

How to take ProRAW photos on iPhone 14

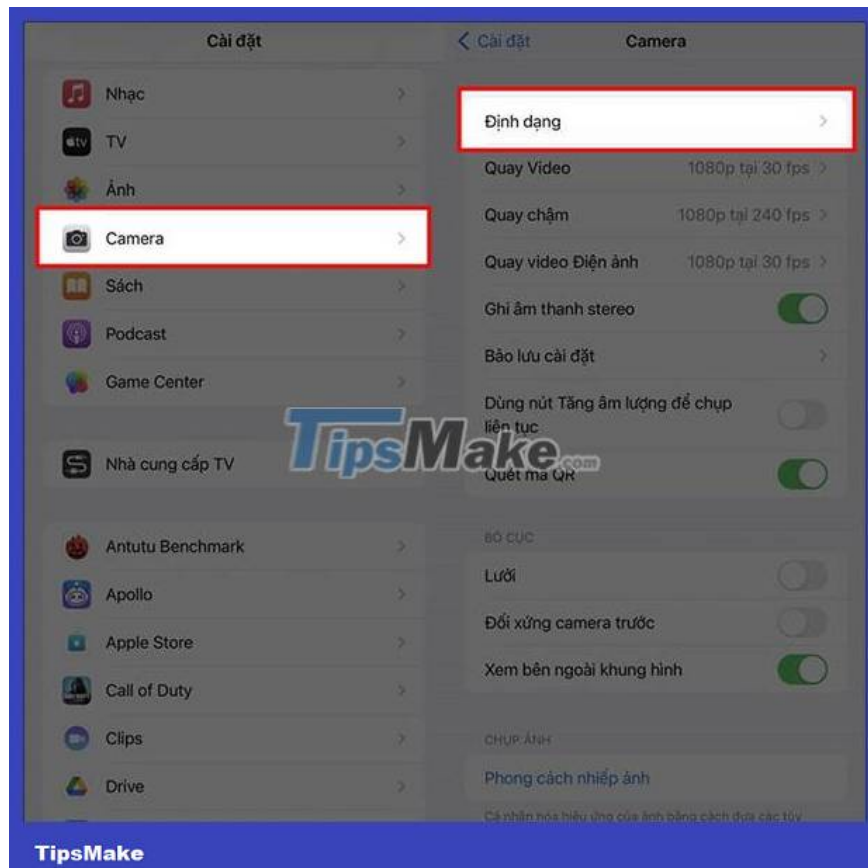

ProRAW photography mode on the iPhone 14 series is not enabled by default and you will have to activate it manually. The article below will guide you to enable ProRAW photography mode on iPhone 14.

Instructions for turning on ProRAW photography on iPhone 14 series

Step 1:

At the iPhone interface, click on **Settings** , then scroll down to select **the Camera application** . Switching to the settings interface for the camera application on the iPhone, we **click on Format** to adjust the photography parameters.



Step 2:

Next, in the Format section, activate Apple ProRAW and select ProRAW Resolution. Now you adjust the resolution to 48MP.

However, you should note that when photos are taken at the highest resolution, the capacity of the photos also increases. For example, when taking photos on iPhone 14, choosing 12MP resolution, the photo has a capacity of 25MB, but with 48MP, the photo capacity is up to 75MB. So you need to pay attention, 48MP photos will take up a lot of iPhone memory.



Thus, the cameras on the iPhone 14 series will be captured at ProRAW resolution with image quality up to 48MP.
