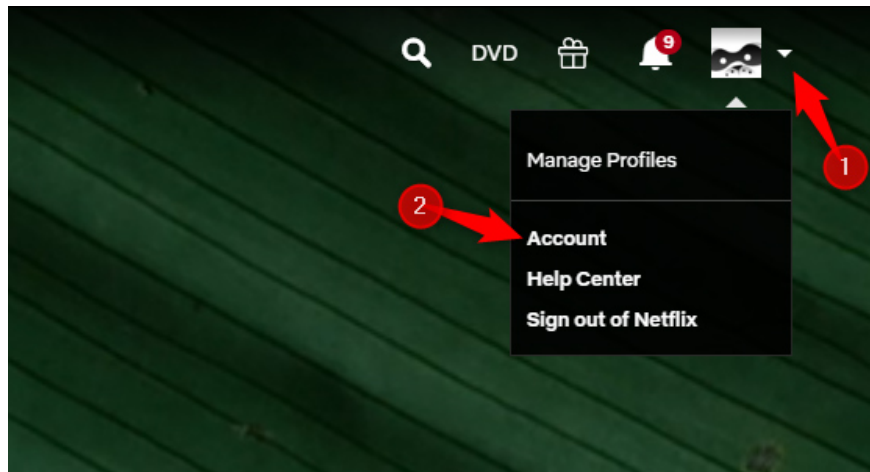
How to turn off auto-preview in Netflix

We visit the **Netflix website in the browser** to proceed with the setup. Changes will only be made on the web browser but applied to your account when signed in on other devices.

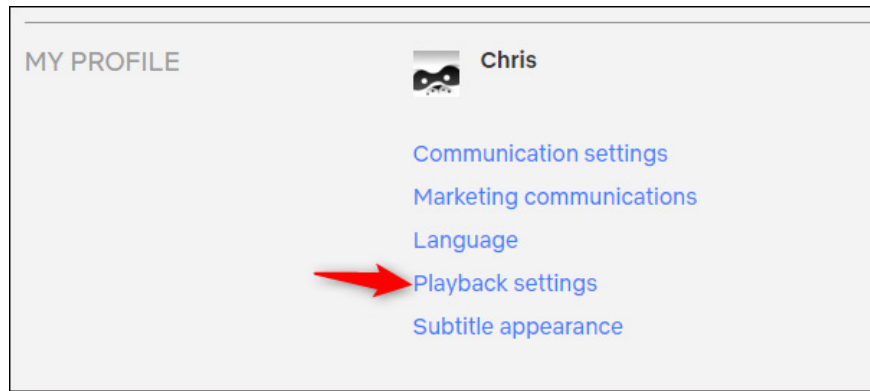
Step 2:

Step 3:

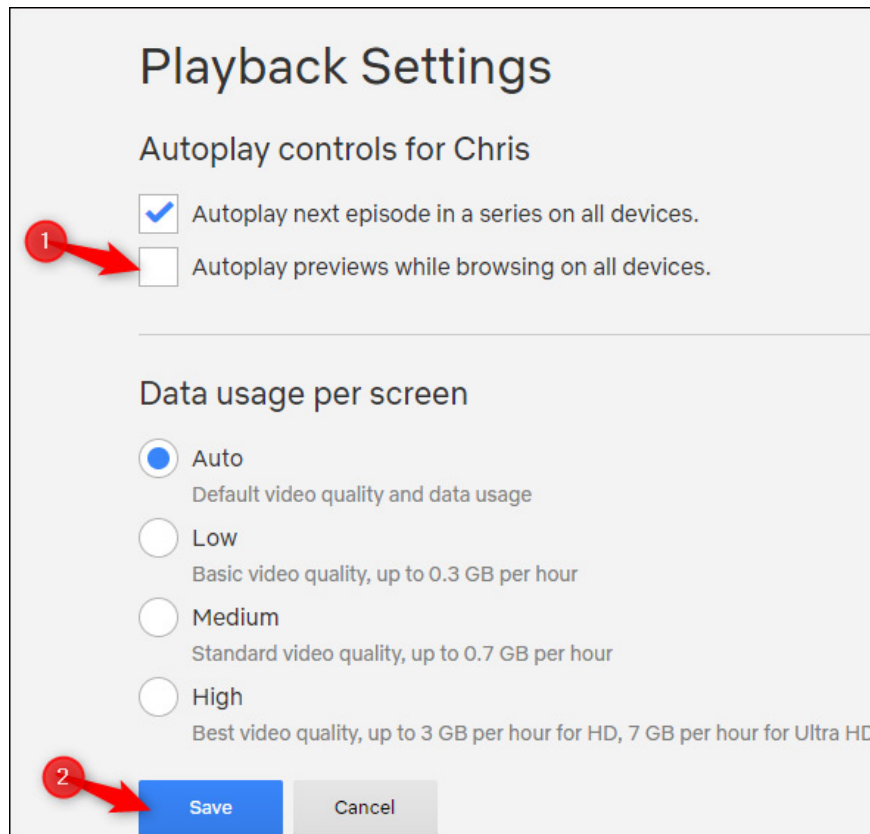
Switch to the new interface, look at **My Profile**, then look to the right to find **Playback settings** .



Then the Autoplay controls for . section will have 2 options to set the autoplay mode. We **uncheck the box for Autoplay previews while browsing on all devices** and **click Save** below to save.

Autoplay next episode in a series on all devices will enable / disable auto-play of the next video in the series you are watching.

In case you use multiple Netflix profiles, it must be set up for each account.
