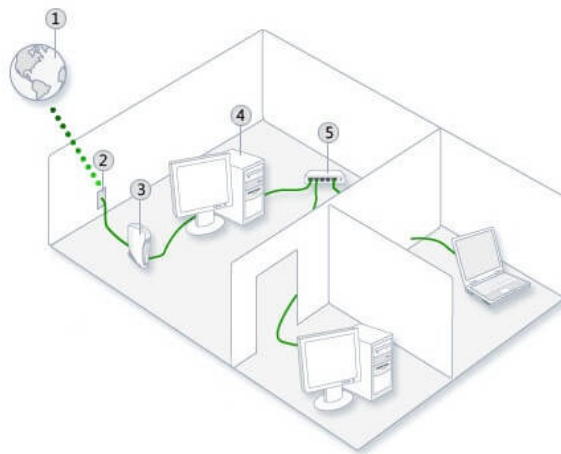


How to turn off Internet Connection Sharing on Windows

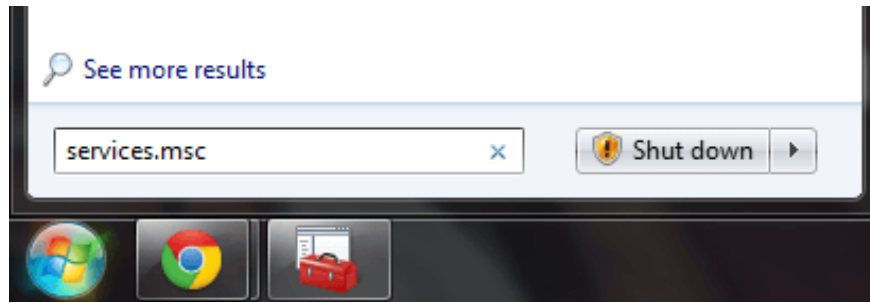
Disable Internet Connection Sharing

Disable Internet Connection Sharing on Windows:

To disable Internet Connection Sharing on a Windows computer, follow the steps below:

Step 1:

First click Start, then enter **services.msc** into the Search box and press Enter.

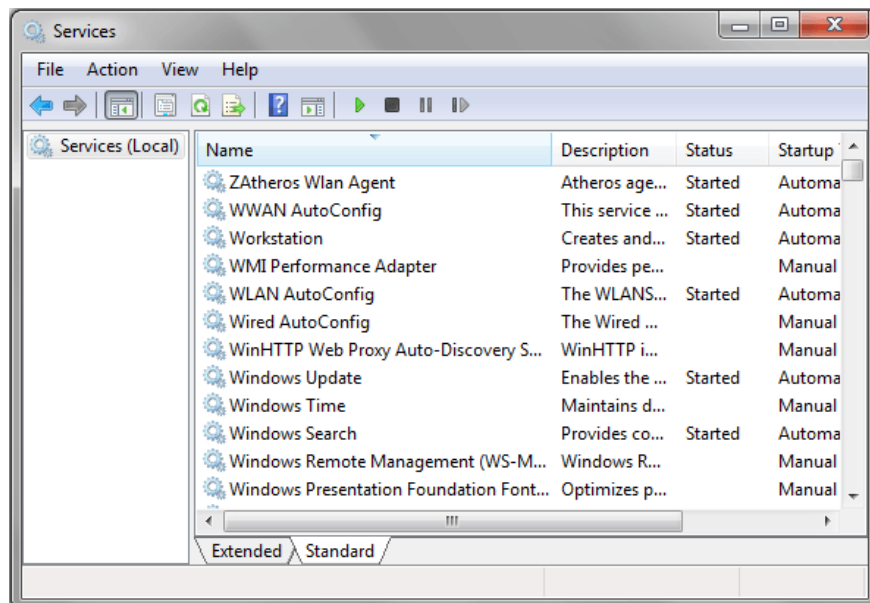


Note:

If you're using Windows XP, first open the Run command window, then enter **services.msc** into it and press Enter.

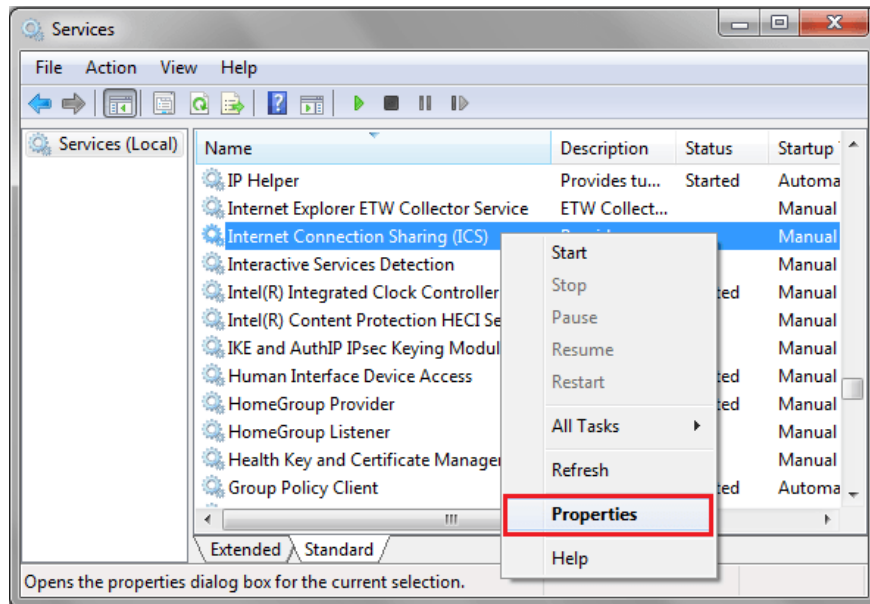
Step 2:

The Services window will now appear.



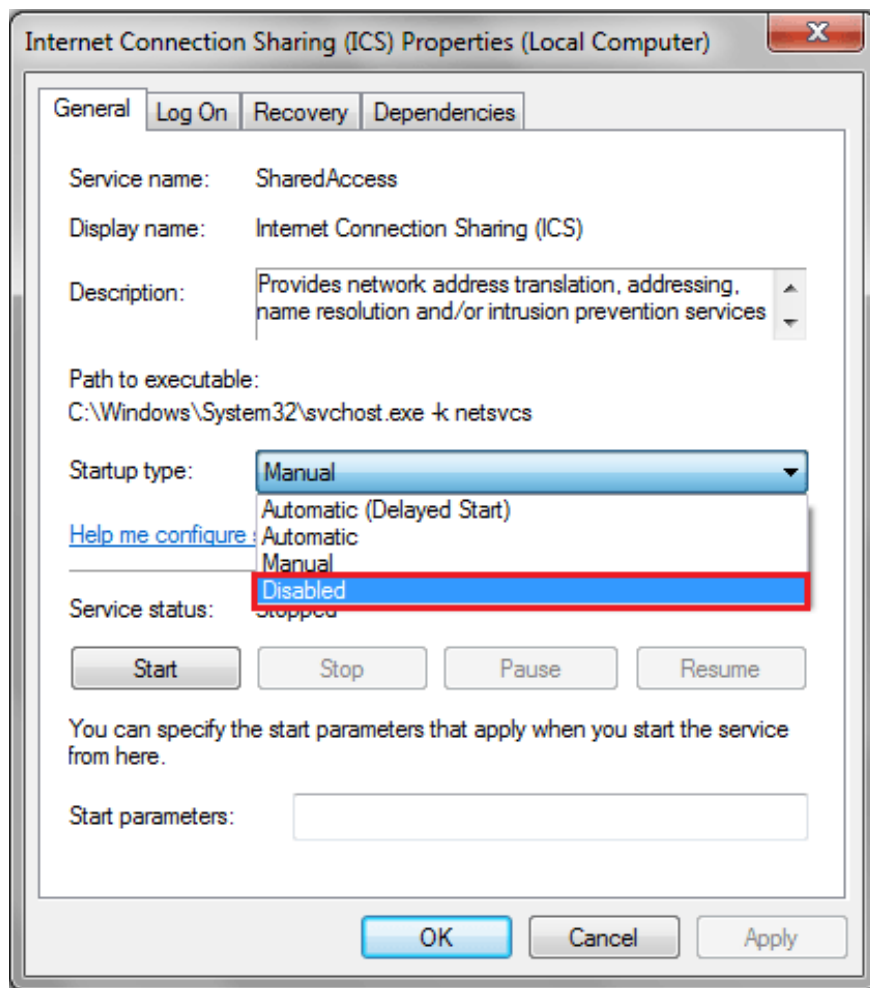
Step 3:

On the Services window, scroll down to find an option called **Internet Connection Sharing (ICS)** . Right-click that option and select **Properties** .



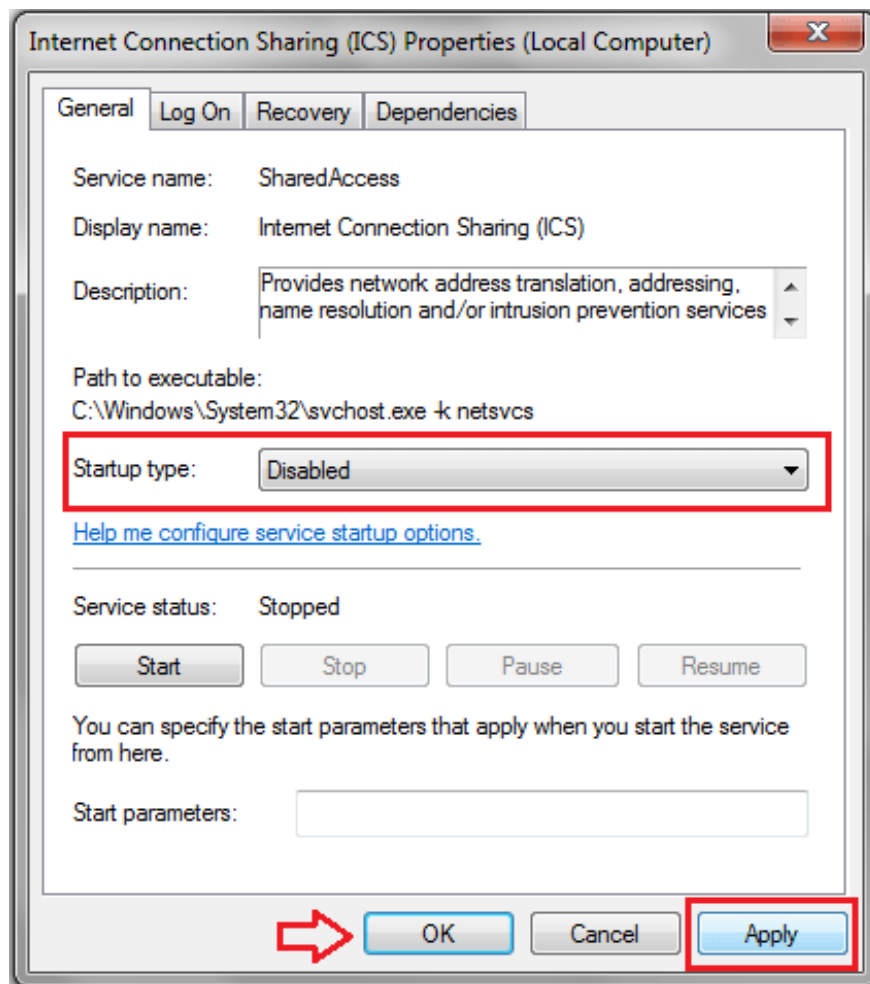
Step 4:

On the Internet Connection Sharing dialog box (ICS) Properties, on the **Startup Type** options menu, select **Disabled**.



Step 5:

Once done, click **Apply** then click **OK** to save the changes.



Step 6:

At this time, Internet Connection Sharing (ICS) has been completely disabled.
