

# How to turn off the message to restart the Windows 10 computer after the update

After updating the Windows 10 system, the computer will automatically show a reboot of the computer system, making users very uncomfortable. So how to turn off the message to restart the computer?

Updating Windows 10 operating system can be done right on the system, with automatic updates or you can download the installation file and then proceed with the upgrade. And by default, after the Windows 10 computer has been upgraded to a new version, it will prompt to restart the computer.

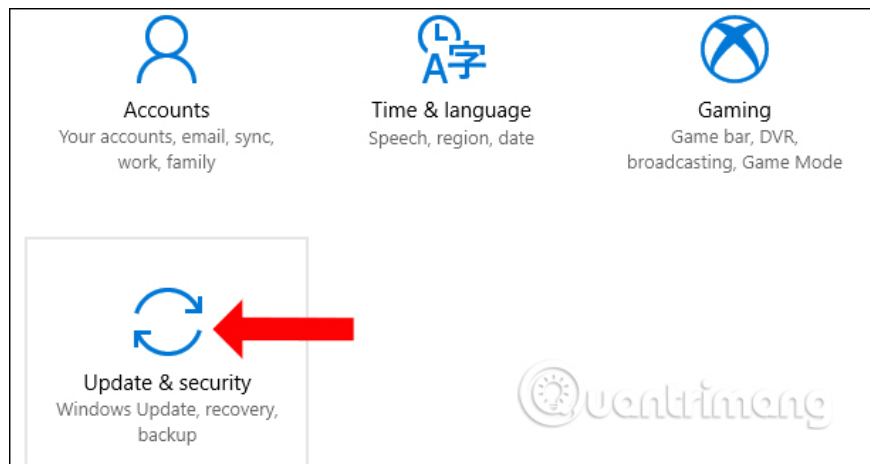
This message will continue to be displayed on the screen until the computer is restarted. Of course, you don't always restart the computer immediately and need to work, but repeated notifications are annoying. So what is the way to turn off the restart message after the update?

## How to turn off restart notification of Win 10 computer after update

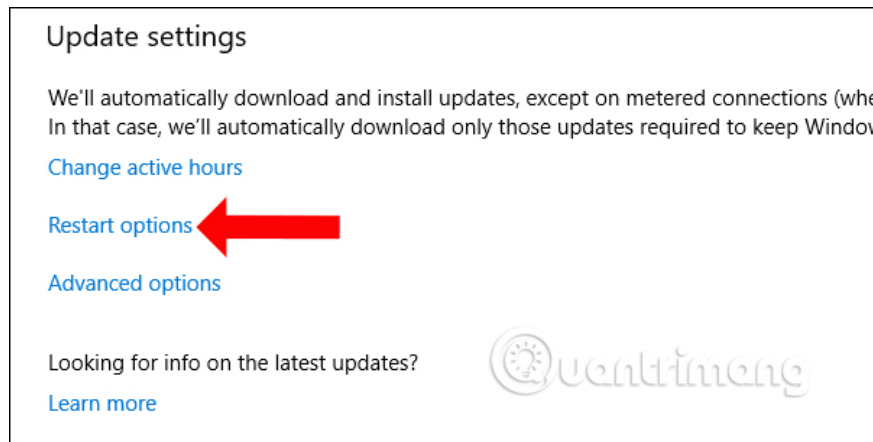
### Step 1:

Click on **the Settings icon** on your computer, or press the Windows + I key combination to open the Windows Settings interface. Then click on **Update & Security** .



### Step 2:

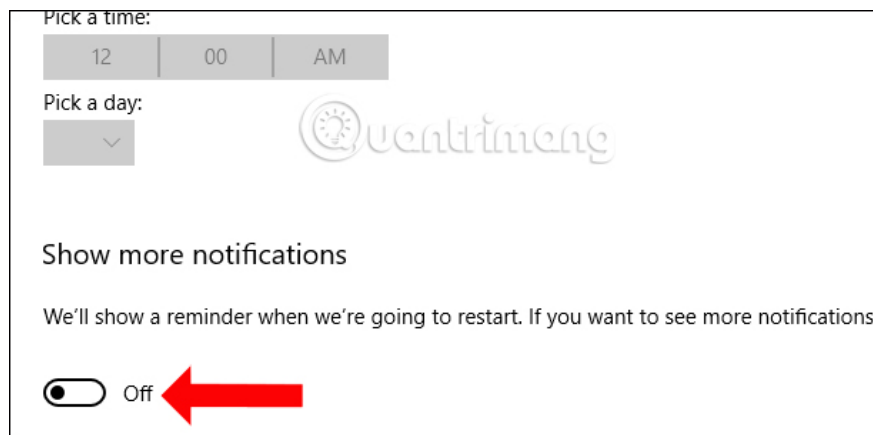
In the new interface click on **Restart options** option in the Update settings section.



### Step 3:

Switch to this new interface, users will see in the section Show more notifications by default turn on the notification after the computer has updated to the new version of Windows 10.

To turn off the message to restart the computer after updating, switch to **Off state** .



Thus, with simple customization on the system we can turn off the message to restart the Win 10 computer after upgrading the operating system. The message will not display continuously on the screen, affecting your work.
