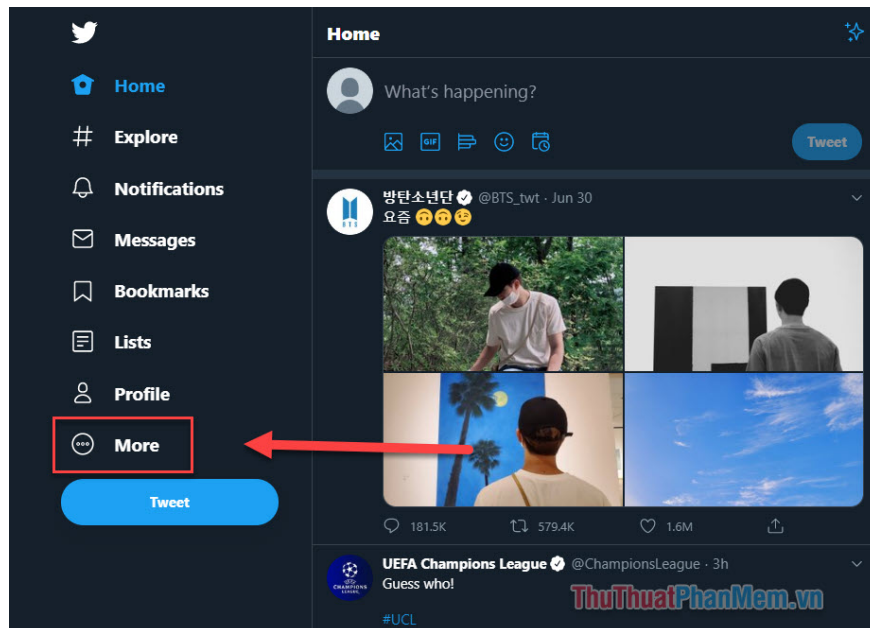


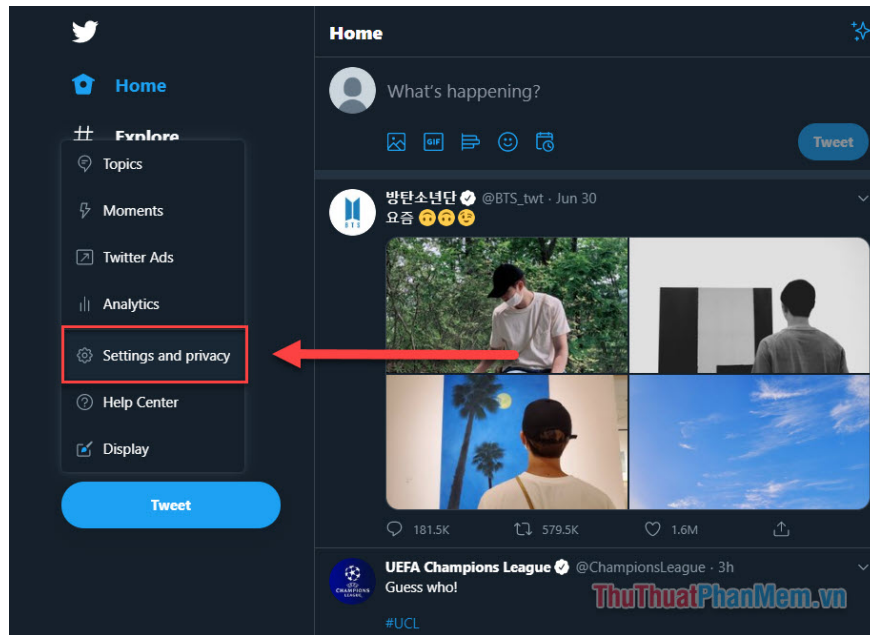
How to turn off autoplay videos on social networks

Autoplaying video is a convenient feature, but sometimes it also comes with the hassle of playing unwanted videos or taking away your 3G capacity. To limit that, turn off the auto-play video by following steps!

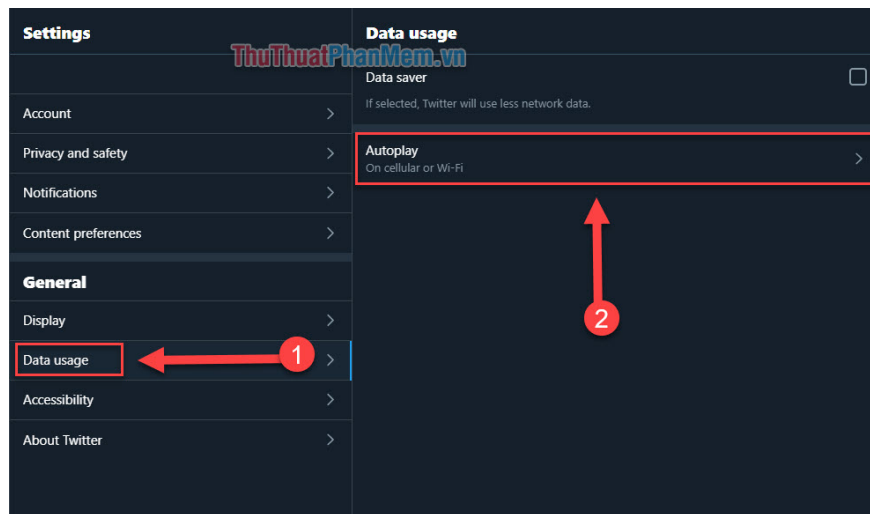
Turn off autoplay video on Twitter

On the Twitter.com website, point to the **3-dot icon (More)** and select **Settings and privacy** .

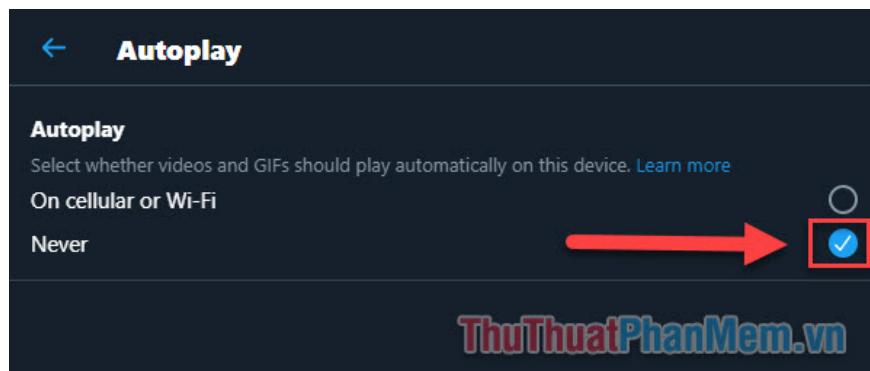




At the **Settings** interface , navigate to **Data usage** >> open **Autoplay** settings .



Check **Never** is done, the video, Gif on the homepage will never play automatically again.



For iOS and Android phone applications you do the following: Click on your profile page >> open **Settings and privacy** .

Next step select **Display and sound** :

Now you have 2 options:

1. Turn on data saving: The videos will not automatically play and images appear with lower mode.

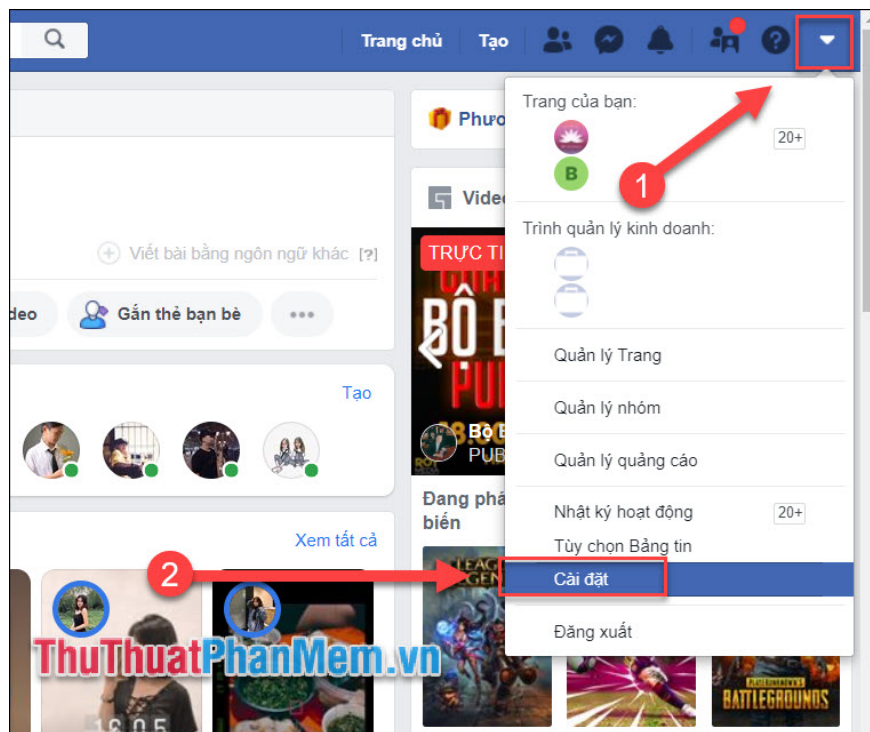
2. Only turn off autoplay video and still download high quality images: You click **Auto play video** then set it to **Never** .

Turn off auto-play videos on Facebook

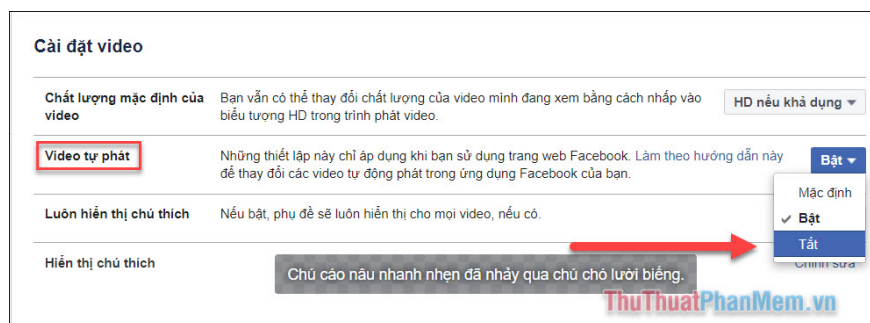
Similarly, how to turn off auto-play video is also very simple. If you use the Facebook website, click **the drop down arrow** in the upper right and select **Settings** .



Navigate to the **Video** settings .



In the **Spontaneous Video** setting , you switch to **Off** as complete.



For the mobile version of Facebook, do the following: Click the **3-dash** icon in the lower right corner of the screen >> **Settings & privacy** .

In the drop down menu, select **Settings** .

Navigate to the **Videos and Photos section** .

Open the **Auto-play** section , then select **Never auto-play Video** .

Disable autoplay videos on Instagram

Instagram actually doesn't offer the option to turn off fully automatic video playback. But you can use less data, which is useful if you are a bandwidth-saving user. On a mobile phone, go to your profile and click the **3 dashes** icon in the top corner.

In the settings menu, navigate to the **Account section** .

Next go to **Use mobile data** .

For the YouTube video sharing application, simply turn off the auto-play feature right below the video being watched.
