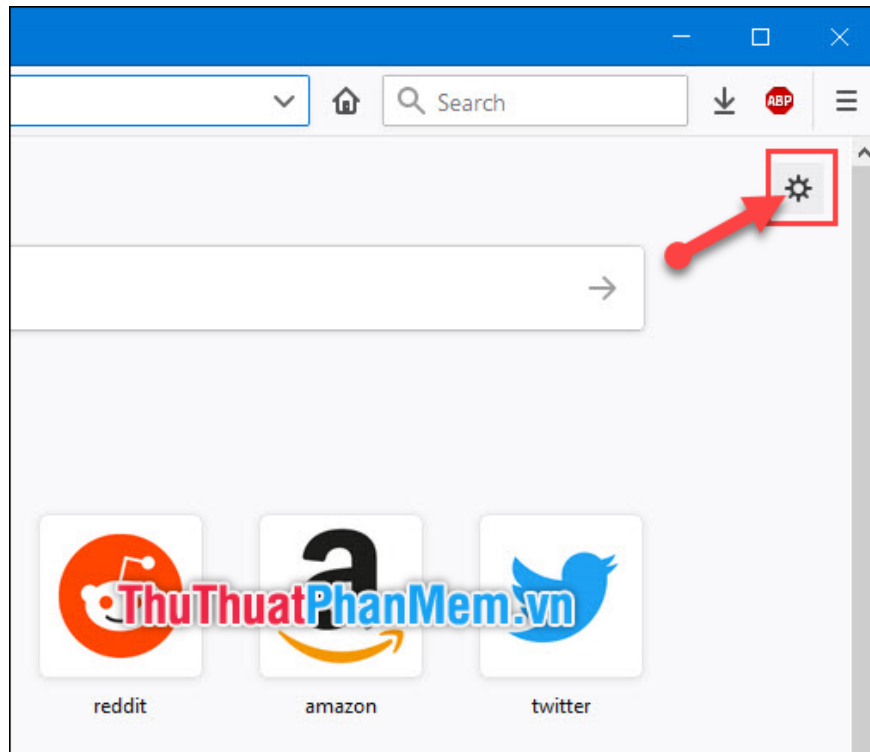

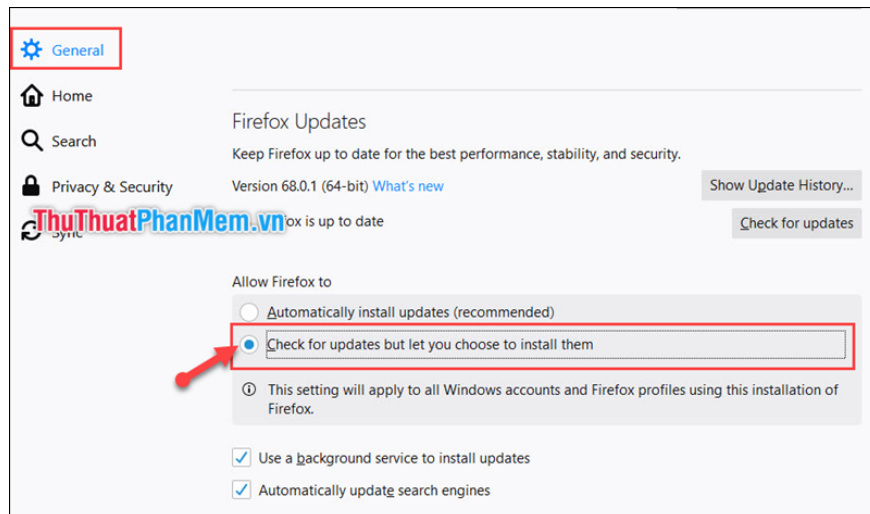


To turn off the automatic update mode on FireFox browser we do the following:

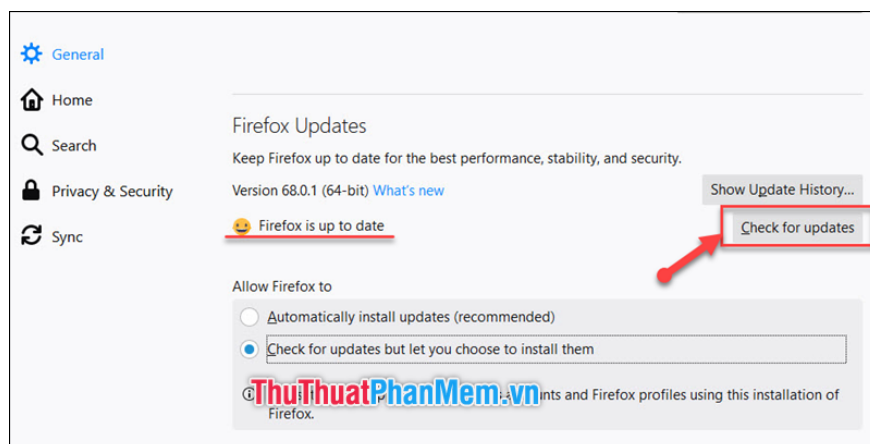
Step 1 : At the interface of FireFox browser, open a new tab and look to the right corner of the browser, on the gear icon.



Step 2 : Then in the **General** section, scroll down to find **Firefox Updates** and select **Check for updates but let you choose to install them** .



That is done turning off the auto-update feature of FireFox. Later, if you want to update the browser by yourself, click on the **Check for updates** item . Then if you receive the message **Firefox is up to date** , your version of Firefox is already the latest.
