

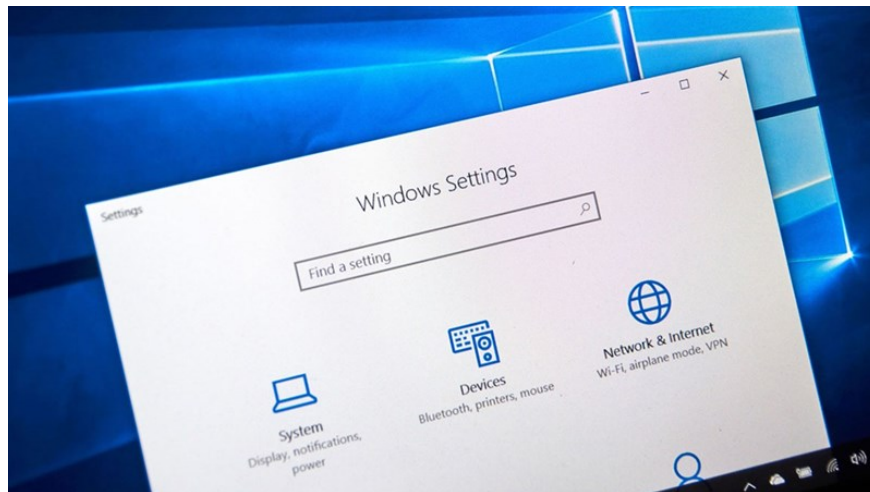
How to turn off drag and drop feature on laptop Touchpad

The touchpad on a laptop acts as a computer mouse. However, users often make mistakes because of the drag and drop feature on the touchpad. So how to turn it off!

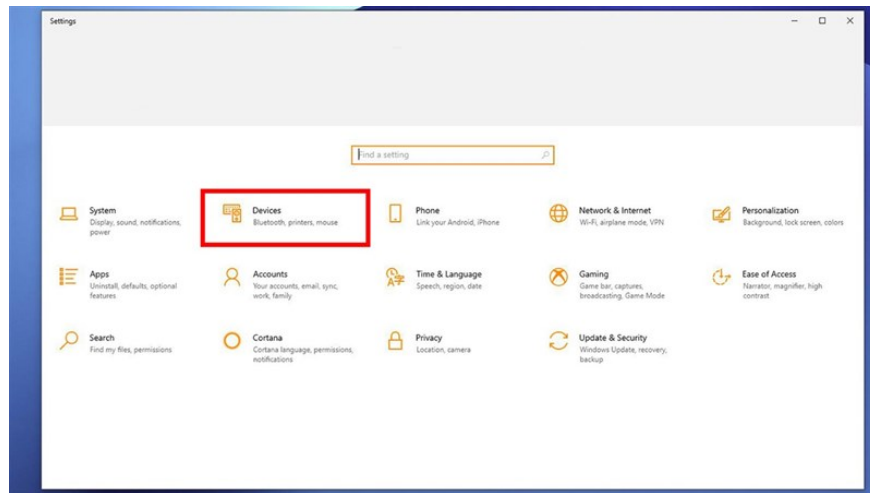

How to turn off Touchpad drag and drop

Step 1. To turn off this feature, you need to know how to access the Settings section on Windows. You can press the Windows + i key combination to open it quickly.

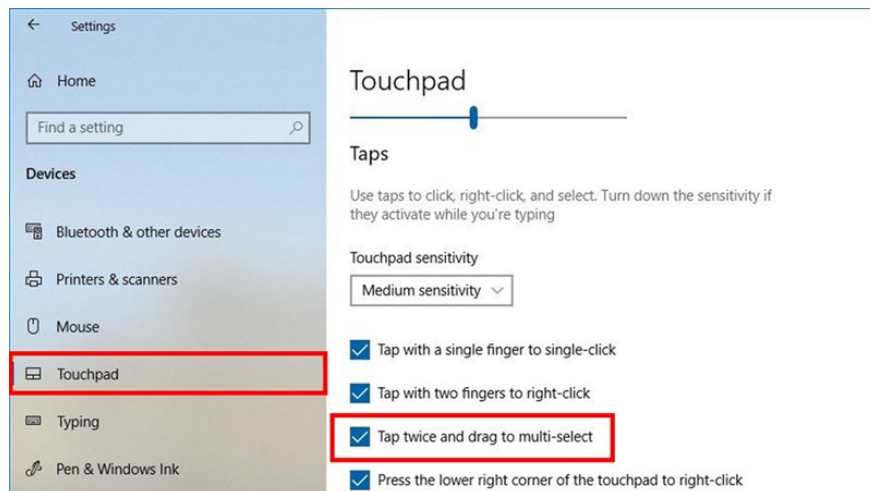


Step 2. First, select Devices.



Step 3. Select Touchpad on the left and uncheck Tap twice and drag to multi-select.

Note: When you turn off this option, you will turn off the double-click to move folder feature. Other features remain the same.
