

How to Survive Underwater in Minecraft, Breathe Underwater

Surviving underwater in Minecraft requires careful preparation and good skills. With tips like using bubble columns, carrying Water Breathing potions and equipping enchantments, you will easily conquer the challenges under the ocean. Discover how to survive underwater in Minecraft in this article.

Minecraft 1.19 update brings many new biomes for players to explore, mainly ocean biomes. Below TipsMake will suggest some ways to survive underwater in Minecraft version 1.19.

Tips for surviving underwater in Minecraft

Method 1: Using turtle shell

Players usually craft helmets out of iron, diamond, or Netherite to protect themselves. However, there is another type of helmet made from turtle shells that allows them to breathe longer and survive underwater in Minecraft 1.19.



When wearing the turtle shell, the player will gain the underwater breathing effect for 10 seconds after diving. After 10 seconds, the player's oxygen bar will decrease normally.

Method 2: Use underwater breathing medicine

Using underwater breathing potion is also a way to literally survive underwater in Minecraft as their oxygen bar will not decrease.



Players can make a potion to breathe underwater by putting pufferfish in a strange potion. If you add redstone powder, the potion's effect will increase from 3 to 8 minutes. If you don't know **how to make potions in Minecraft** , you can see here.

Method 3: Using a pipe

A conduit is a little-known block in Minecraft. To craft a conduit, players will need a few seashells and a heart of the sea.



If seastone and conduit are placed correctly, the conduit will activate, continuously restoring oxygen to players within a 32 - 96 block radius and granting underwater vision, increasing digging speed.

Method 4: Use breathing spell

Using a turtle shell gives the player the ability to breathe underwater, but they still need a proper helmet to survive. This is where the breathing enchantment comes into play.



This enchantment will make the player's oxygen bar drain slower, allowing the player to swim underwater longer and survive underwater in Minecraft 1.19.

All types of hats, including turtle shells, can be enchanted with breathing. If you do not understand how to enchant in Minecraft, you can refer to the answer in the article below.

Method 5: Use an air umbrella

This is the most popular way to survive underwater in Minecraft and is used by many players to swim underwater for a long time without having to come up to the surface.



In Java, the player can place a door underwater, stand in it, and breathe normally. In Bedrock, this is more difficult as the player will need to break a block and quickly place a button in it to retain the air cell.
