How to turn off screen sharing protection on Android

Step 1:

Go to Settings on your phone, then **tap About Phone** as shown below. Tap Software Information if available.

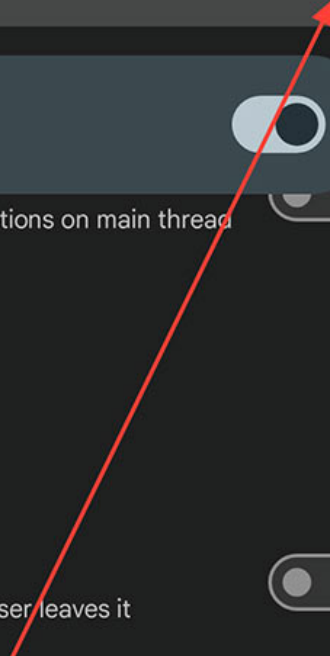
