top of the image.



Step 3:

Switch to the optional interface for sending images. At **Include** users **enable the option All Photo Data** to send photos with the quality equivalent to the original image. Note that enabling all data will include the position of the image. Click **Done** to save changes to the image.



Step 4:

Return to the sharing interface to choose the **method** you **want to share images or videos** , here is AirDrop is done.


