How to turn off beta updates on iPhone

Step 1:


Users **tap on Settings, then select General Settings** . Next, they choose **Software Update** to make adjustments.



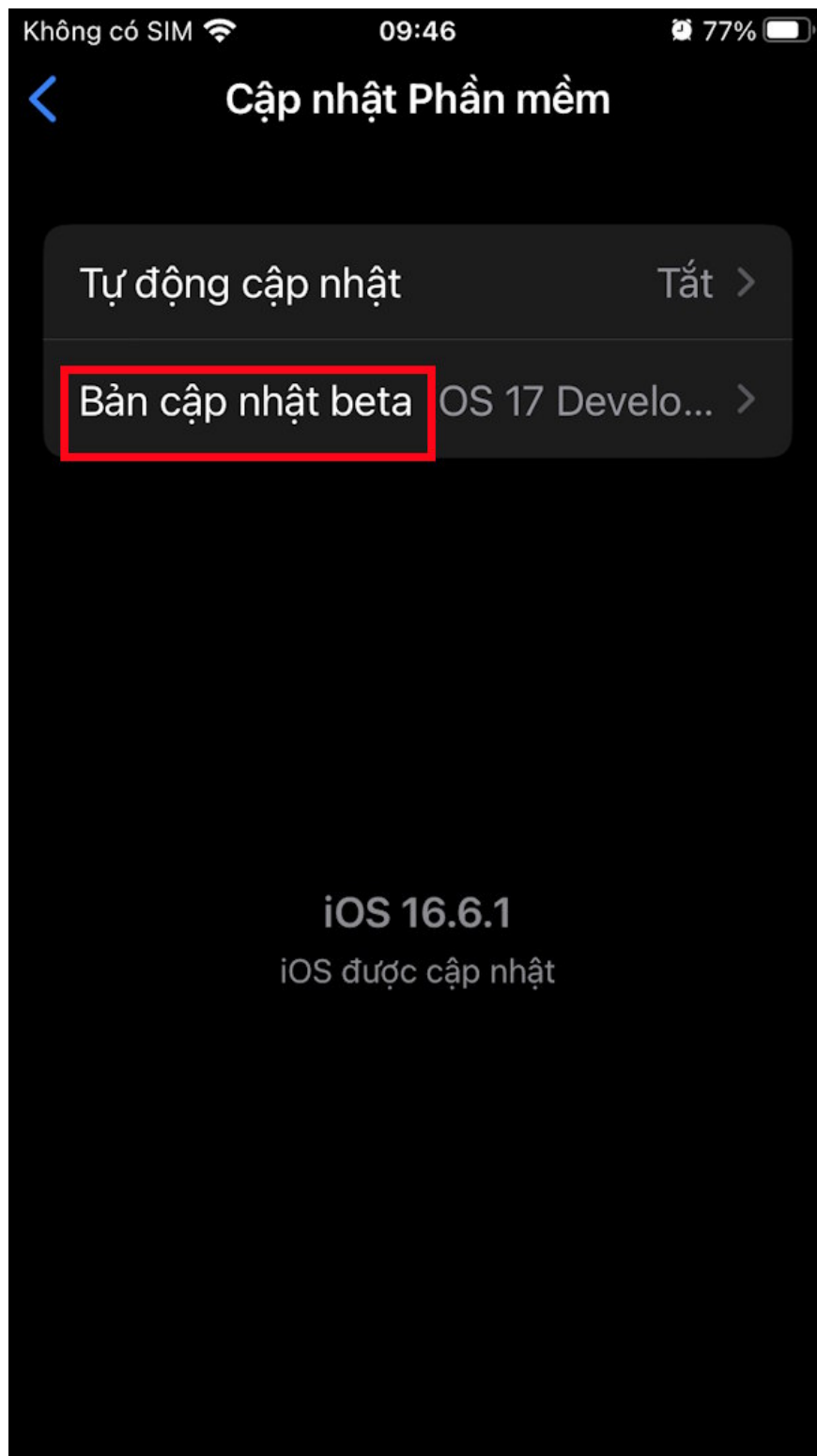

How to exit beta updates on iPhone

If you want to stop receiving beta updates for your iPhone, you first need to unsubscribe from the device.

After disabling beta updates on your iPhone, you need to access the link below to exit the beta operating system update program.

1. Unsubscribe from the iPhone beta update program.

After leaving Apple's beta update program, you will stop receiving emails and will no longer be able to send feedback through Feedback Assistant. Additionally, beta updates will no longer appear in the iPhone's Software Updates section.

When a new version of the iOS operating system is released, you need to install it via Software Update on your iPhone.
