How to change DOTA 2 into Vietnamese

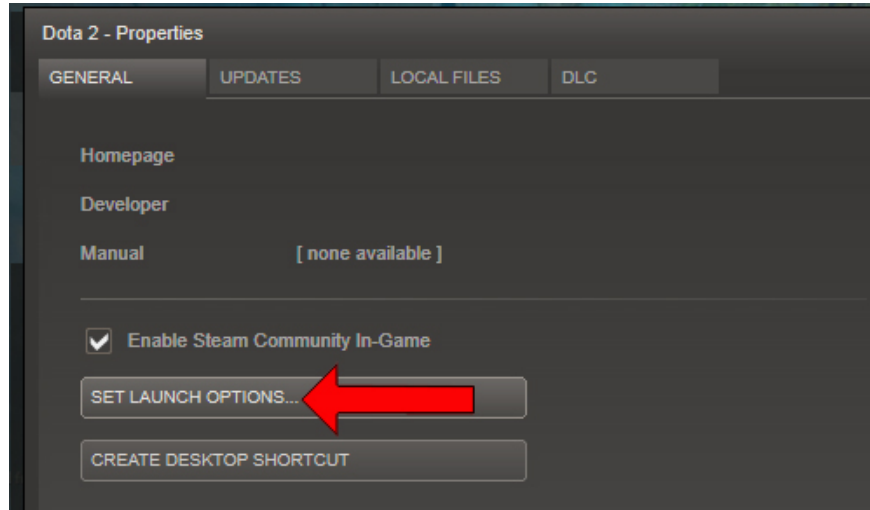
Step 1:

First, go to Steam and install DOTA 2. If it is, go to the **Library tab** , right-click on **DOTA 2 and** select **Properties** .



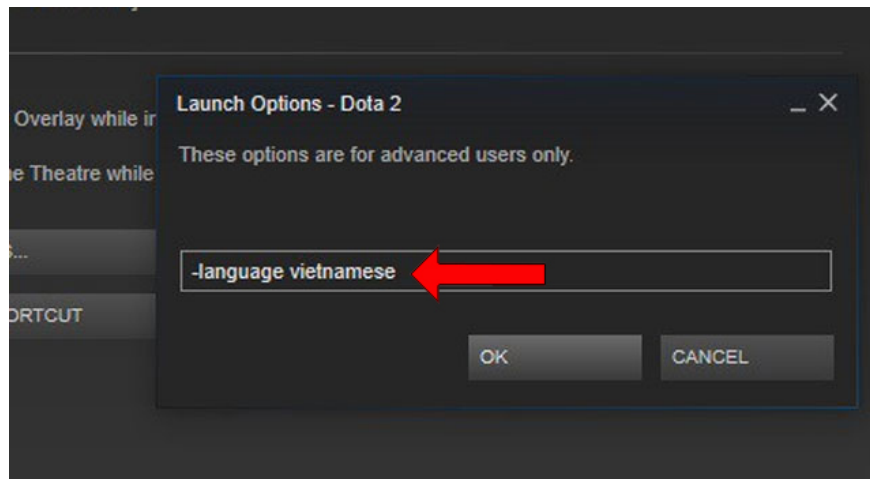
Step 2:

Switch to the new interface on the General tab, click on **Set Launch Option** .

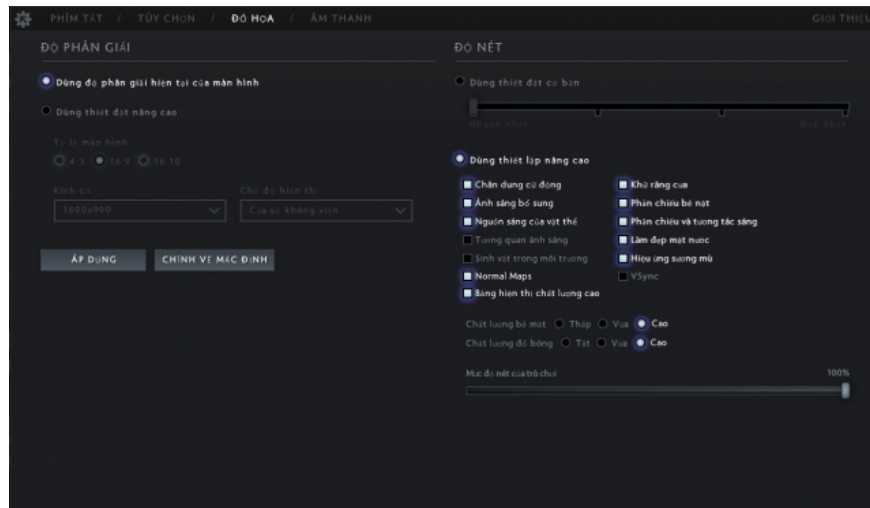


Step 3:

The **Launch Options** panel appears. At the horizontal bar below the **-language vietnamese** input and press **OK** to save.



When returning to the interface of DOTA 2 you will see the interface displayed in Vietnamese as shown.



In general, Vietnamese interface on DOTA 2 is not really elaborate, when some items are still displayed in English or not translated correctly. Hopefully in the next time Valve will fix the Vietnamese version on DOTA 2 for more complete.
