

How to turn off Apple TV notifications on iPhone, iPad

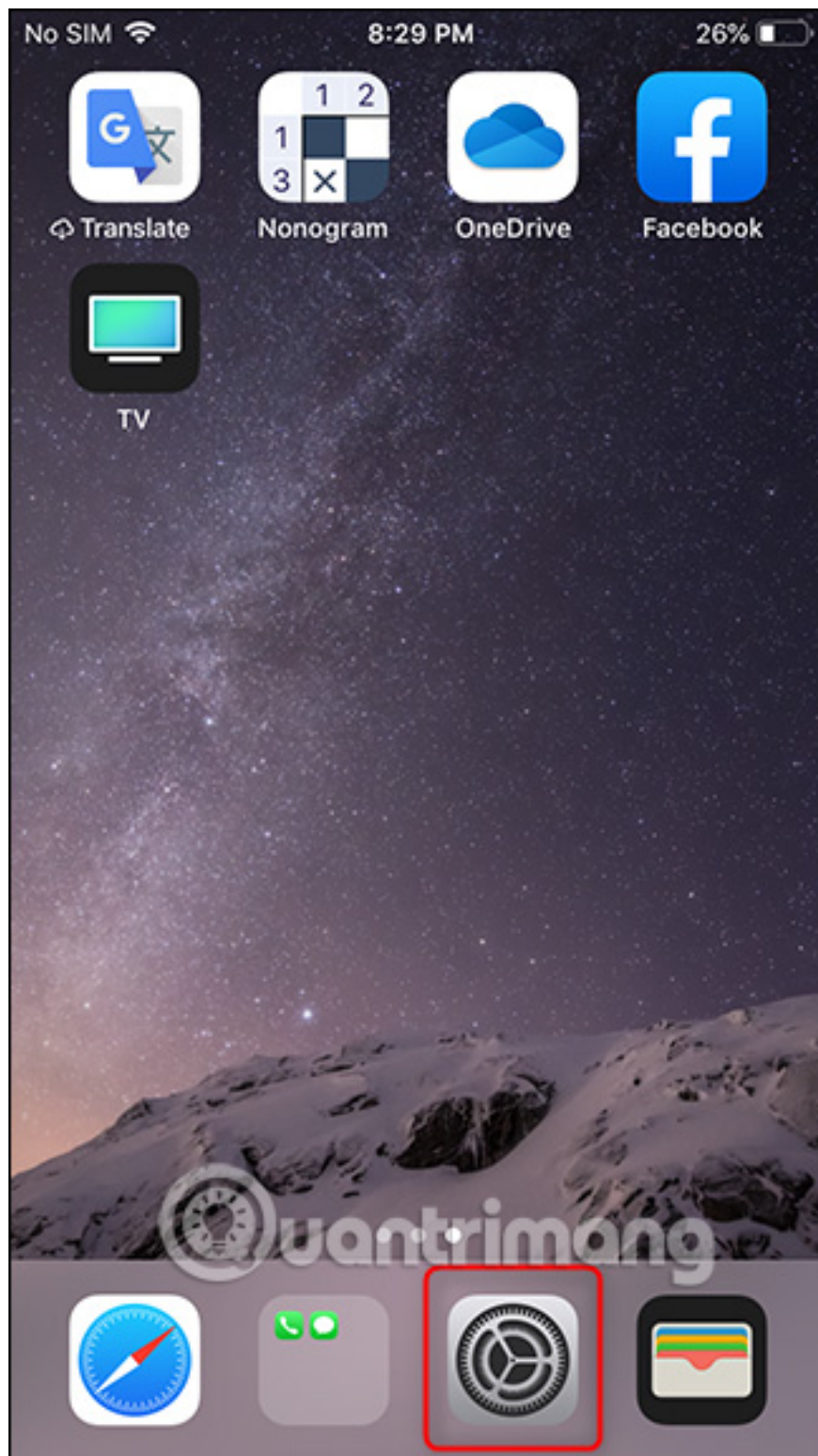
Apple TV application notifies users of new content on iPhone, iPad, if you find it inconvenient, you can disable these notifications.

There is a lot of good content in the Apple TV app and Apple wants you to discover it by providing new content notifications on your iPhone or iPad. If you find it inconvenient, you can set up iOS to allow you to edit or disable these notifications.

Many TV notifications you get even without content you can watch. Usually the TV app will remind you of the new season of popular shows and when it touches, it will provide a registration frame to watch the show. Although it is convenient for those who like the program, they are very troublesome.

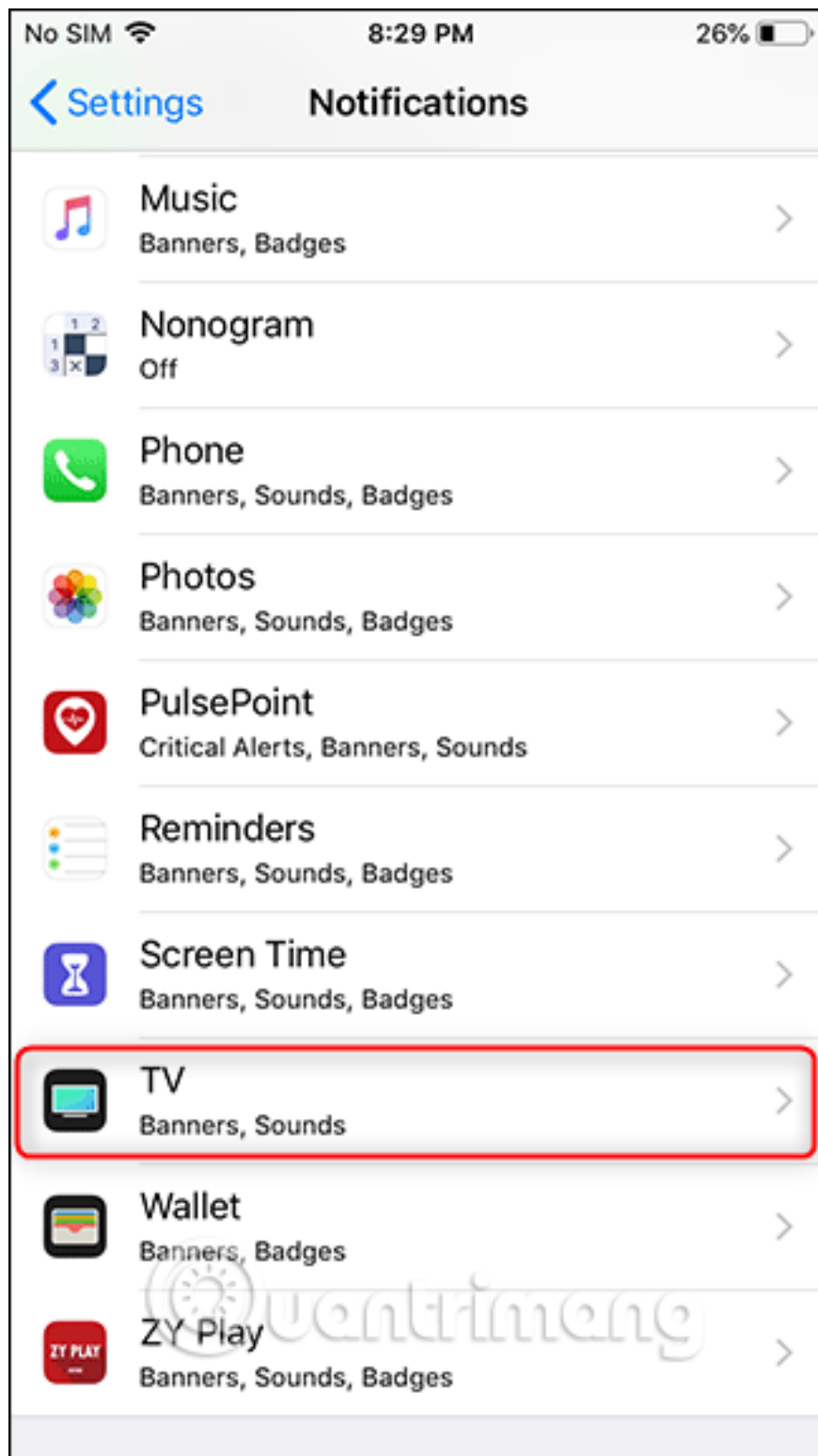

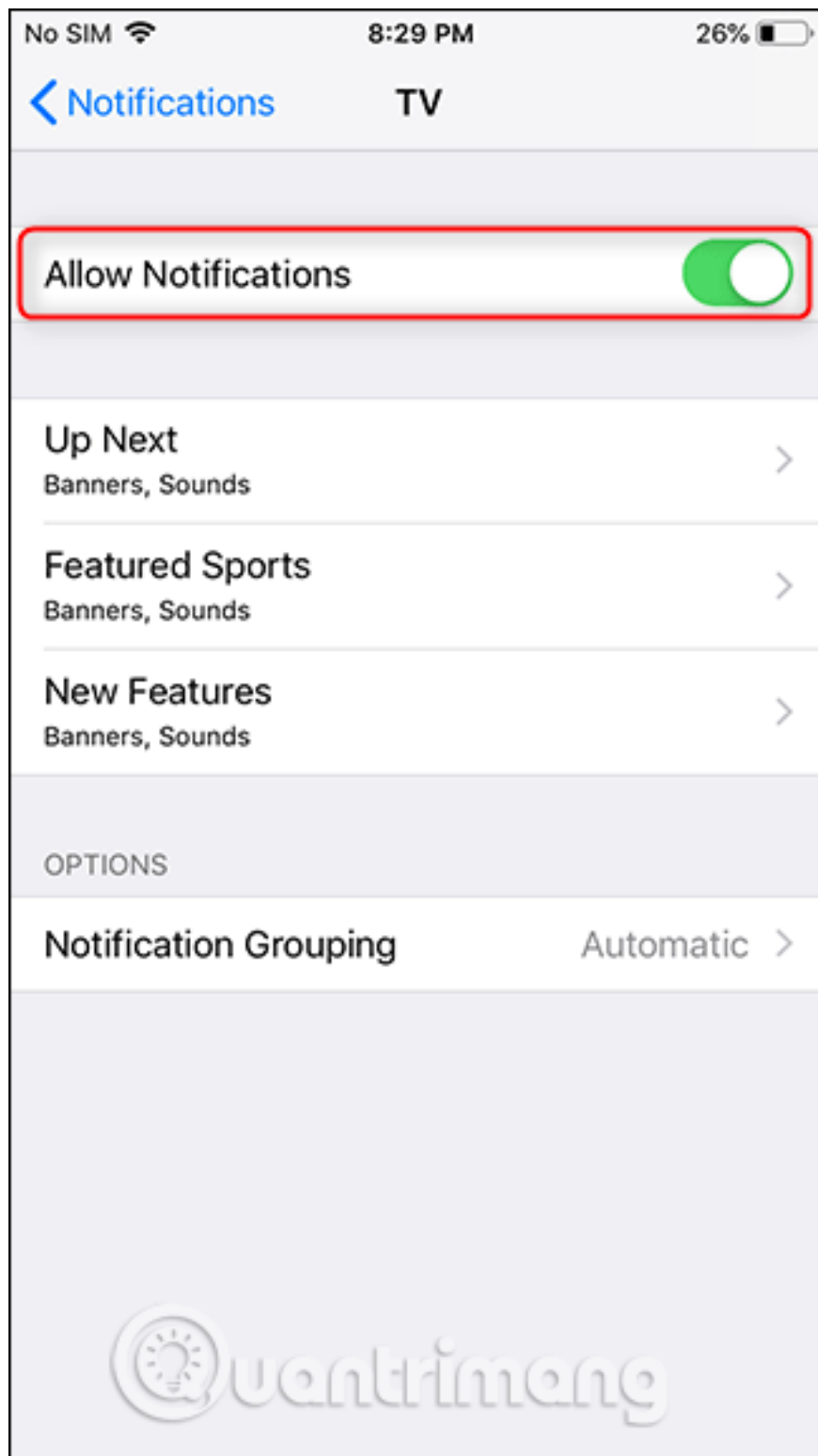

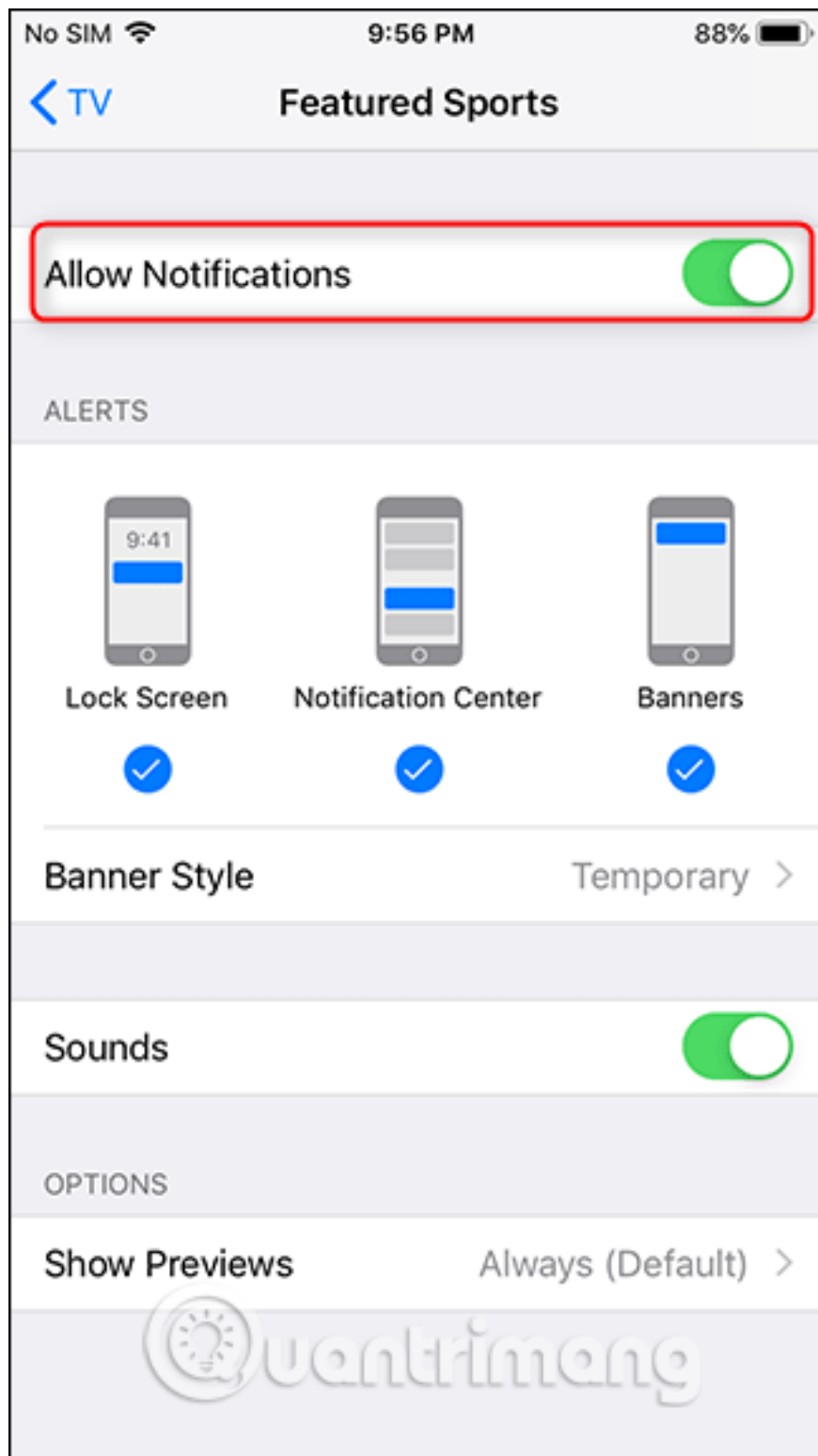
