

How to turn off laptop screen but still keep the computer running on Windows 10

Sometimes you want to turn off your computer screen when resting but still maintain the operation, or more specifically, gamers who play online and want to save battery? But how many people know how to turn off the laptop screen but the computer is still working?

While using a laptop, we often wonder "How to turn off the laptop screen but the computer is still running?". Because sometimes, we don't need to use the laptop anymore, or don't need to see the information on the screen but still want the applications to stay active. Or sometimes we just want to save a little battery when going out without a charger. So how to turn off the laptop screen but the computer is still running? Follow the article below of Hanoicomputer to know this trick!

Feature to turn off the screen but the device is still running

Through the versions developed from Window XP, Window 7, Window 8 and the latest Window 10, Window operating system developers are increasingly paying more attention to user experience. And the application you are interested in is **how to turn off the screen but the computer is still running**, which is one of the countless features that the Window 10 platform allows. With this feature, we can maintain and use all applications on Windows as if we were using a desktop computer with the screen off. Currently, there are 2 simple ways to do it, which are using the hard key to turn off the power and put the computer to sleep mode (Sleep).

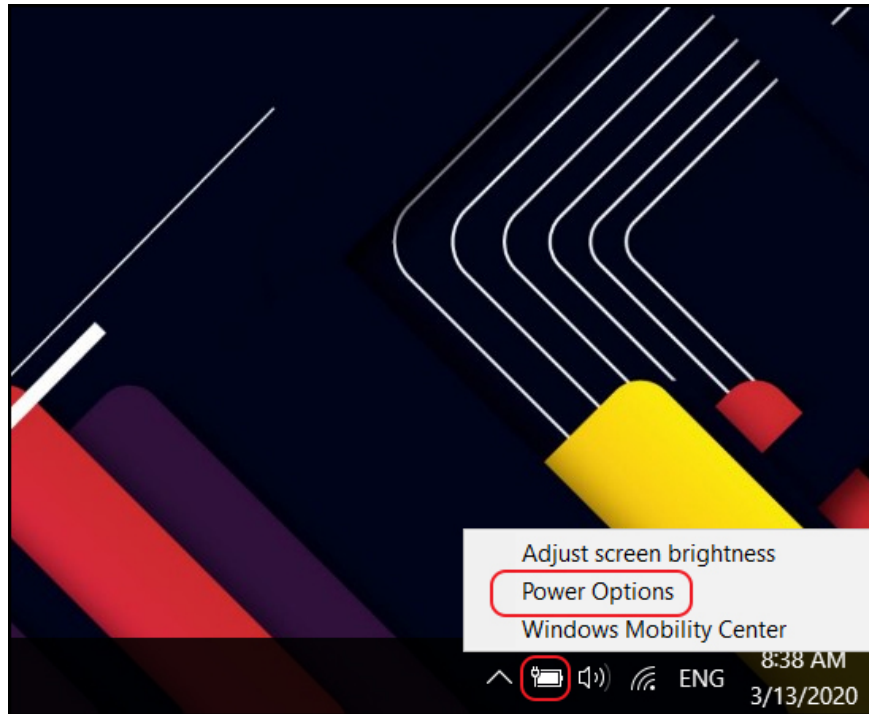
In sleep mode, the CPU and disk still operate normally, however, all operating states of the open program are suspended and saved in RAM. Conversely, when turning off the screen with the hard key, all processes being executed on the computer such as copying, updating windows, rendering images. still operate normally.

Ways to turn off laptop screen but still keep the computer running on Windows 10

Fold the laptop screen but the computer still works

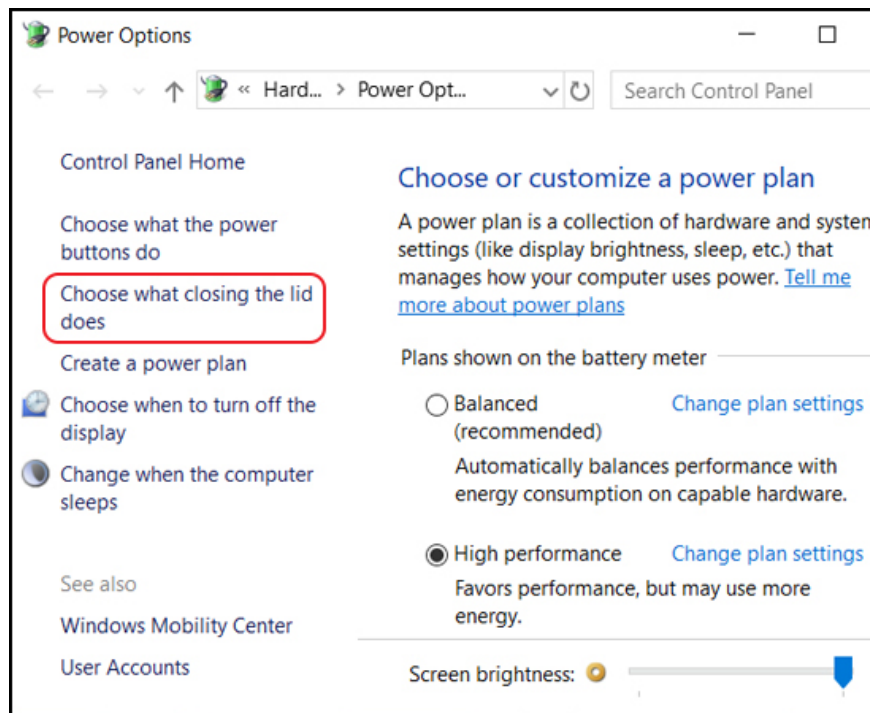
Step 1: Right click on the Battery icon

First, right-click on the **Battery** icon in the lower left corner of the screen and then select **Power Option** .



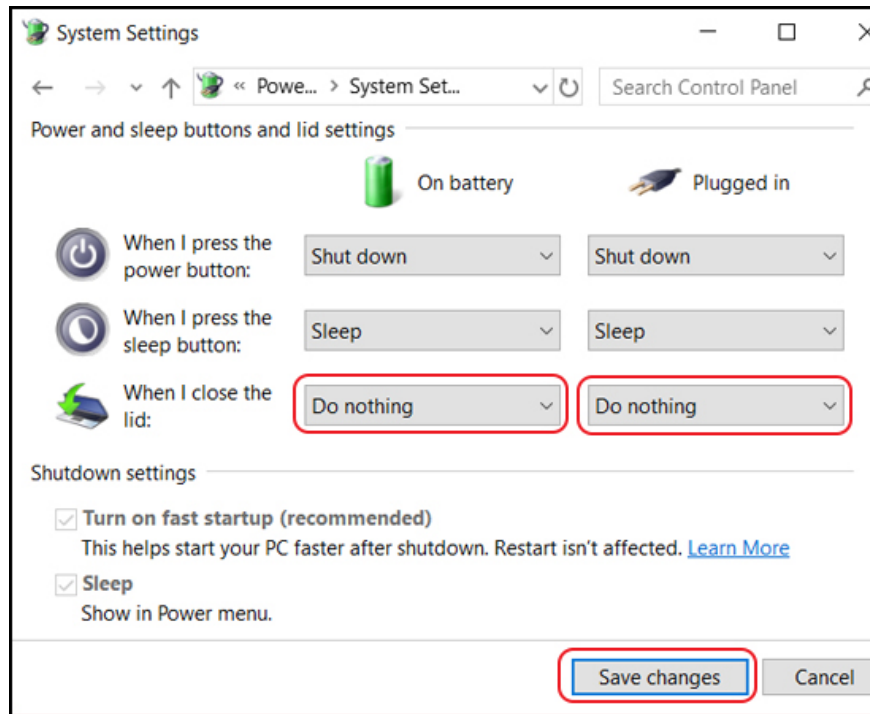
Step 2: Select Choose what closing the lid does

Then the **Power Option** window appears, select **Choose what closing the lid does** .



Step 3: Select Do nothing

Here you select **Do nothing** in the line **When I close the lid** for both columns **On battery** and **Plugged in** then **Save changes** as shown below.



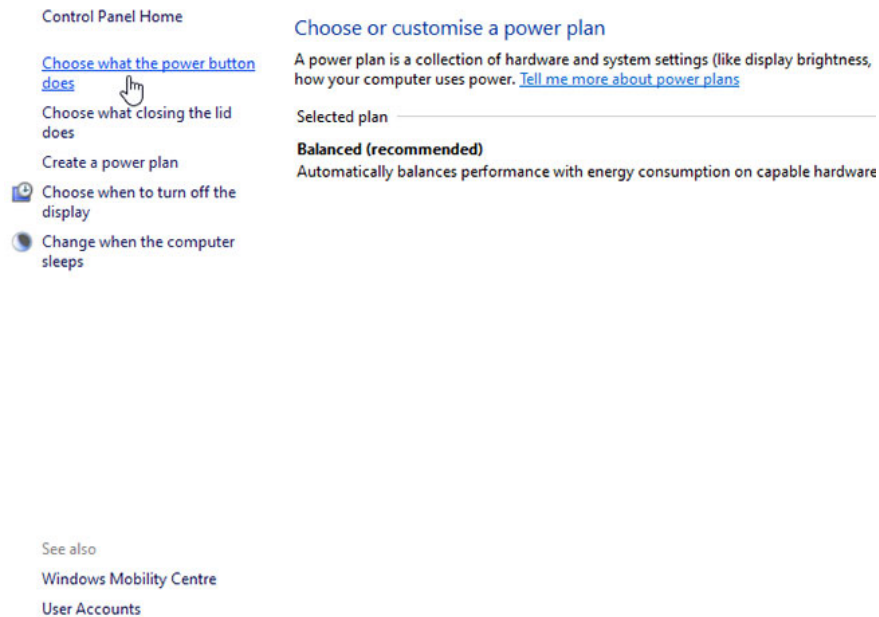
Turn off the screen with the function key

The next way to turn off the screen with a quick function key while the computer is still running is as follows: From the keyboard, press the key combination Fn + F6. (Depending on the specific design of each manufacturer, the key to turn off the screen may be different for different manufacturers. For example: if your laptop is ASUS, there is another extremely simple trick. Just press the key combination Fn + F7 and you can turn off the laptop screen while the program is still running in the background. For other brands, you do the same, hold Fn and press one of the keys from F1 to F12 with the X symbol on the screen.

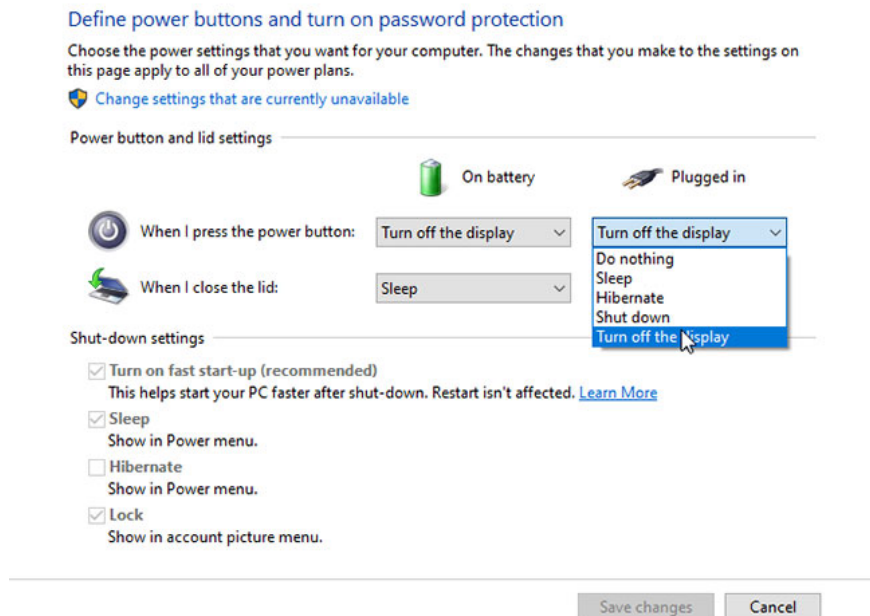
Turn off laptop screen with power switch button

Normally, the power button is often associated with the function of turning the device on or off. However, we can also set the function of this hard key to a function key used to turn off the screen.

First, we right-click on the battery icon in the upper right corner of the Taskbar and click on Power Options. Then, click on **Choose what the power button does** .



In this section, we can choose 2 forms when the device uses direct power and when using battery, what can we do when pressing the power button. In the corresponding sections, find the line **When I press the power button** and select **Turn off the display** .

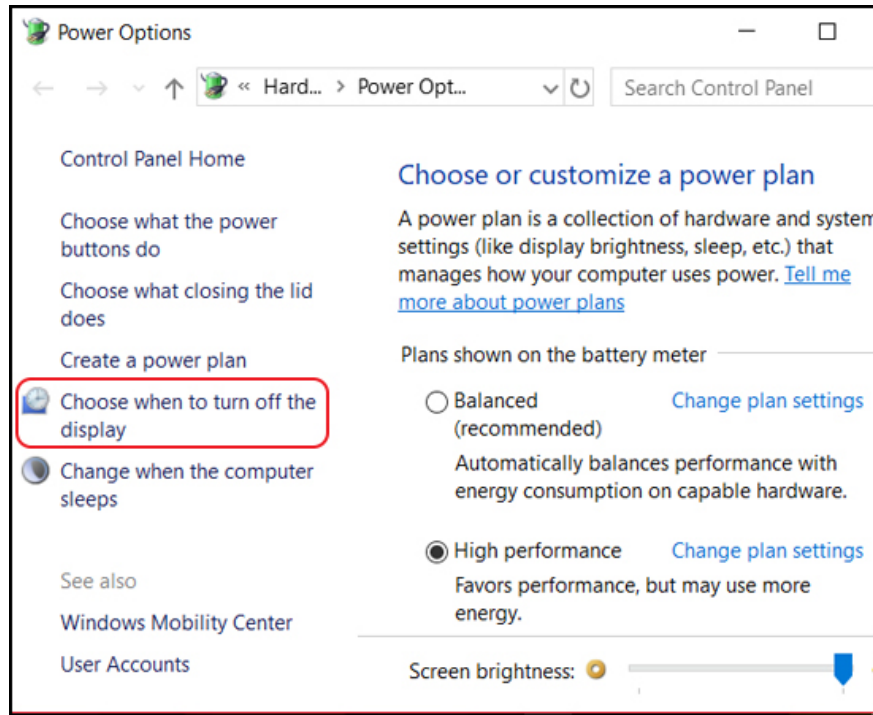


After completing the above operation, when you press the power button, your laptop screen will automatically turn off. However, do not hold the power button for too long as it will cause the device to turn off.

Set the computer to automatically turn off the screen after a certain period of time

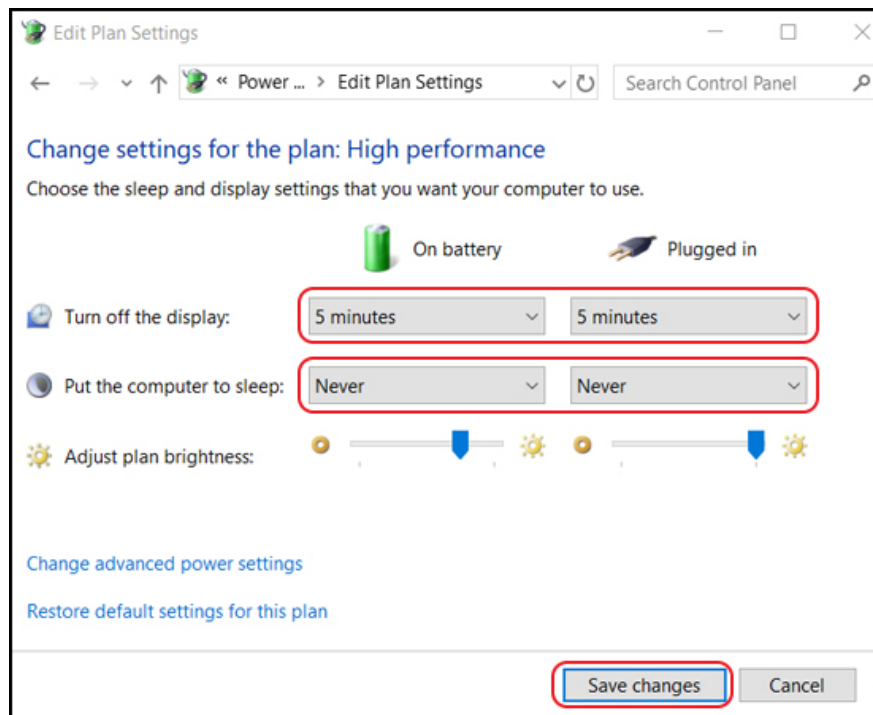
Step 1: Select Choose when to turn off the display

The Power Option window appears, select Choose when to turn off the display.



Step 2: Select screen off time

You choose the time to turn off the screen for the 2 columns On battery and Plugged in in the line Turn off the display and turn off Sleep mode when the computer screen turns off by selecting Never in the line Put the computer to sleep. Finally, you select Save changes to save the changes.
