

How to turn off the notification Your Windows license will expire soon Windows 10

On Windows 10, the message 'Your Windows license will expire soon' will appear, which will make users uncomfortable every time they start their computer. So how to turn off this notification.

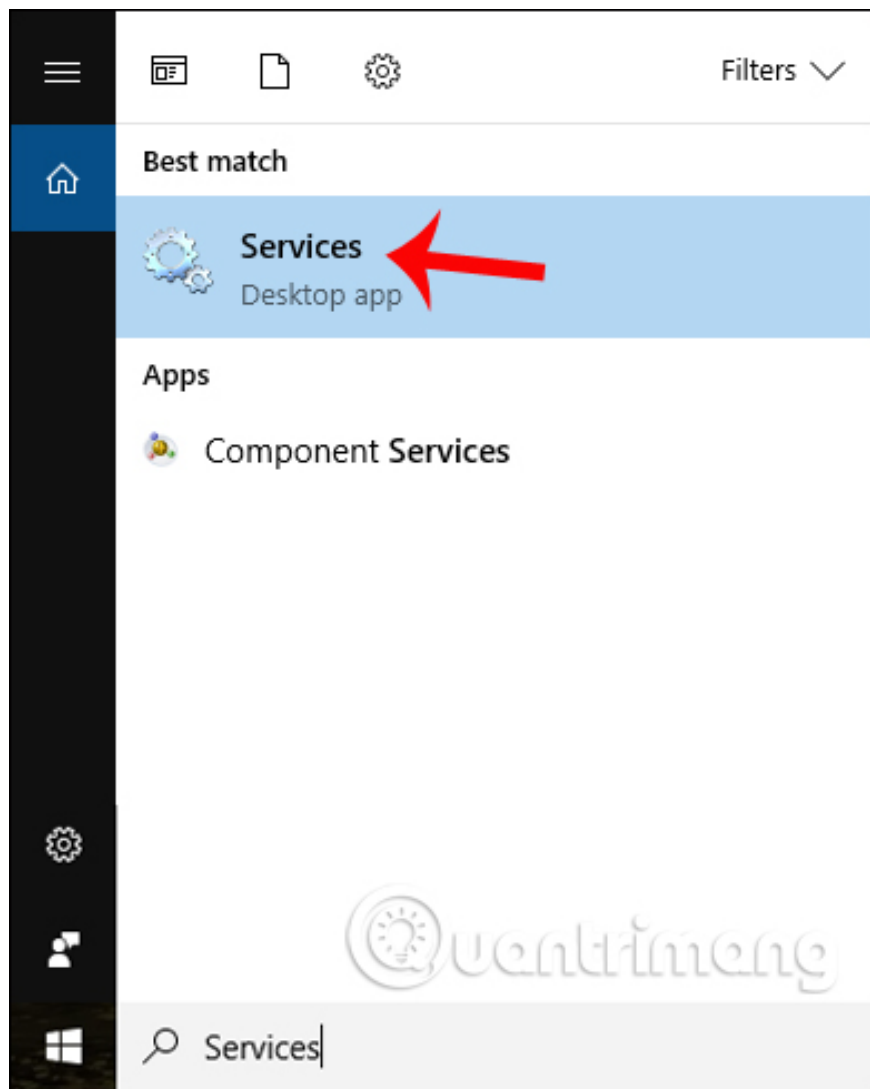
On Windows 10, many users reflect that your computer regularly appears Your Windows license will expire soon, every time you start the operating system and access the screen interface. Even though I clicked Close to turn it off, this message continued to appear in subsequent times, which made the user quite uncomfortable.

In fact, this is not a problem on Windows 10 system. This message appears because your computer is nearing the expiry date of the license and the system requires reactivation. So how to turn off this annoying Windows Windows will expire every time you start your Windows 10 computer?

Step 1:

In the search bar on Windows 10, you enter **the Services keyword** and then click on the search results at the top of the list.



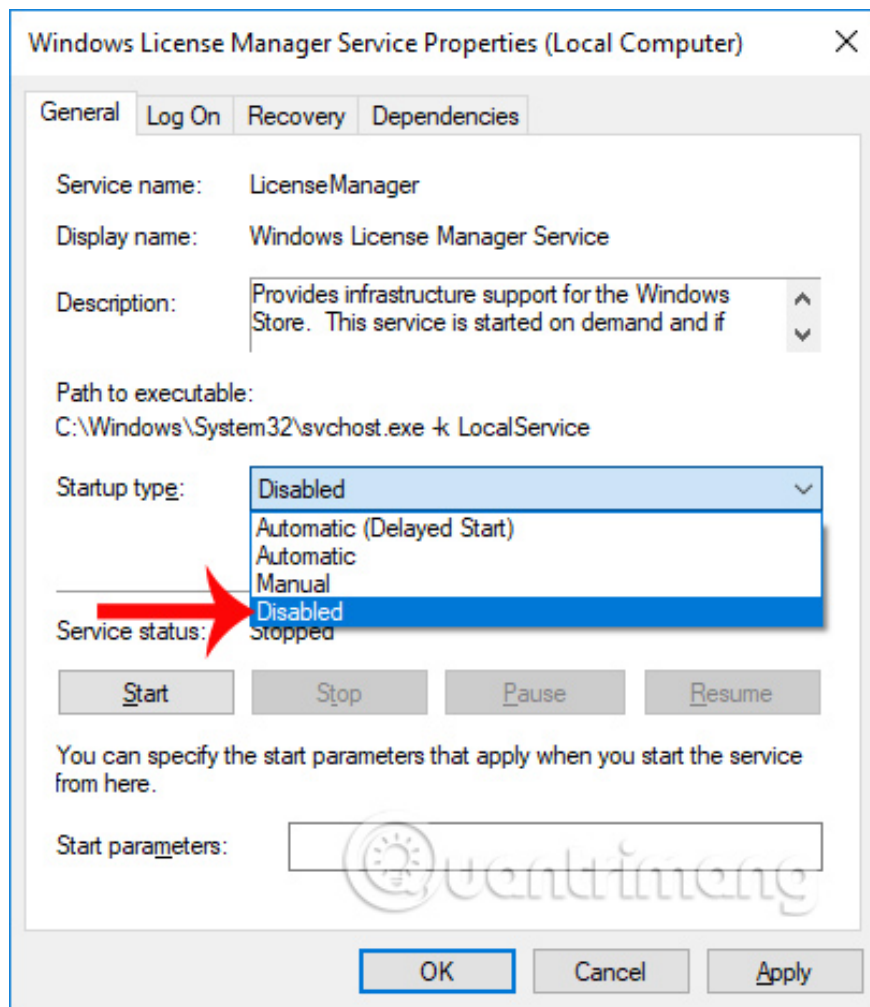
Step 2:

In the Services interface we find the **Windows License Manager Services option** and then double click on it.

Step 3:

A new window interface appears. By default this option will run on the system to notify users of the expiration of the win. The user clicks **the Stop button** then in the list on **the Startup type item** select **Disabled** to disable the notification. Finally click **Apply** and **OK** to save this change.



Step 4:

You continue to scroll down, find Windows Update, once again select Disabled in Service status of the window that appears.

So we have turned off the notice Your Windows license will expire soon appears on Windows 10 system, with extremely simple steps. When the Windows 10 computer has expired, it will often appear this message and we just need to follow the above article to turn it off.

However, readers should note that turning off this message does not mean that Windows has been activated, it just does not show the notification. When the Win expires, the computer will restart itself every 1 hour. So, you should find a way to activate or purchase a Win license to avoid problems when Win expires.
