

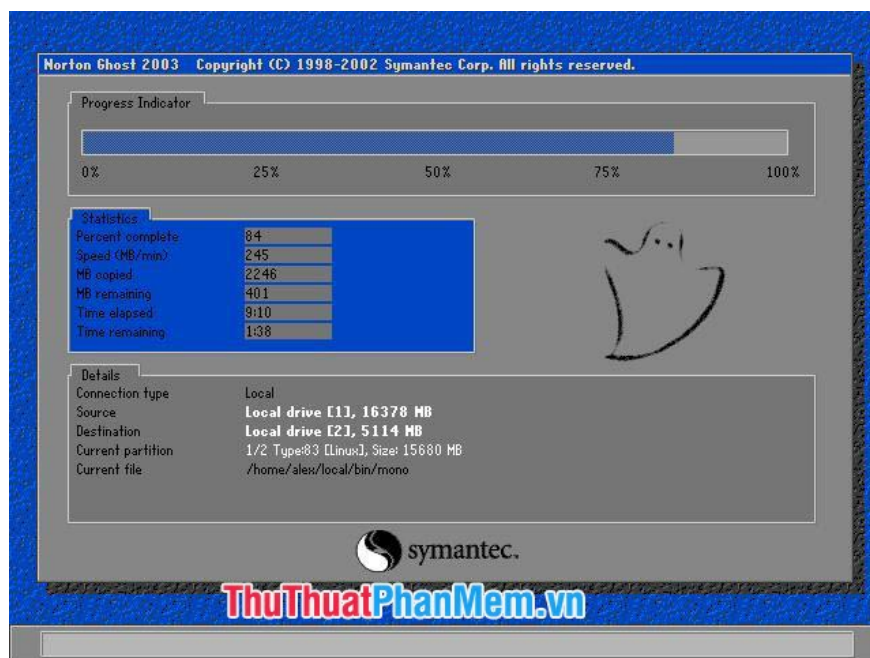
# How to transfer Windows operating system to a new hard drive (from HDD to SSD)

**Method 1: Transfer the operating system from HDD to SSD with Norton Ghost.**



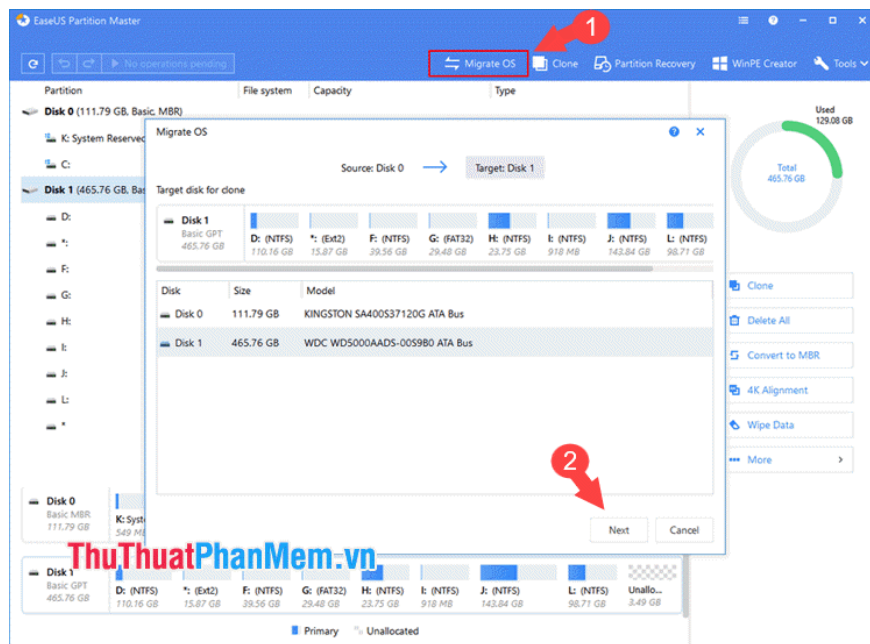
This is a simple method and the lowest error rate when done. First, create a Ghost from the old HDD and then you use that ghost file to ghost to the new SSD.

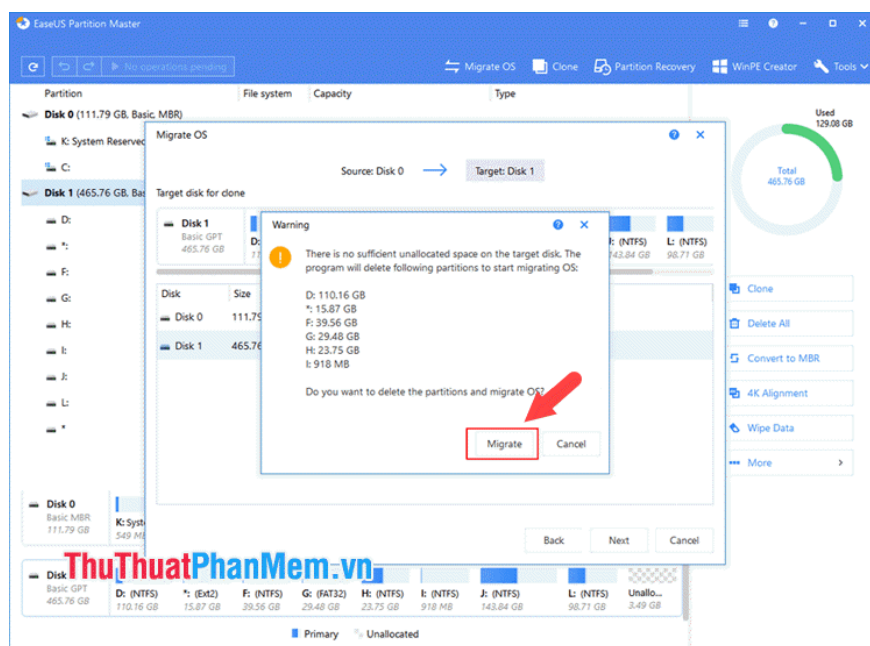
## Method 2: Use Easus Partition Master software

First, download the Easus Partition Master software here: <https://www.easeus.com/partition-manager/>

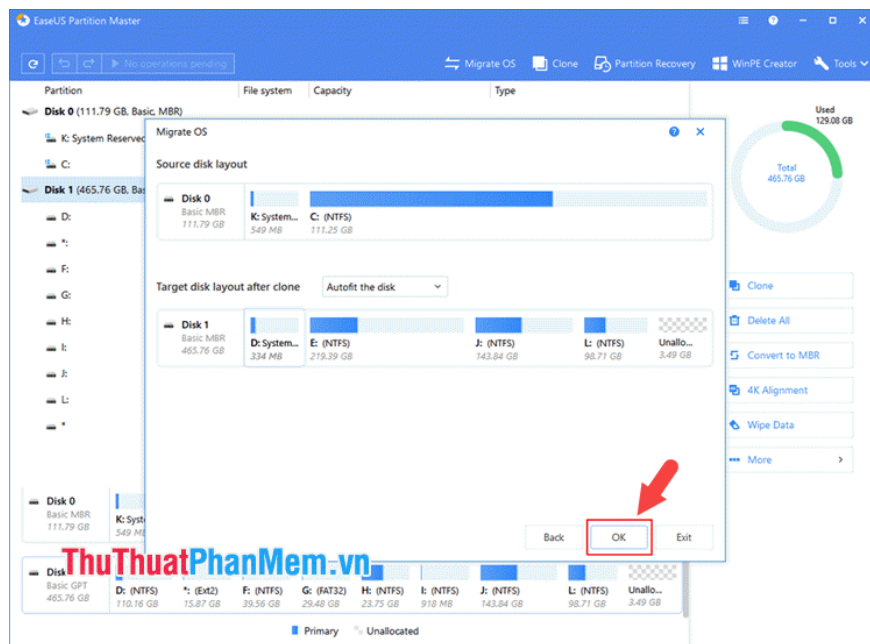
**Step 1:** Connect the 2 HDD and SSD to the computer, then open **EaseUS Partition Master** software and click on **Migrate OS (1)** . After the bulletin board displays the status of the two hard drives, select the destination hard drive to transfer the operating system to and click **Next (2)** .



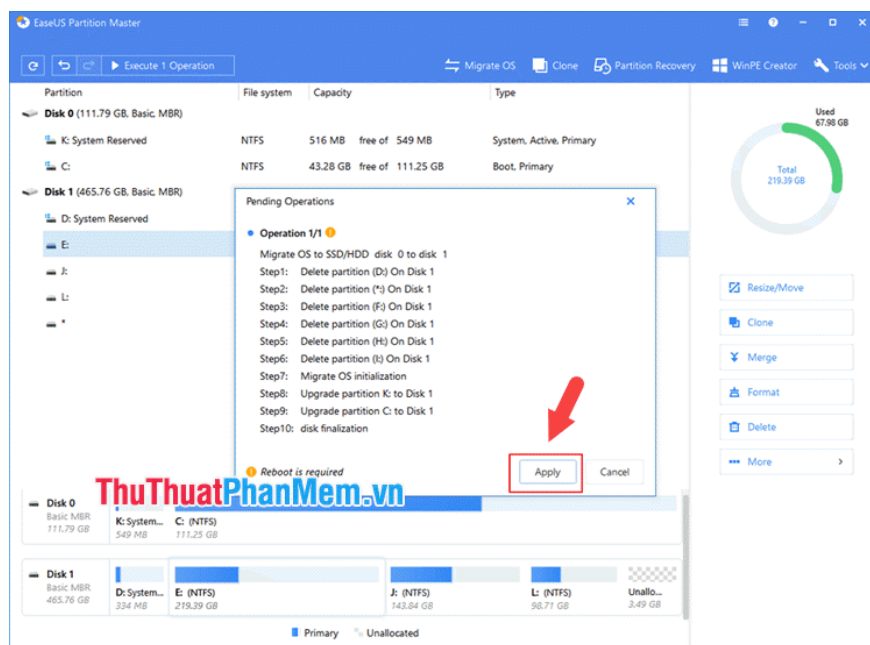
**Step 2:** Then **EaseUS Partition Master** displays a warning line about the hard drive partition that will be deleted after transferring the operating system. Click **Migrate** to continue.



**Step 3:** The software displays information about your Windows partition after transferring. Click **OK** to continue.



**Step 4:** You wait for the data transfer process to complete and then click **Apply** to complete.



In the process of moving the Windows operating system to the new hard drive, we will encounter a situation where the computer does not recognize the hard drive with the new operating system, you can handle it by disconnecting the old hard drive or entering the settings in BIOS and hard drive boot priority with the new Windows operating system first.
