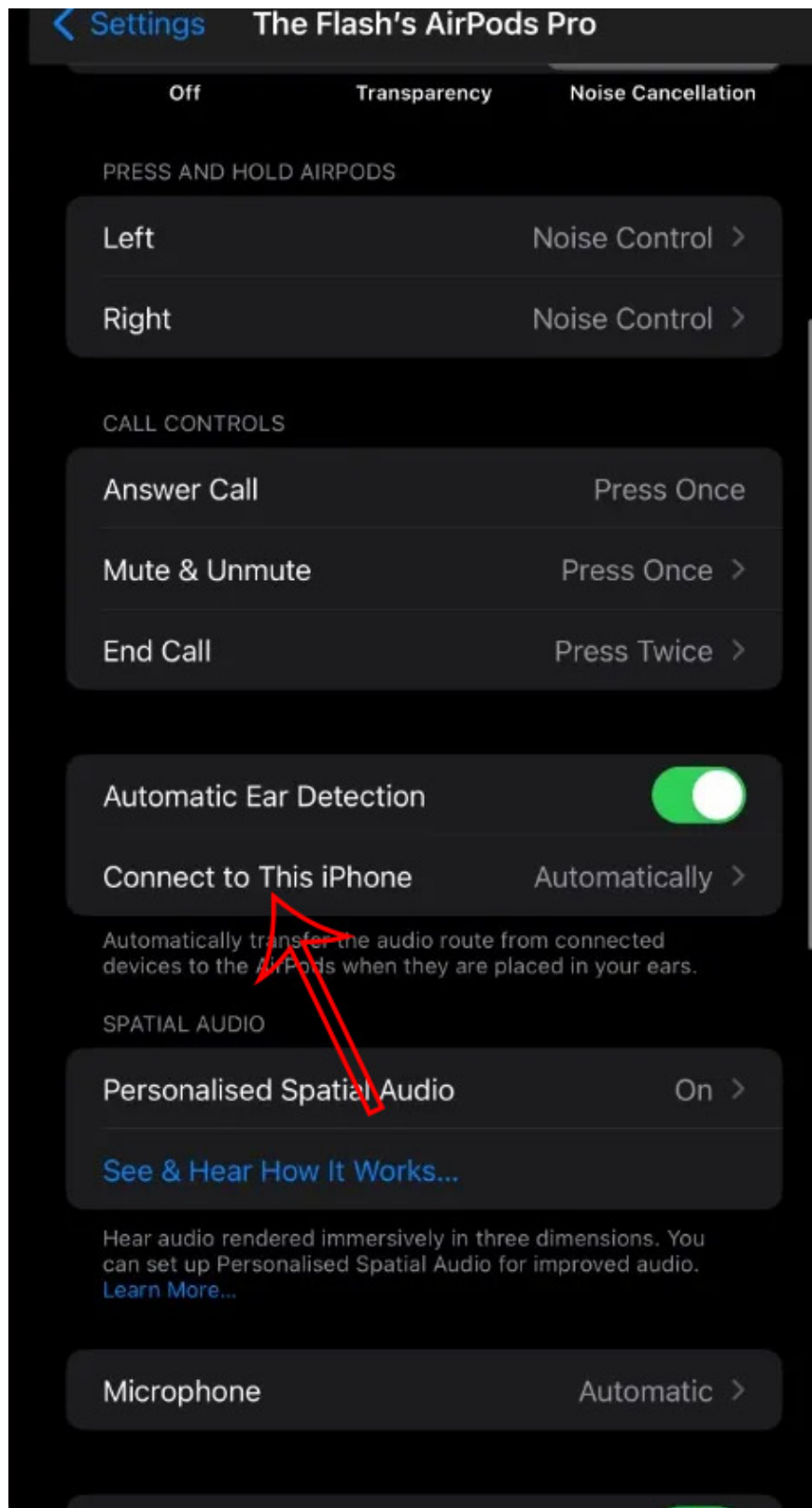
How to stop AirPods from automatically switching devices

Step 1:

After connecting AirPods to your iPhone, tap **Settings** , then tap **Bluetooth** and tap **the i icon next to the AirPods name** .

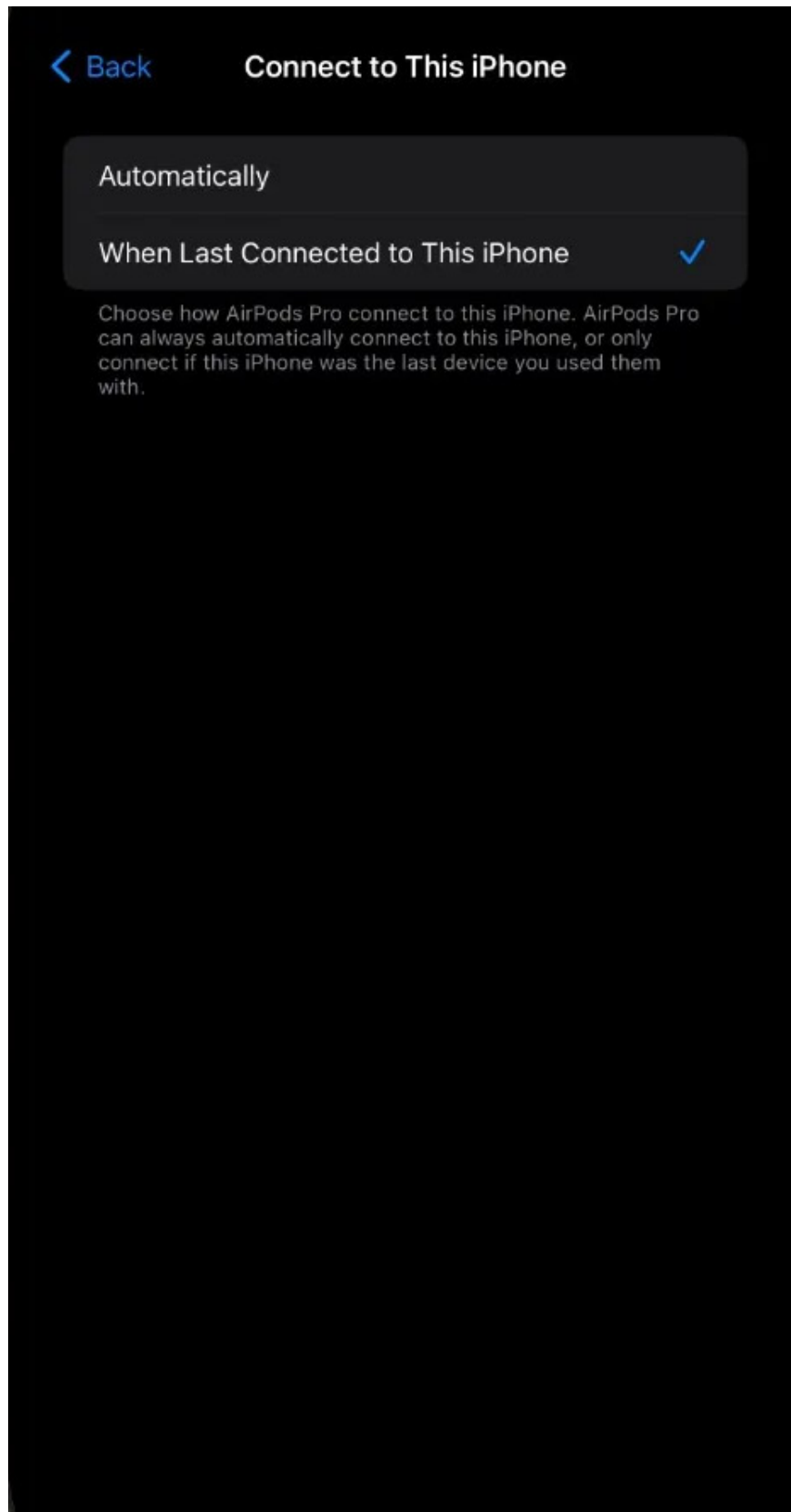
Step 2:

Next, we click on **the Connect to This iPhone option** which is in automatic connection mode with the iPhone.



Now you need **to switch to When Last Connected to This iPhone mode** so that AirPods no longer automatically switch to Mac or iPad.

Likewise, they won't transfer to your iPhone when you use them on your Mac or iPad.

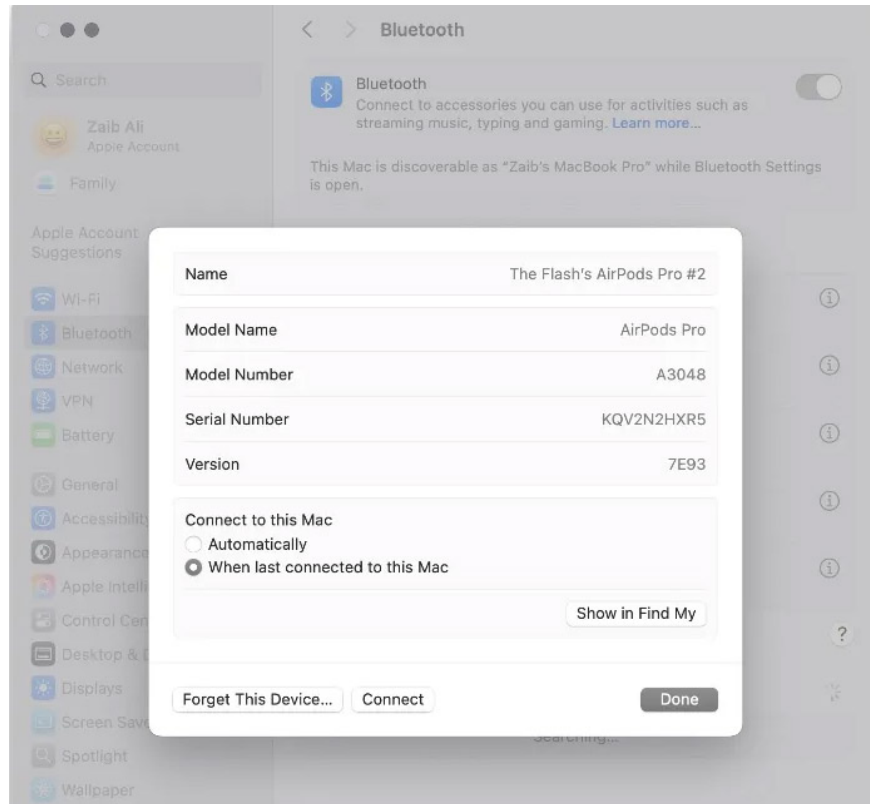


Step 3:

On Mac, click the Apple logo in the menu bar and select System Preferences.

From the sidebar, click Bluetooth. In the list of Bluetooth devices, find your AirPods and then click the i icon next to the device name.

Next to Connect to This Mac, we click When Last Connected To This Mac.
