

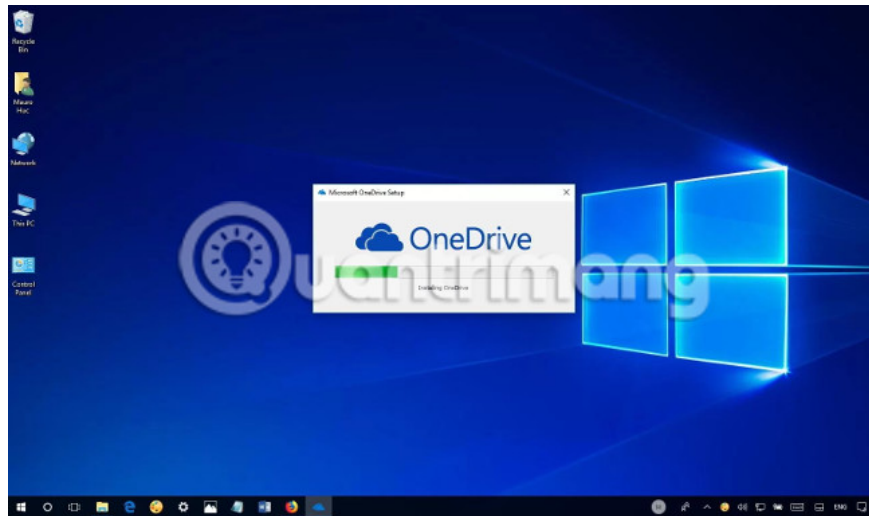
# How to troubleshoot OneDrive after resetting on Windows 10

If OneDrive has trouble on your device, you can use the following steps to restore on Windows 10. Let's TipsMake.com refer to how to troubleshoot OneDrive after reinstalling on Windows 10 in lesson write this!

**OneDrive** usually automatically installs every time a new setup on Windows 10 and the **sync client application** is even preserved during the upgrade process. However, now that you can uninstall the OneDrive client, the reinstallation process will threaten it like another application, so it will be deleted when you try to restore your system to the default settings. .



This behavior makes users feel there is a problem with the reset process by OneDrive missing after reinstalling and Windows 10 is not intuitive to make OneDrive return.

In this tutorial, you'll learn how to troubleshoot OneDrive after reinstalling or OneDrive missing in a Windows 10 device for any other reason.

## How to install OneDrive on Windows 10

If after resetting the device, you can not find OneDrive on Windows 10, no problem, you just need to add sync client by hand.

1. Download the **OneDrive** app.
2. Double-click the **OneDriveSetup.exe** file to install the sync tool.
3. Open **Start** .
4. Search for **OneDrive** and click on the first result.
5. Log in with your Microsoft account associated with OneDrive.
6. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the setup.

When you're done, you can start using OneDrive again on your computer.
