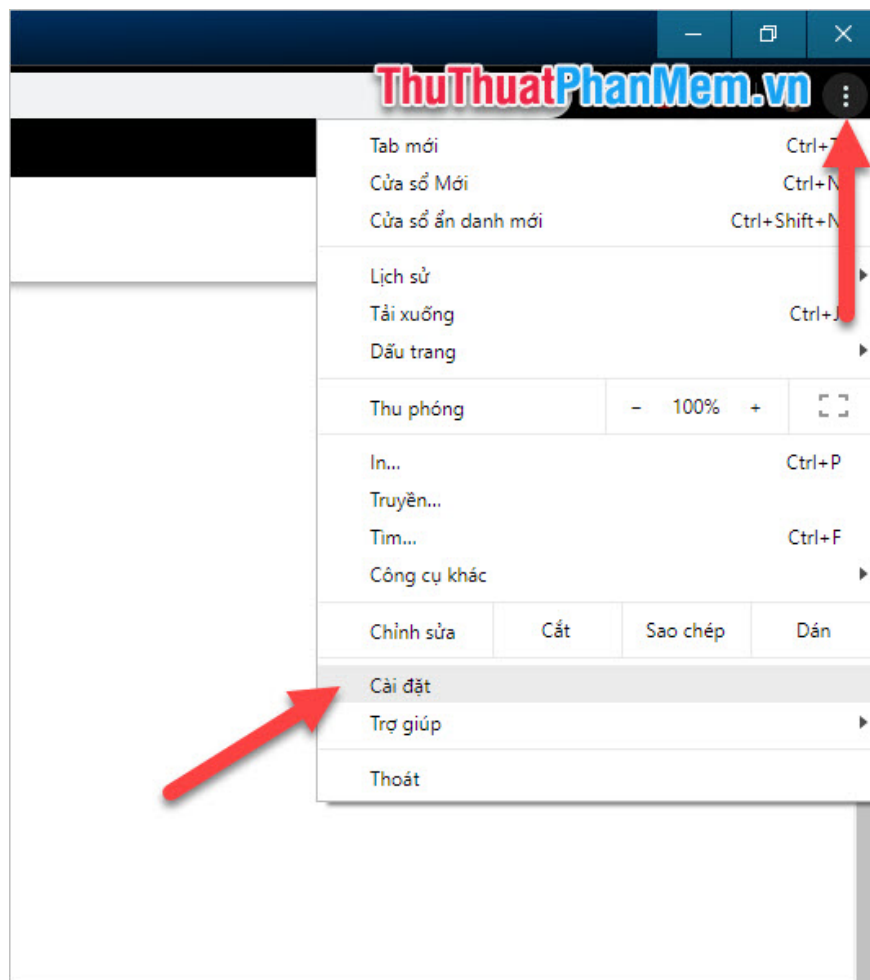

Step 1

Click open on the icon of 3 vertical dots in the right corner of the Chrome browser interface. This is the **Setting** option icon .

Click on **Settings** .



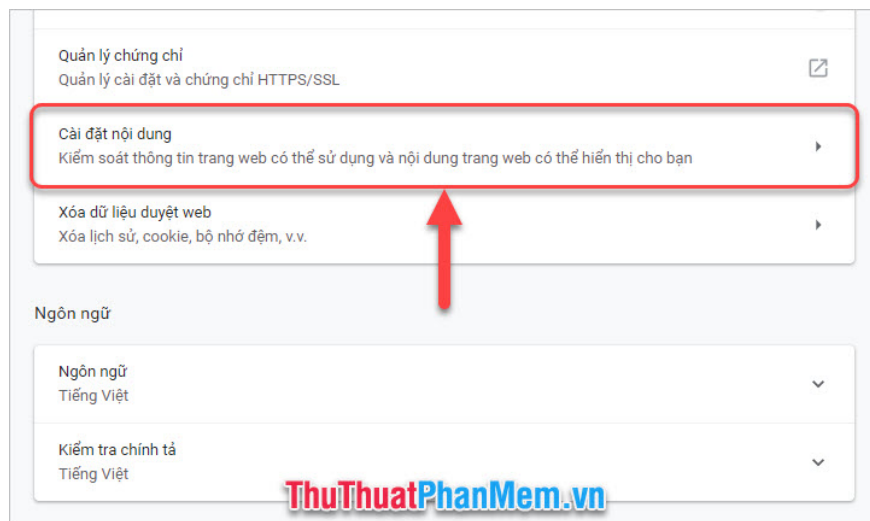
Step 2

After opening the **Settings** tab , you scroll down to the bottom of the page and click on **Advanced** because the settings to receive notifications on Chrome are only in the advanced settings.



Step 3

Search for **Content setting** item , click open this item.



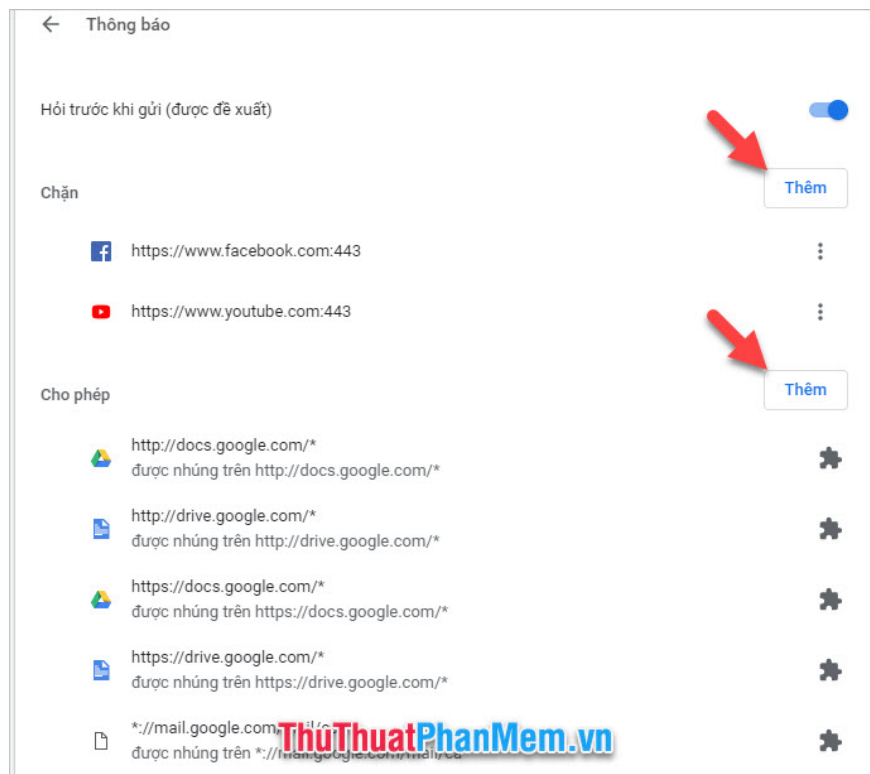
Step 4

In **the Content** settings section, there will be **Notifications** settings that you search.

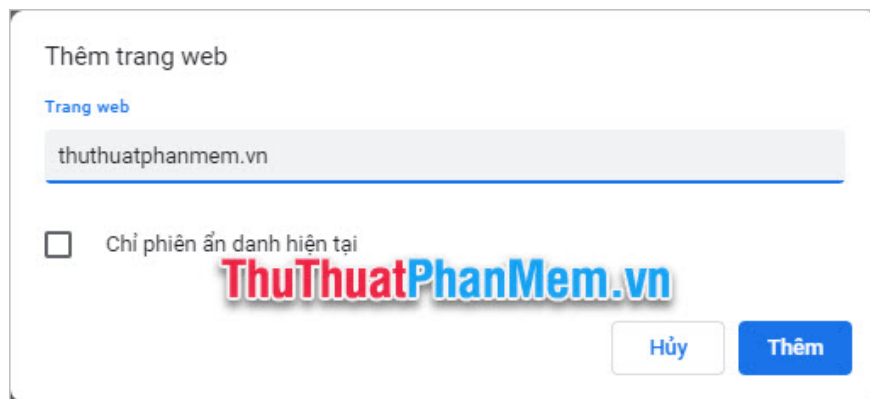


Step 5

Here you can install more or less web pages that your browser will block / allow to display notifications.



For example, if you want to display a notification of a web page, click the Add button of the **Allow** section, then enter the address of the website and click **Add** .



If you want to block site notifications, do the same thing with the **Block** section .

Or if you turn off the pre-ask function then the browser will not ask you every time you go to a new website to send you notifications, it will automatically block all notifications for you.
