

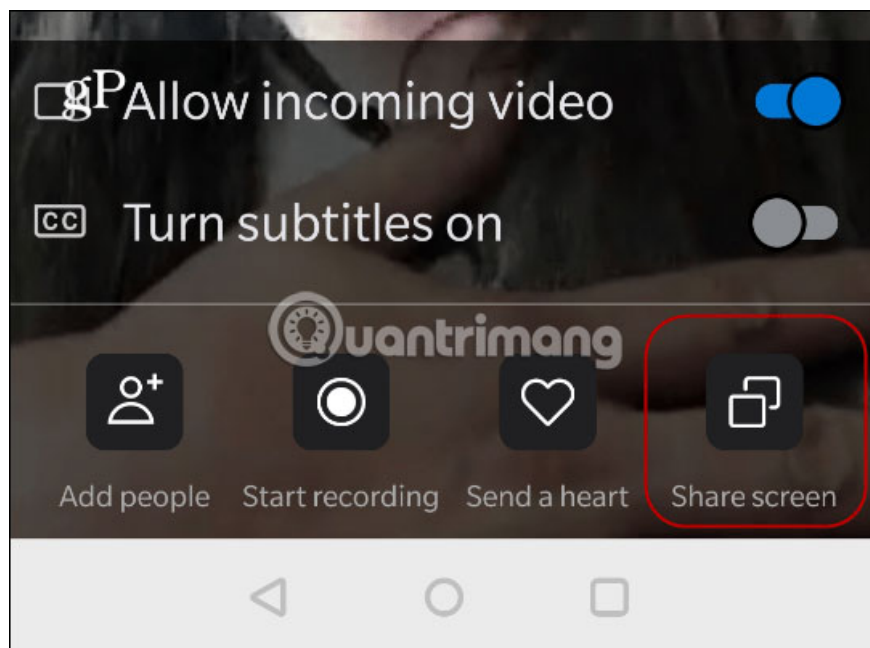
How to share phone screen on iOS or Android by Skype

Use the Screen Share feature on Skype for Android or iOS

To get started, open the Skype app on your Android or iOS device and start the video call with one of the contact numbers. After the call starts, touch the option button (three dots) in the lower right corner of the screen.



From here, click on the **'Start Broadcast'** button. Now the person you contact will be able to see your phone or tablet screen and you can show them what you need.



Screen sharing may be useful in some situations. For example, when you're on the move and need to help your friends or family members do something. You can guide them step by step by showing how to do it. Or, you may need to present a document or presentation to your boss. Or as Microsoft suggests: Maybe you want to shop online with your best friends or you need to collaborate with someone on the other side of the hemisphere, while sitting comfortably on the couch in your home. .

In any case, this is a great feature that Skype users can use on their computers. Phones and tablets are becoming more powerful, now you can work or entertain from almost anywhere.

This new option is available on iOS and Android. However, it is worth noting that you need to have Android 6.0 Marshmallow or more. If using an iPhone or iPad, you need to run iOS 12 and above.
