

How to turn off self-running videos on Microsoft Edge

Microsoft Edge has updated the video and audio blocking feature. So how to turn off the auto-play feature on the Edge browser?

The auto-play feature (Autoplay media) on Microsoft Edge when browsing the web will sometimes cause trouble for users when the audio or video automatically runs. Not to mention that if you use mobile data networks, the automatic playback of this video also takes a lot of space, if users do not know to turn them off. In the new update on Windows 10 build 17704, Microsoft has improved Edge browser quite a lot, including the feature to customize the mode to automatically play videos on the browser.

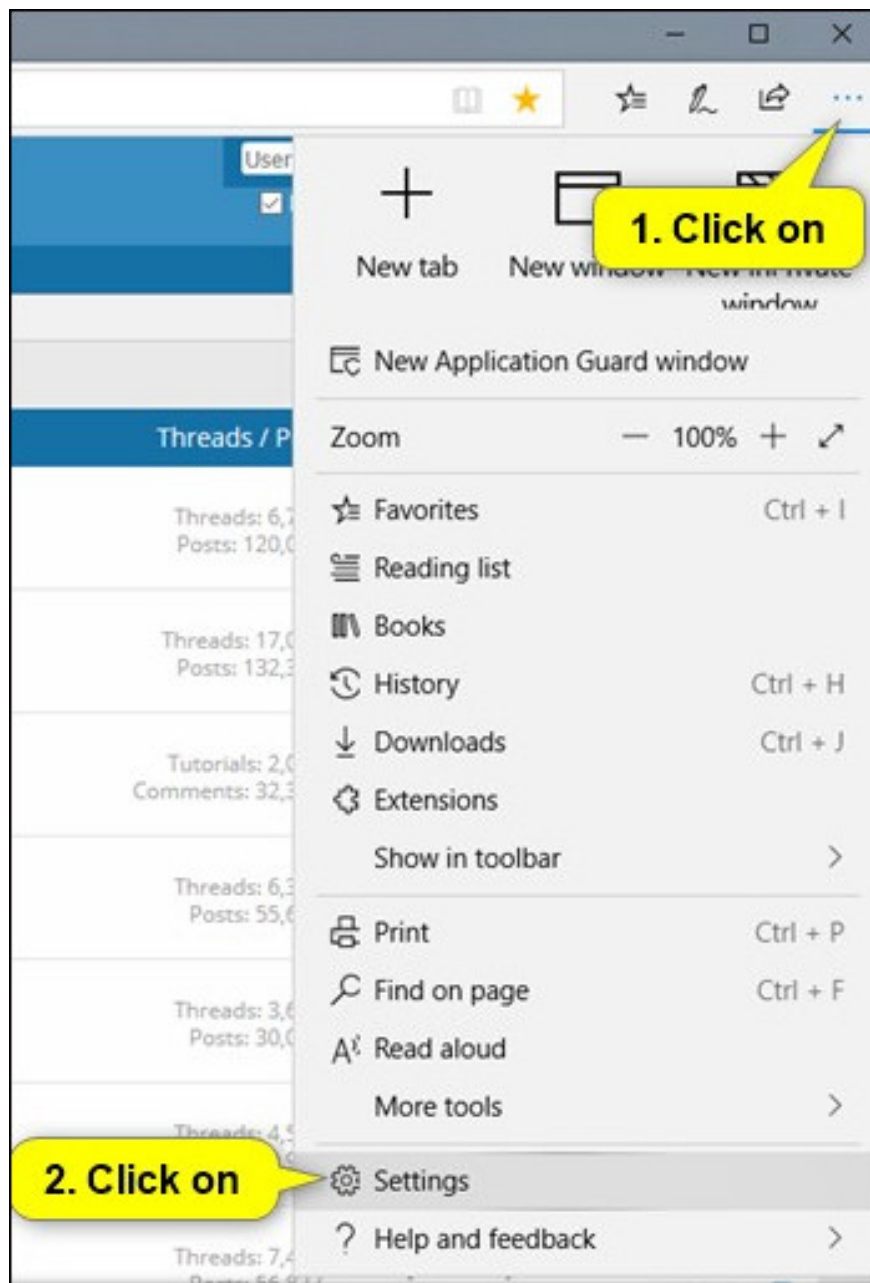
Accordingly, users can choose to play only the video without sound, or turn off all video or audio on the browser. The following article will guide you how to turn off self-running videos on Microsoft Edge.

Instructions to turn off videos automatically played on Microsoft Edge

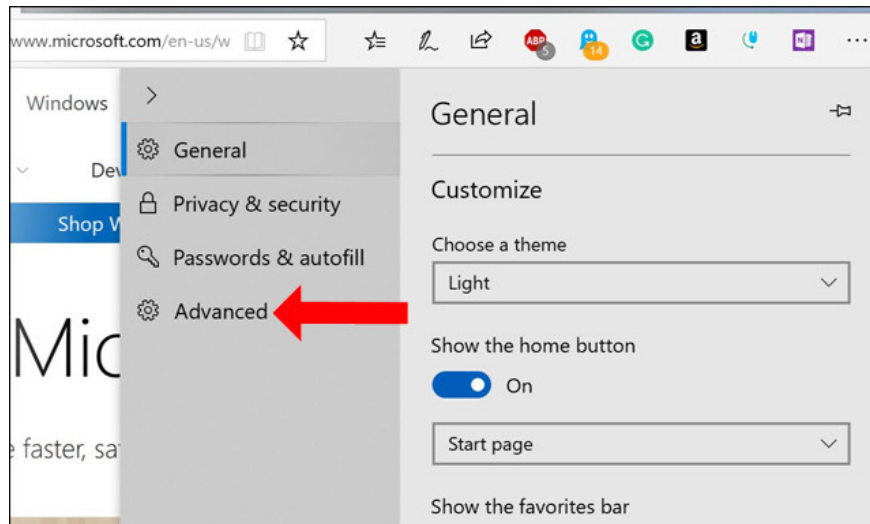
Step 1:

At the Microsoft Edge web browser interface click on **the 3 horizontal dots icon** in the top corner, right of the screen, then select **Settings** .



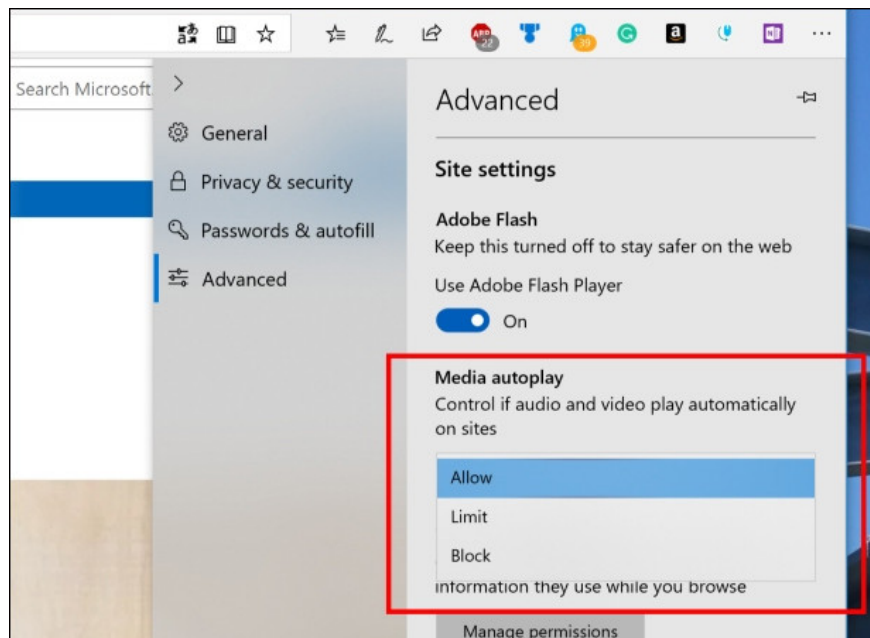
Step 2:

Next, click **the Advanced button** .

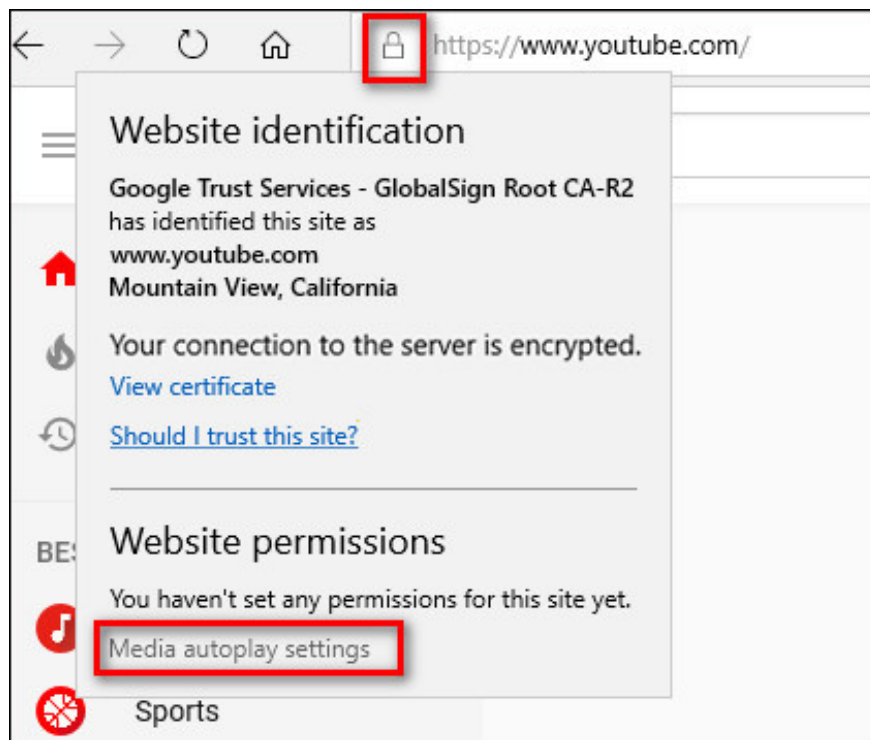


In the Advanced Media Autoplay section, there are 3 customizations for automatically turning off videos running on the Edge browser.

1. Allow: automatically run media content on web pages, set the default mode on the browser.
2. Limit: Turn off all videos that have audio on the site, and those that do not have audio will still be played.
3. Block: turn off all videos and audio on the browser.



In case the user wants to turn off the video automatically on some pages, click **the lock icon** next to the address bar. A pop-up dialog box appears, select **Media autoplay settings** . Users will then have the option to turn off the audio file as above.



Updating the video auto-shutdown feature on Microsoft Edge is similar to Chrome, Firefox will save you mobile data networks. If you still want to play the video, you can choose to play only videos without sound.
