

How to shoot Art Bokeh beautiful and sparkling 'virtual' on Galaxy S9 +

The Galaxy S9 + has an extremely interesting function called a little-known Art Bokeh capture. Simply put, Art Bokeh is the tiny light behind the background of a photo, that light or round grain of rice looks very eye-catching.

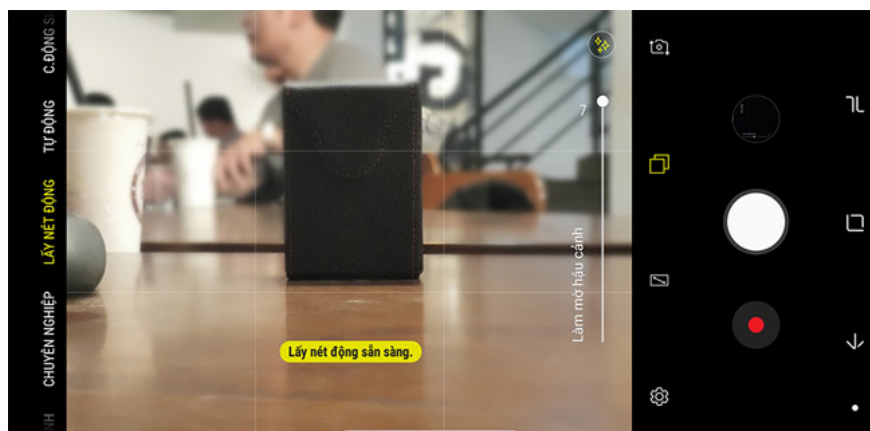
The Galaxy S9 + has an extremely interesting function called a little-known Art Bokeh capture. Simply put, Art Bokeh is the tiny light behind the background of a photo, that light or round grain of rice looks very eye-catching. Normally, you want to take photos of Bokeh, you need to use a professional camera with a large aperture lens with a certain focal length. However, if you own a Galaxy S9 +, you can also make this eye-catching bokeh part into a heart shape, an airplane, a snowflake, .

The reason Art Bokeh on the Galaxy S9 + does so is by using the real Bokeh recognition algorithm and re-processing it in different shapes with fully adjustable sharpness, making the photo shoot bokeh so unique and sparkling that no smartphone has done so effectively. Let's learn about this "god" feature now!

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How to take photos of Art Bokeh beautiful sparkling and "magic" on Galaxy S9 +

To capture Art Bokeh, you first need to activate *Dynamic Focus mode*. The way to let you know whether this mode is activated or not is when taking photos of the appearance of yellow text like the image below.

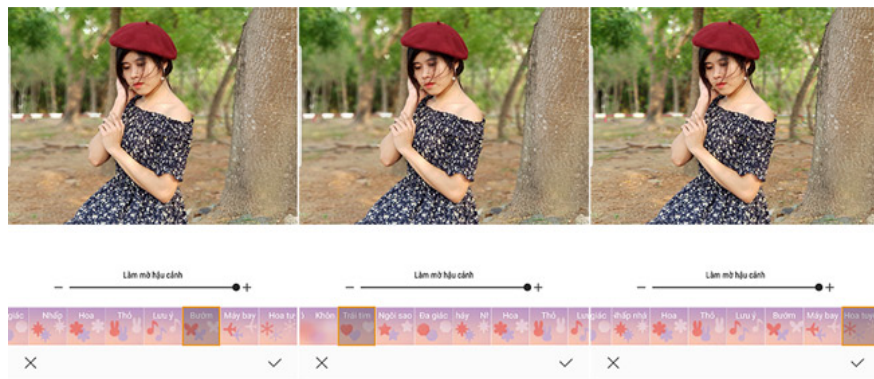


One thing to note, is not always the Art Bokeh feature. It only works when the background blur behind has details of small font deletion such as light bulbs in the distance, foliage, sunshine through the foliage, . and the

number must be relatively large. If only a few lights or a flat background, clear blue sky, a wall, . then you can use Art Bokeh. For example, photos taken under tree foliage like this we all use Art Bokeh.



Another way to help you check if Art Bokeh works is, after you have finished shooting, open the image and choose to blur the background. In the case that only appears to adjust the level of font removal, Art Bokeh does not work on that photo, but if it appears like the image below, congratulations, you took Art Bokeh photos on Galaxy S9 + successfully there.

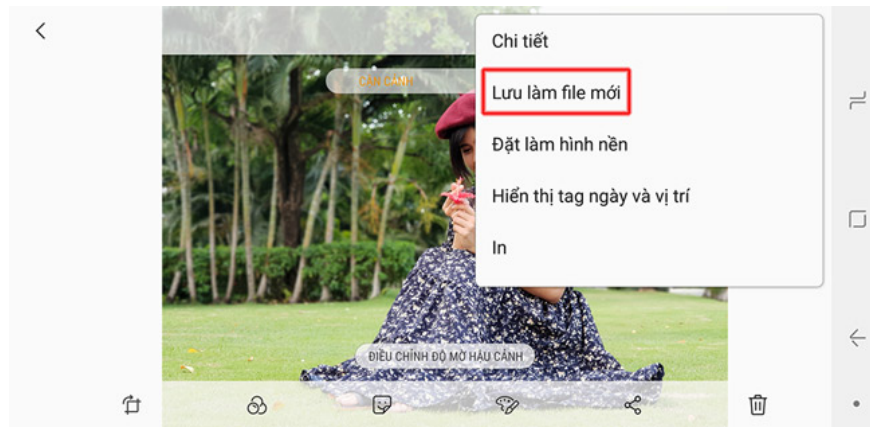


In particular, you can choose from a variety of different bokeh icons such as hearts, stars, snowflakes, flowers, planes, polygons instead of just circular bokeh like professional cameras. You can also save as many photos with different effects.



When selecting a certain effect, remember to tick the tick in the right corner. Next, select the 3 dot mark icon and select *Save as new file* , the applied effect will be saved.

Note: For newly saved images, you will not be able to change the effect, but the original image can be changed at any time, even if you transfer the original file to another S9 +, it can be edited. normally.



In general, using Art Bokeh is not difficult at all. You can take advantage of beautiful view locations like parks and cafes with lots of lights. Certainly, Art Bokeh on Galaxy S9 + will create extremely illusionary font deletion.
