

How to split the screen on a Windows 11 laptop

When you frequently work with multiple applications at once on your Windows 11 computer, switching between them can be confusing and time-consuming. Things will become much simpler and easier if you use the convenient split-screen function available. In this article, TipsMake will share with you how to split the screen on a Windows 11 laptop.

With the following shared instructions, you can **split the screen on your Windows 11 laptop** into different sections to view and access multiple windows at the same time. Furthermore, to improve the user's multitasking experience, Microsoft added a new feature called Snap Layouts to Windows 11, which allows you to quickly and neatly arrange your applications on the screen according to 4 layouts available.



Instructions to split the Windows 11 computer screen in half

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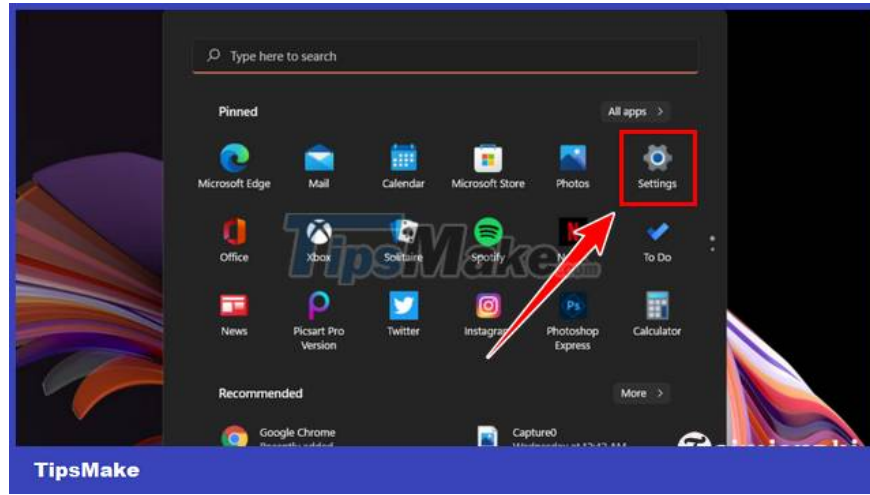
1. How to enable Snap windows feature on Windows 11.
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How to split screen on Windows 11 laptop

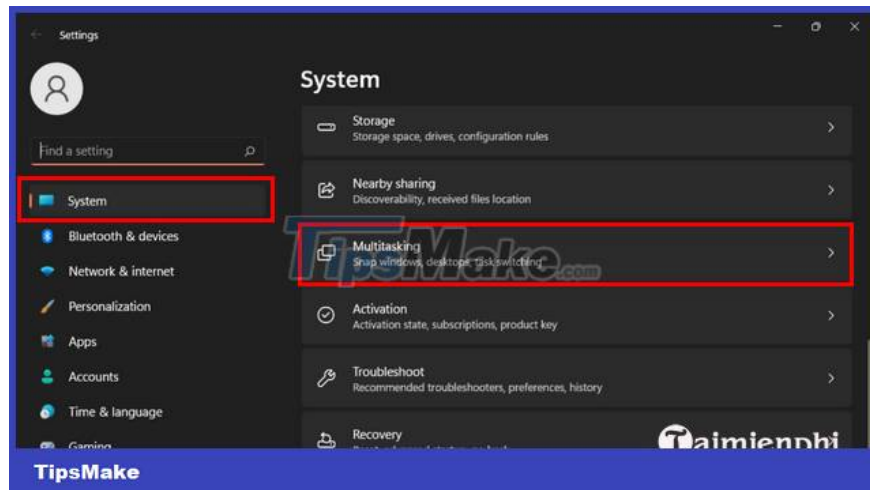
1. *How to enable Snap windows feature on Windows 11*

First you need to turn on the Snap windows feature on Windows 11 with the following steps:

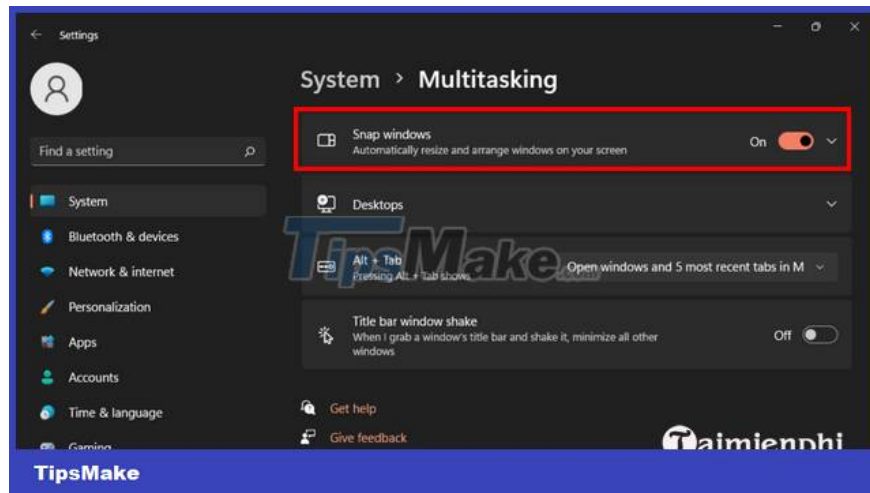
Step 1: You click on the **Windows icon** on the taskbar and select **Settings**, or press the **Windows + I** key combination to open the settings application.



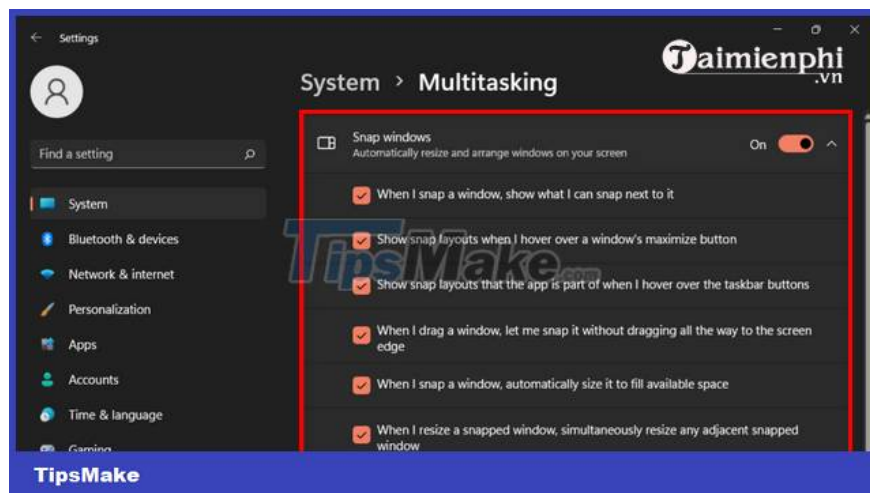
Step 2: Next, click **System > Multitasking**.



Step 3: Turn on **Snap windows** by turning the switch to **On**.



Step 4: Click on **Snap windows** and you will see a menu that includes various options. Here, you can uncheck or tick the options you want.



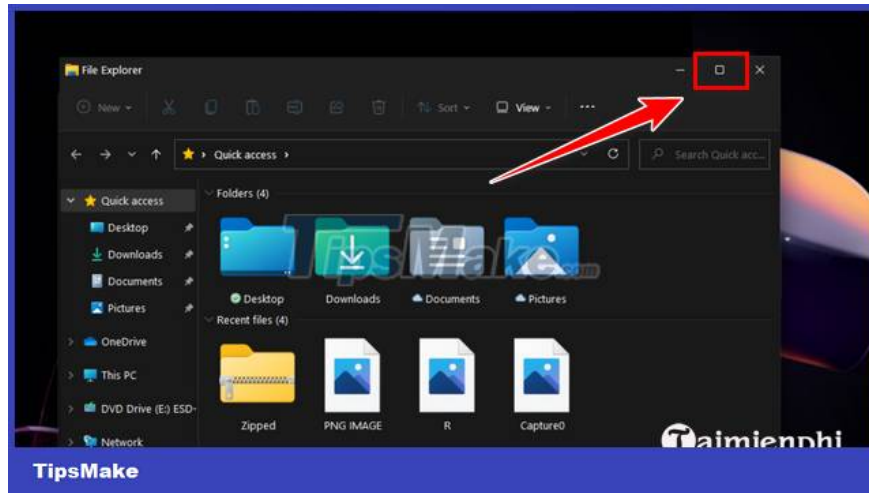
2. How to split screen on Windows 11 laptop with Snap Layouts

Windows 11 has made split screen much easier and faster with Snap Layouts built right into the maximize button for each window. You don't have to hold and drag the window aside or work with keyboard shortcuts to activate the Snap window like on Windows 10 anymore.

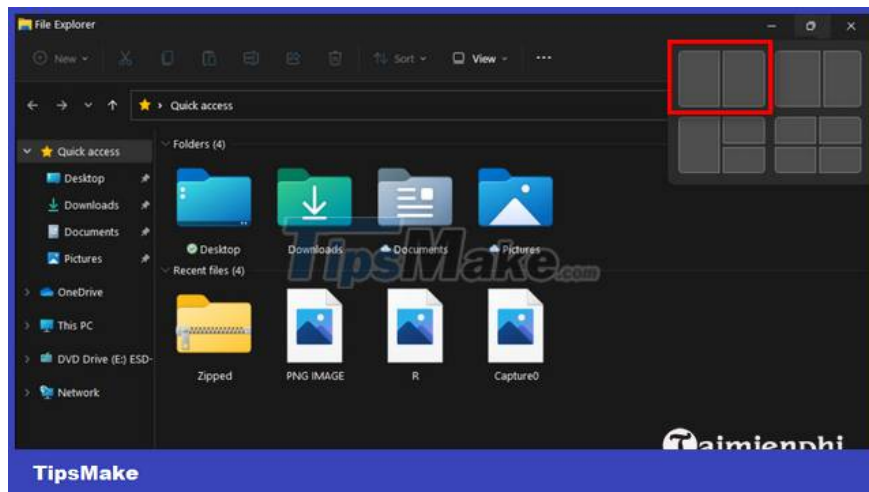
2.1. Split screen on Windows 11 laptop into 2 parts

To split the screen on Windows 11 laptop into 2 parts, do the following:

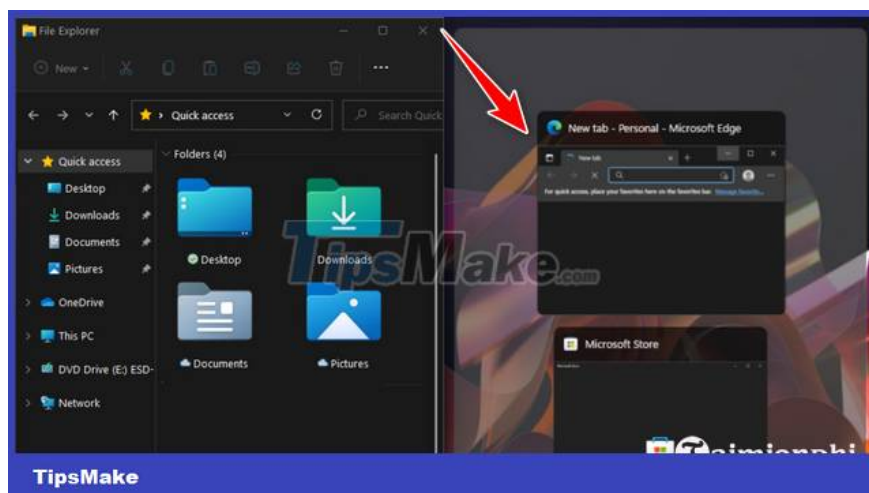
Step 1: Open the application window you want to split and hover your mouse pointer over the **maximize button** in the upper right corner of the window.



Step 2: In the layout that divides the screen into 2 parts, click on **the left half** or **the right half** of that layout.



Step 3: Now your current application window will be attached to the selected half of the screen and open applications will be displayed as thumbnails in the other half. Click on the app you want to add to the other half of the screen.

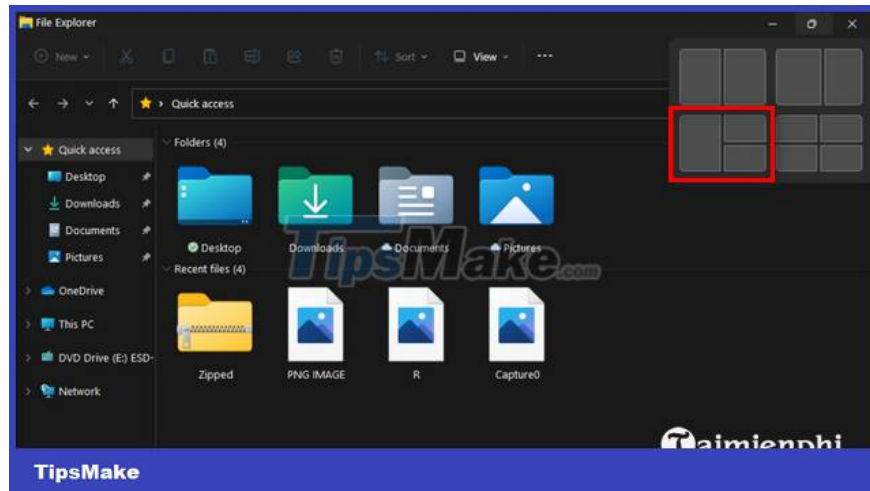


Step 4: Thus, you will have two application windows on the screen to use simultaneously.

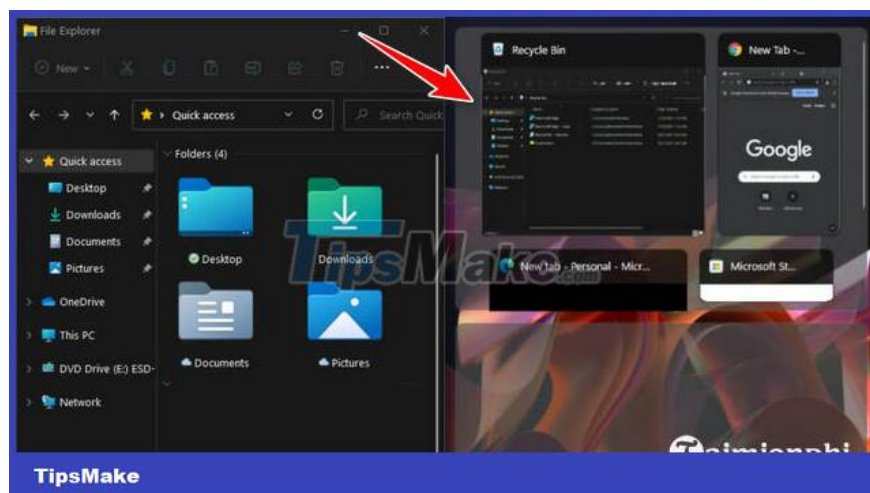
2.2. Split screen on Windows 11 laptop into 3 parts

Step 1: Open the application window you want to split and hover your mouse pointer over the **maximize button** in the upper right corner of the window.

Step 2: In the layout that divides the screen into 3 parts, click on one of the 3 parts of that layout.

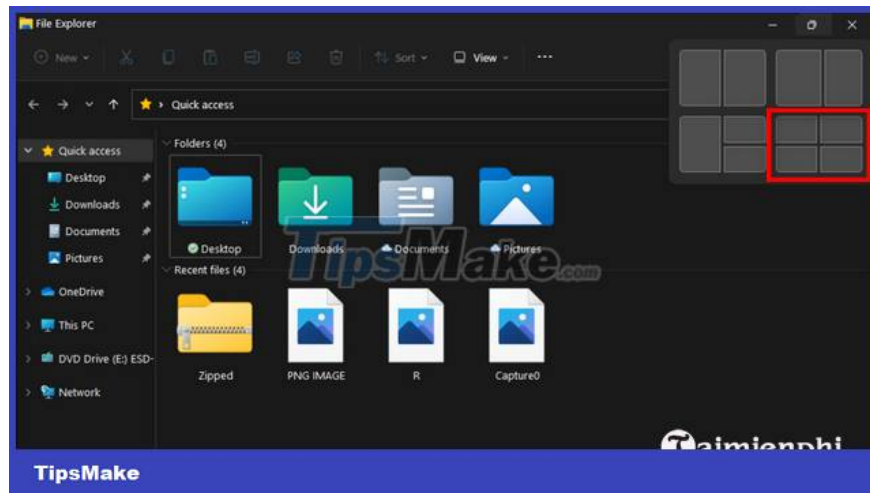


Step 3: Now, your current application window will be attached to the selected part of the screen and the open applications will be displayed as thumbnails in the 2nd screen part. You continue to select the application. used to add the 2nd and remaining screen sections.



2.3. Split screen on Windows 11 laptop into 4 parts

The steps to divide the screen into 4 parts are also performed in the same way as above. You open the application window you want to split and hover the mouse pointer over the **maximize button** in the upper right corner of the window.



Then, in the layout that divides the screen into 4 parts, you click on one of the 4 parts of that layout. Your current application window will be attached to the selected portion of the screen and open applications will be displayed as thumbnails in the second screen section. Now you continue to assign applications to the second screen. the remaining 3 screen sections. After splitting the screen, you can also refer to how to take screenshots here when using Windows 11.

3. Split screen on Windows 11 laptop with keyboard shortcuts

Besides using Snap Layouts to split the screen on Windows 11 laptops, you can also use keyboard shortcuts to do this.

All you need to do is open the window you want and press the **Windows key + Left/Right arrow combination**. The current application window will then be assigned to the selected portion of the screen, and other open applications will display as thumbnails in the other half. At this point, you just need to select the application that you want to add to that half of the screen. To divide the screen into 3 and 4 parts, you use the keyboard shortcut **Windows + Left/Right Arrow** and **Windows + Up/Down Arrow**.
