

How to turn off the notice of iPhone installation complete

If you recently updated the software version on your iPhone or iPad, you may receive a prompt from the Settings app to complete device settings.

If you recently updated the software version on your iPhone or iPad, you may receive a prompt from the Settings app to complete device settings.

This message usually appears because when you set up iOS, you missed some steps like activating Siri or setting up Apple Pay.

If you do not intend to set these features up, installation notifications and notification numbers can be annoying for you. Fortunately, it's easy to get rid of them with the following steps.

3. How to customize notifications on iPhone

Step 1 . Launch the Settings application.

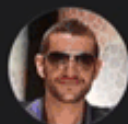


Step 2 . Touch Finish Setting Up Your iPhone / iPad .

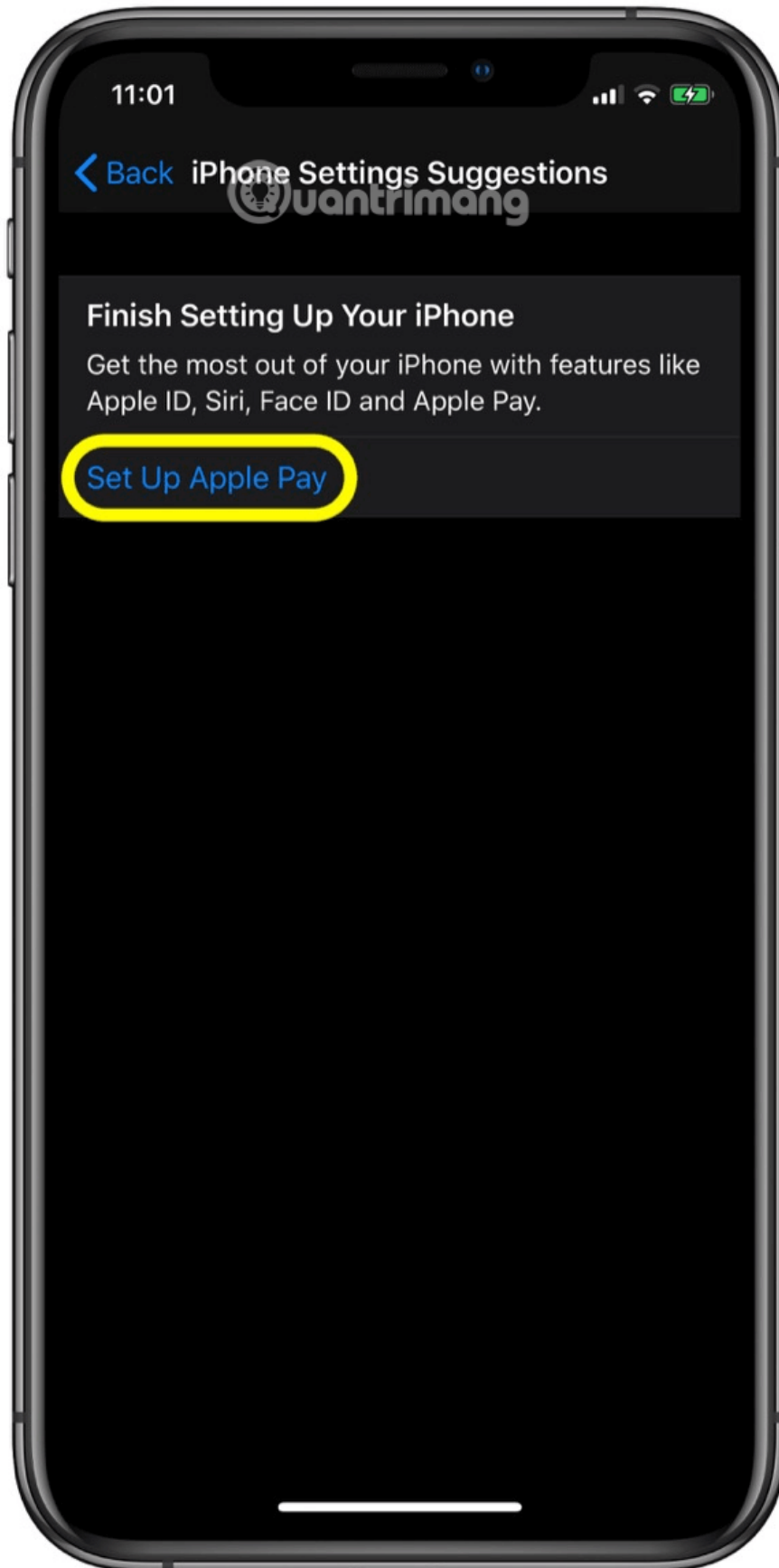

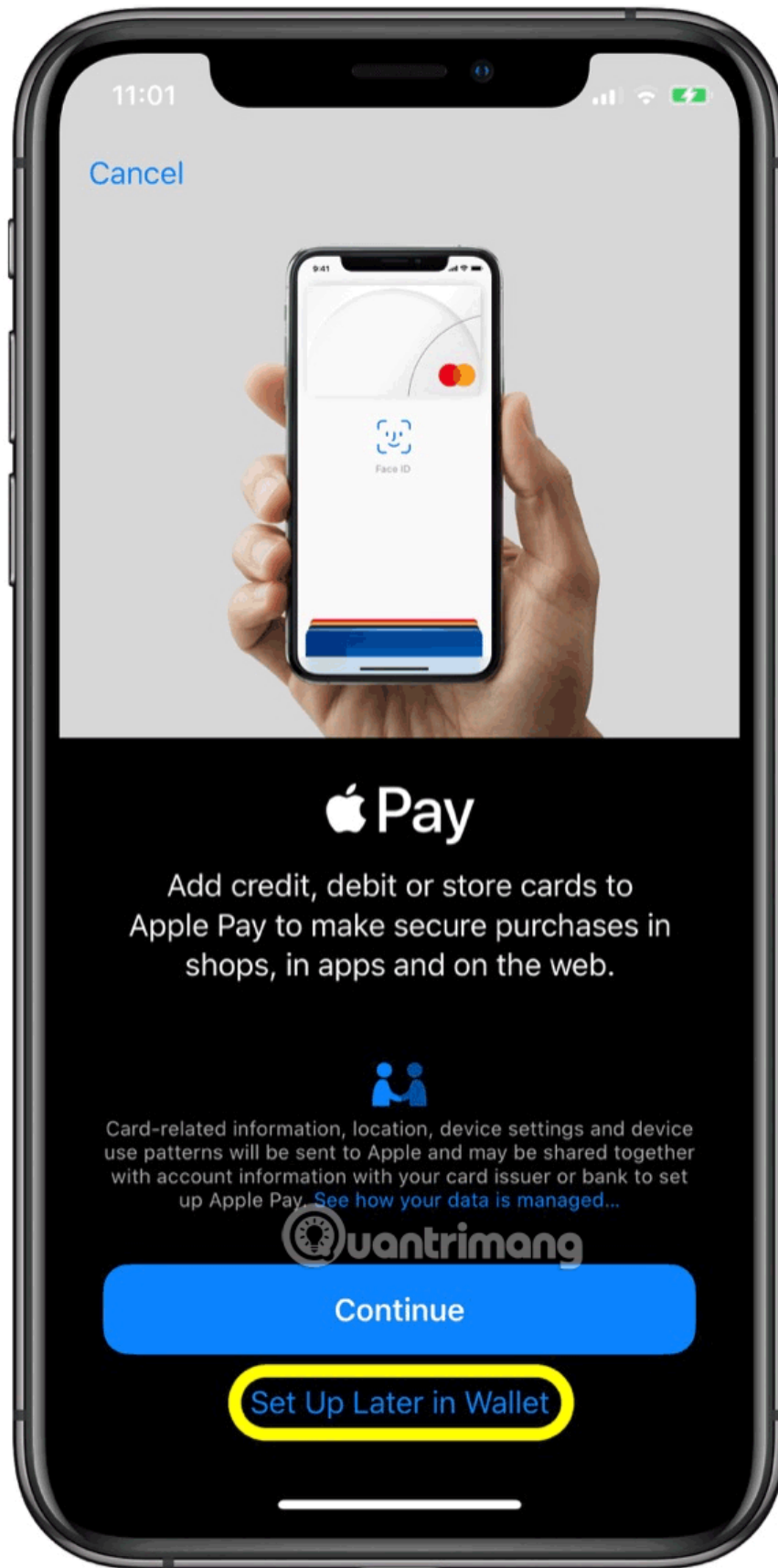
