

How to take Portrait Mode selfie photos on iPhone X

Portrait Mode on iPhone X brings users a sharp light effect like when you took a photo in front.

Portrait Mode portrait mode on 'premium' iPhone models gives users precise focus mode, taking advantage of the dual lens processing capability on iPhone 7 and later versions. In which Portrait Lighting supports Portrait mode to create amazing lighting effects.

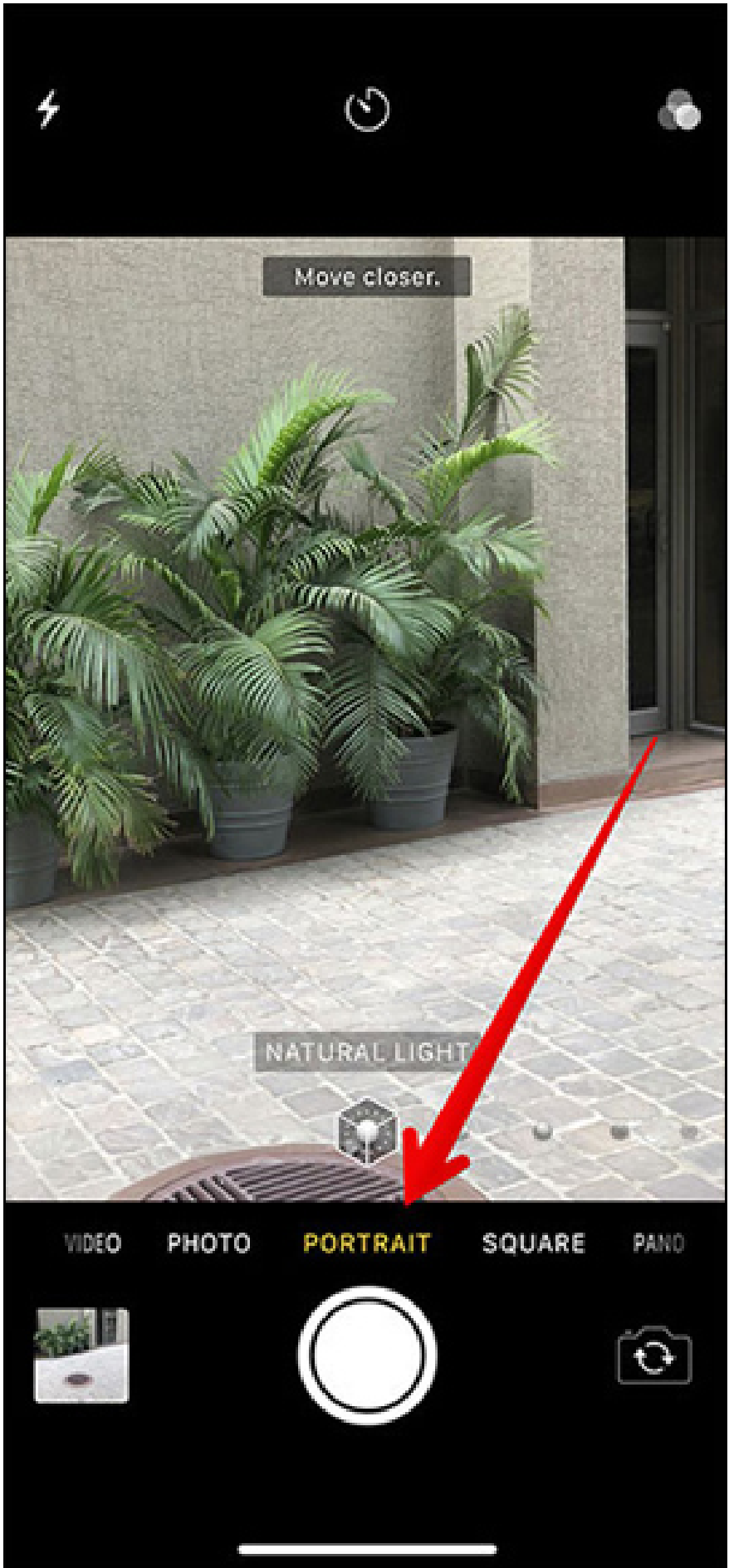
On the iPhone X, when taking photos 'take a selfie' with Portrait Mode you will see the quality of shooting as well as light similar to the rear camera. A sharp, deep image creates an impression when taking photos with the front camera. The article will guide you how to read selfie with Portrait Lighting on iPhone X.

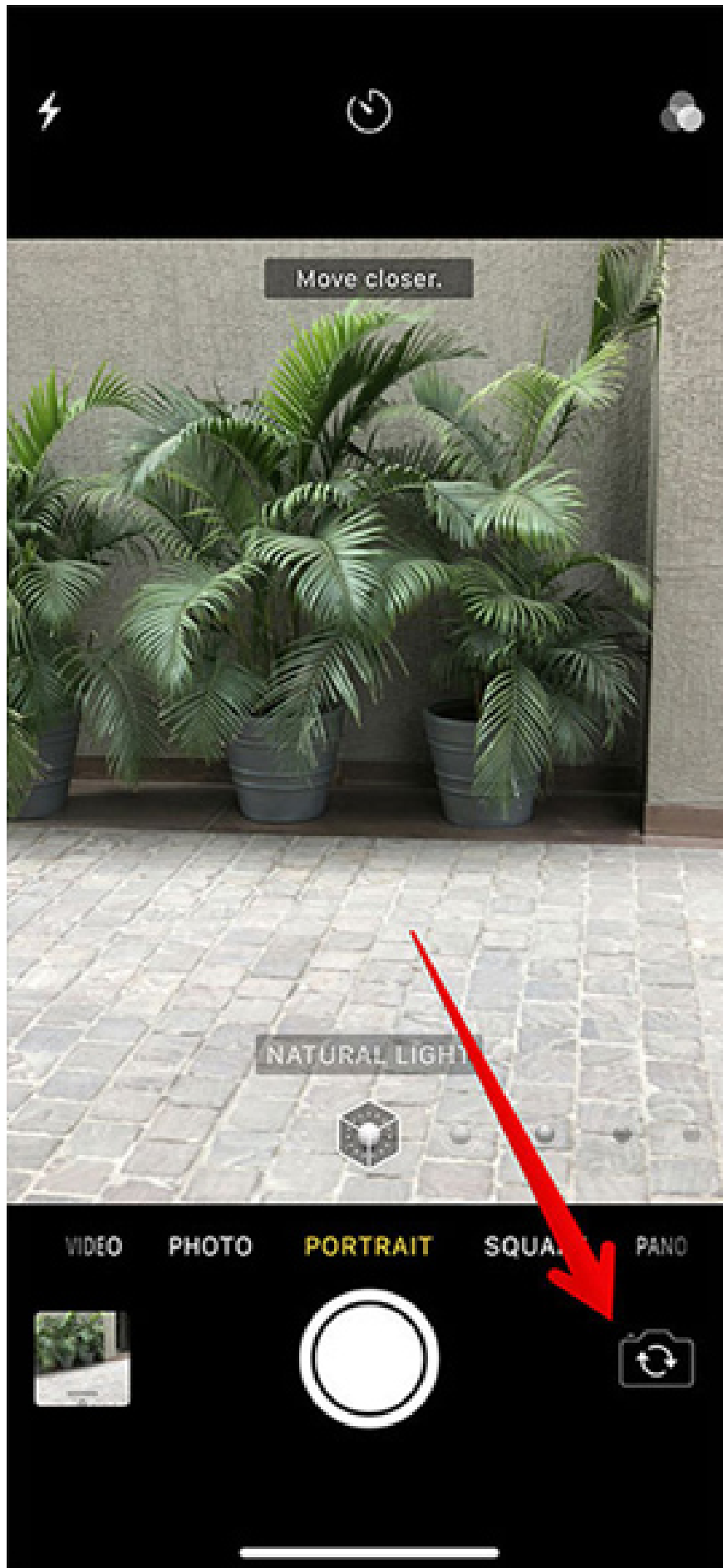
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How to take a selfie photo with the Portrait Lightning iPhone X

Step 1:

First you start the camera application on the device. Then switch to **Portrait Mode** . Click on **the camera icon** in the right corner to use selfie mode.





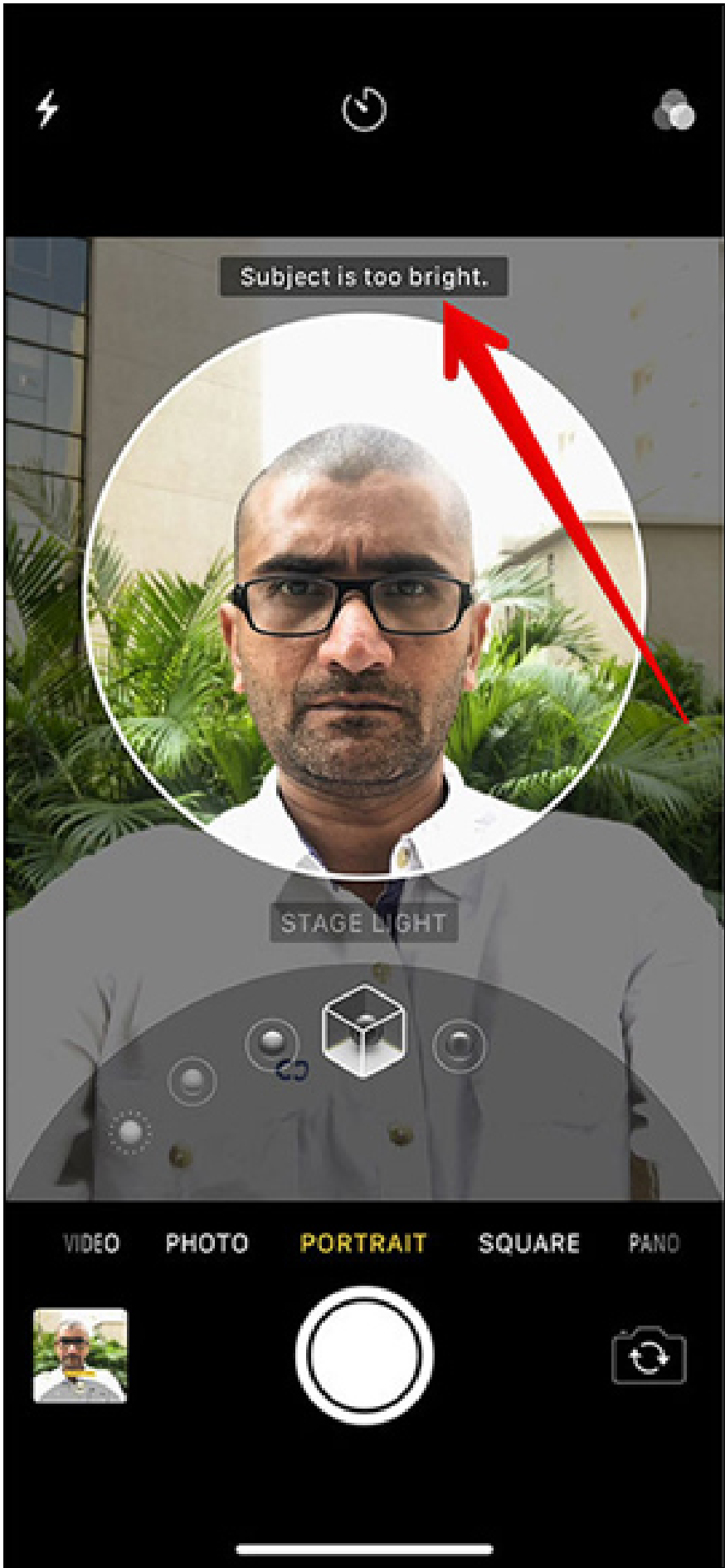
Step 2:

Bring the camera close to your face and choose Portrait Lightning mode. This **Portrait Lightning** feature will apply 5 most basic lighting effects so we can choose for portrait photos. 5 effects include:

1. Natural Light: The effect simply obscures the background for high contrast.
2. Studio Light: Allows you to lighten up facial expressions.
3. Contour Light: Provides light in impressive directions.
4. Light Stage: Allows you to completely separate your theme in the spotlight.
5. Mono stage: Allows you to localize your theme in black and white classic spotlights.

Click on the light effect I like. When selecting the light effect we will see on the screen interface a number of hint messages such as adjusting the lighting, .





Step 3:

You follow the suggestions of Portrait Mode. When we see **the Natural Light yellow message**, we get the effect as well as the complete angle. Finally press the button to take the middle photo to capture.

Note to readers , the appearance of a yellow notification on the interface is not so important. It only suggests so you can customize the shooting angle as well as the effect to best suit. You can still shoot when the yellow message does not appear, but the photo will not have the desired light effect.





Above is how to take a selfie with Portrait Lightning shooting feature on Portrait iPhone X mode. This shooting mode provides users with 5 light effects commonly used in the studio from simple to advanced. Includes Natural Light, Studio Light, Contour Light, Stage Light, Stage Mono. With 5 photo effects, you can freely create quality "selfie" images on iPhone X.
