## Use the key combination Command + Shift + 4

Using the above **method of taking a screenshot of a MacBook computer**, you can press the key combination **Command + Shift + 4** at the same time, then click the + icon on the screen instead of the regular mouse cursor icon. Then, click this icon to move to the area you want to take a screenshot of. Successfully captured screenshots are automatically saved in the desktop section of Mac OS.

Besides, you can also refer to other **MacBook screen capture** software that is very convenient, especially with the ability to save photos to the cloud, you will no longer need to save captured photos to your device.

## Take screenshots of MacOS computers in many different ways

Every user can **take a screenshot of a MacBook** using many different **ways to take a screenshot of a MacBook**. Here are some of the simplest **ways to take screenshots on MacBook** :

1. Press and release **Command + Shift + 3** : to **take a screenshot of the MacBook screen** right from the entire computer screen without having to select a screen frame to capture.

1. Press the key combination **Command + Shift + 4 + Spacebar (bar)** : the mouse icon will turn into a camera image and when you move to an element such as a web browser window, home screen or

application, the window will pop turn blue. And you can click a window to **take a screenshot of your MacBook** at that window only.

## Summary of keyboard shortcuts used to take Macbook screenshots

Below is a brief summary of keyboard shortcuts to **take screenshots on MacBook Air** or other Apple Mac lines that you should know:

1. **Command+shift+3** : Captures **full screen** .
2. **Command+Shift+Ctrl+3** : Capture **full screen and copy to Clipboard** .
3. **Command+shift+4 (simultaneously drag the mouse with 3 fingers)** : Captures **an area** .
4. **Command+shift+4+Option** : **Capture an area from the center** .
5. **Command+shift+Ctrl+4** : Capture **an area and copy to Clipboard** .
6. **Command+shift+4+Space bar** : Captures **the current window** .
7. **Command+shift+3** : Capture **screen to a file** .
8. **Command+shift+Control+3** : Can take **screenshots on MacBook to Clipboard** .
9. **Command+shift+4** : Captures **a selection to a file** .
10. **Command+shift+Control+4** : Captures **a selection to the Clipboard** .
