

How to show the clock on the Taskbar in Windows 10

Did you know that you can display the second clock in the Taskbar? If not, read this article to learn how to do it!

Did you know that you can display the second clock in the Taskbar? By default, you can click the time displayed on the Taskbar and the pop-up window will show the time with the number of seconds. If you want them to always be displayed in the Taskbar to know the exact time every second, please remember this method, note that this method only works on Windows 10.

1. Some tips to customize Taskbar on Windows 10 effectively

Start by opening the Registry Editor. Type **regedit** into the **Start** menu and launch the utility. Accept the administrator's prompt and you will access the Registry. As usual, be careful when staying here because only one wrong operation can lead to system crashes.

Unlock Advanced with this link:

HKEY_CURRENT_USERSoftwareMicrosoftWindowsCurrentVersionExplorerAdvanced

Right-click on the **Advanced** folder in the left bar. Select **New> DWORD (32-bit Value)** and name it.

ShowSecondsInSystemClock

Next, double-click this value in the right panel. In the **Value data** field, set the value to **1**. Click **OK** to save the changes, then close the Registry Editor. After logging out and logging back into the account, you will see the number of seconds displayed on the clock.

If you don't want to display the number of seconds, go back to the Registry, change the value to **0** or delete it.
