

# How to sync data on Google Chrome?

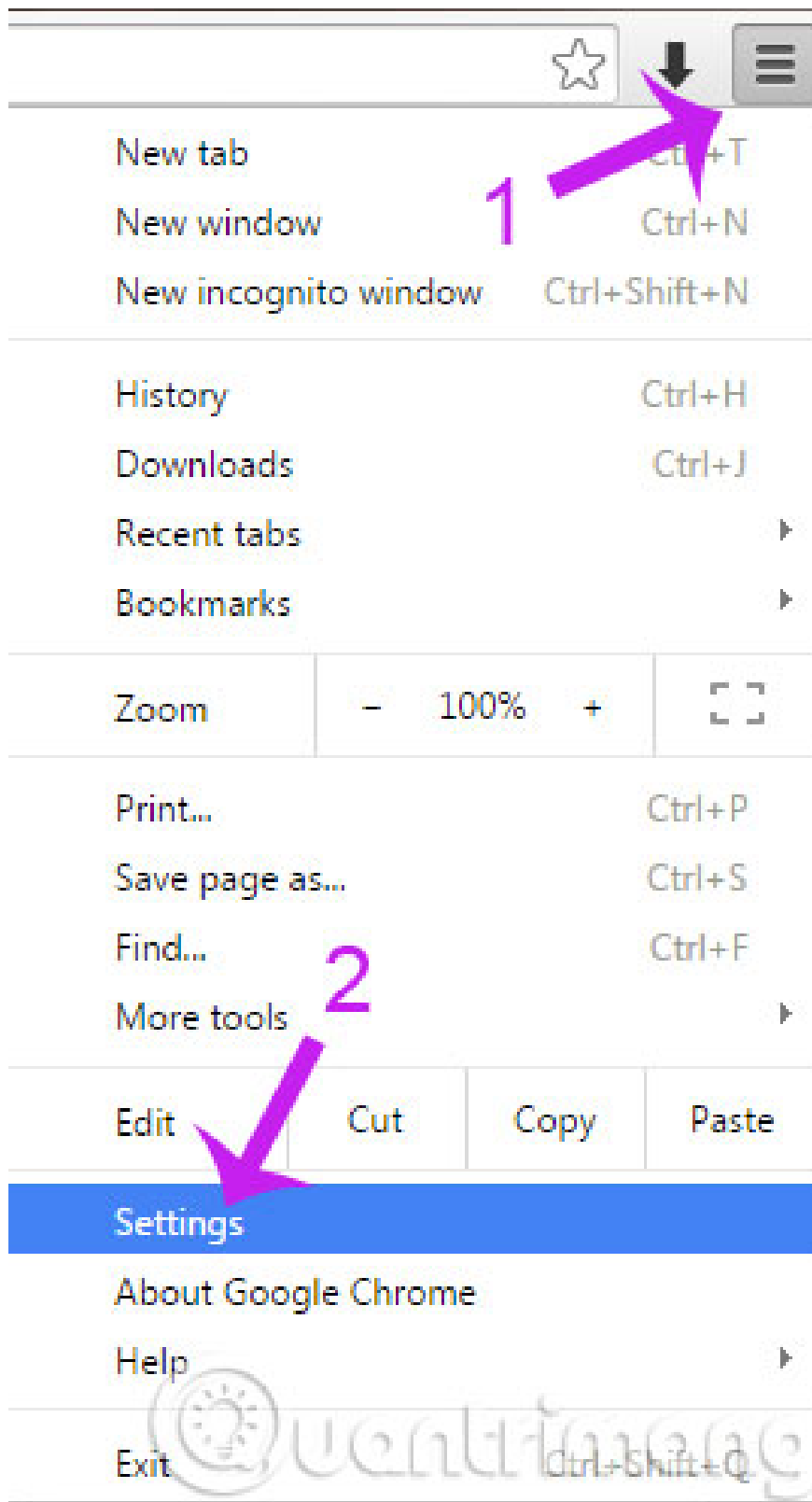

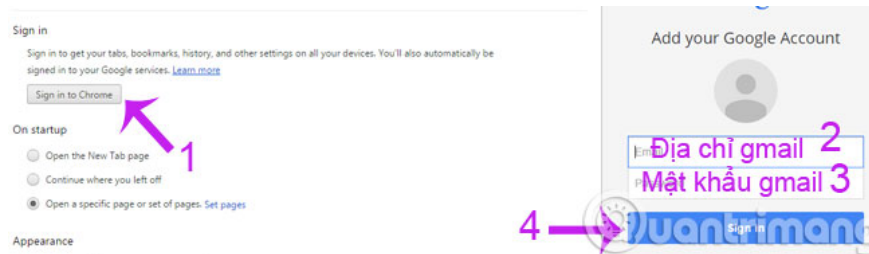

To perform data synchronization for Chrome, follow these steps.

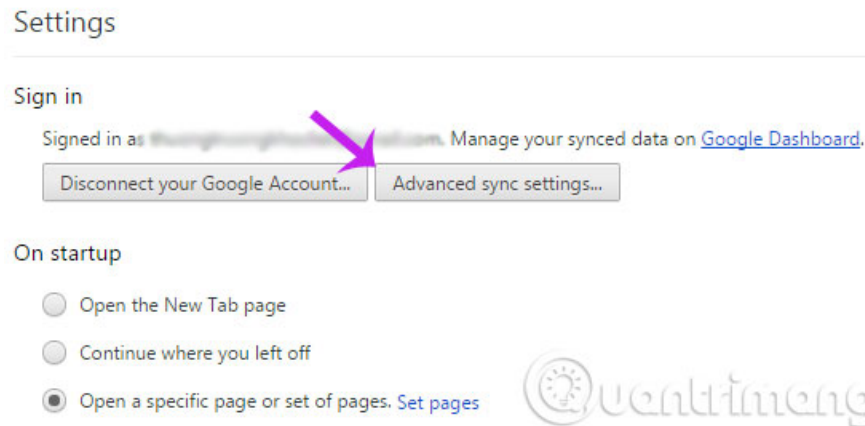
**Step 1** : At the interface of Chrome, you click on the icon **3 dash** and select **Settings**



**Step 2 :** When the **Settings** window appears, you click **Sign in Chrome** ( *login your Gmail account in case you haven't logged in* ).



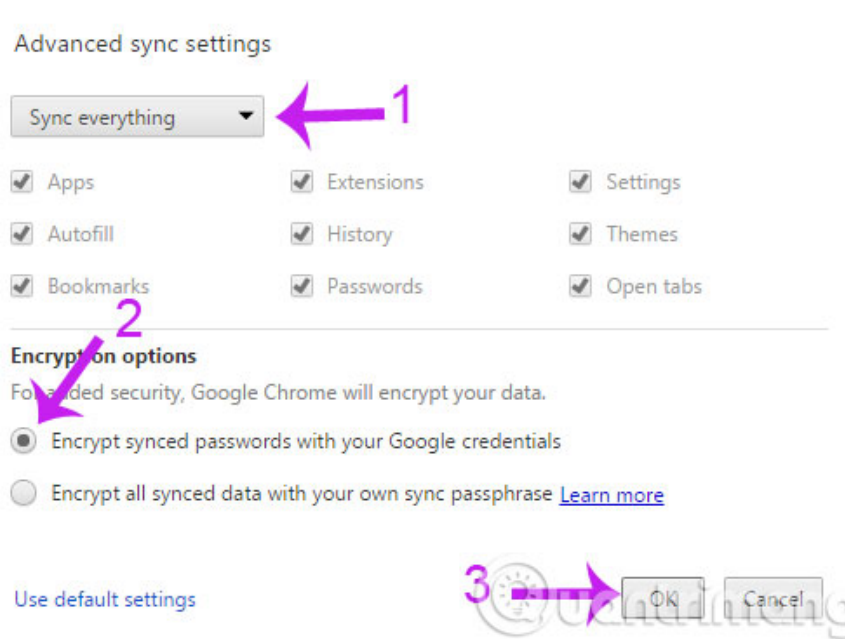
**Step 3 :** Also in **Sign in** , click on **Advanced sync settings** . ( **Advanced synchronization settings** )



**Step 4 :** The advanced synchronization settings window appears, you have the options:

1. **Encrypt synced passwords with Google credentials** : Synchronize all data.
2. **Encrypt all synced data with your own synced passphrase**: Select the data type to synchronize.

Here, Chrome defaults to encrypting your password with your Google account. Then click **OK** .



In case you do not like to share the password with your Google account, you can tick the bottom line then proceed to enter a new password.

#### Encryption options

For added security, Google Chrome will encrypt your data.

- Encrypt synced passwords with your Google credentials
- Encrypt all synced data with your own sync passphrase [Learn more](#)

Only someone with your passphrase can read your encrypted data. The passphrase is not sent to or stored by Google. If you forget your passphrase, you will need to [reset sync](#).
