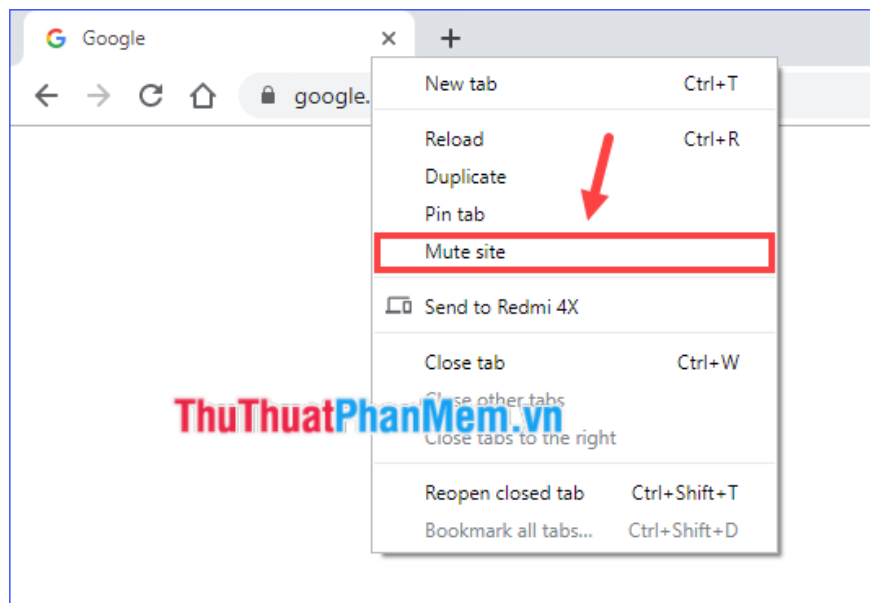

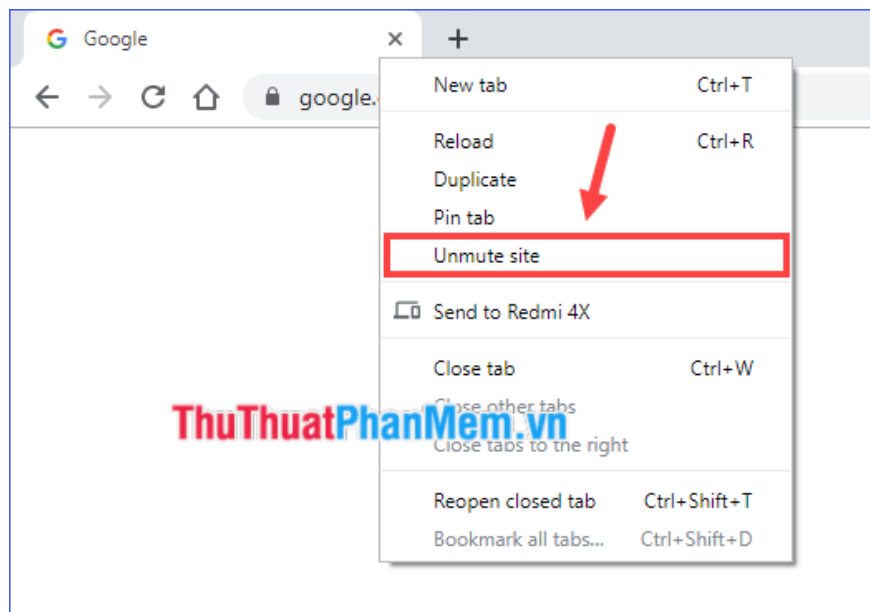
Turn off / on the sound for each tab in Chrome

If you only need to turn off or turn on the sound, you can manipulate extremely easily with just two clicks. Chrome already supports this feature. It is very useful in cases where the web page you need to watch automatically plays music when it is opened.

To mute the sound for a Chrome tab, simply right click on the tab in the tab bar, then select **Mute site** (or **Mute site**).



If you want to turn sound back on, right-click that tab and select **Unmute site** (or **Enable site sound**).



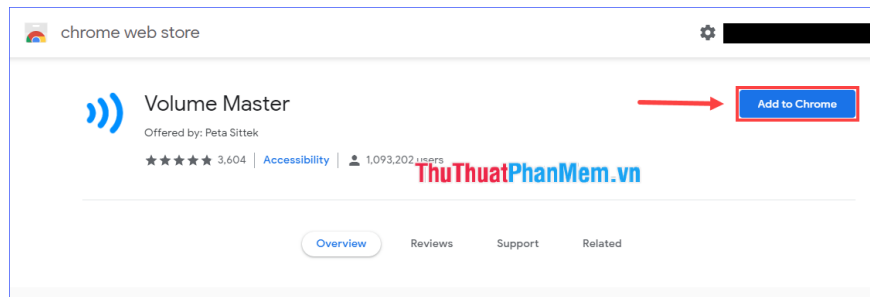
Adjust the volume on each Chrome tab

It's easy to turn off / on sounds. But how about adjusting the volume for each individual tab? Speakers available in Windows cannot do this, it can only adjust the overall volume of the computer. Therefore, you need help from another tool.

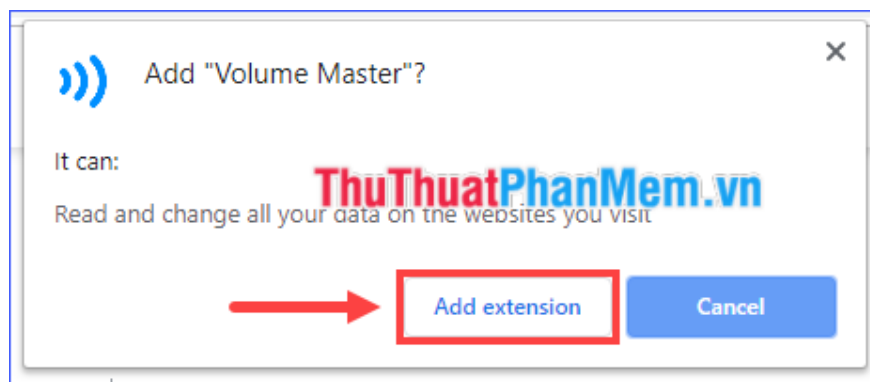
Since we are setting up a browser, we do not need to download and install any additional software. Instead, we just need to add a small extension to the browser, and with Chrome, I recommend using the *Volume Master*. This is a utility that has confirmed its quality with its compact size, powerful volume adjustment and more than a million users worldwide.

Step 1: Add the *Volume Master* utility to Chrome.

- Visit the *Volume Master* page on Chrome Web Store, click **Add to Chrome** .

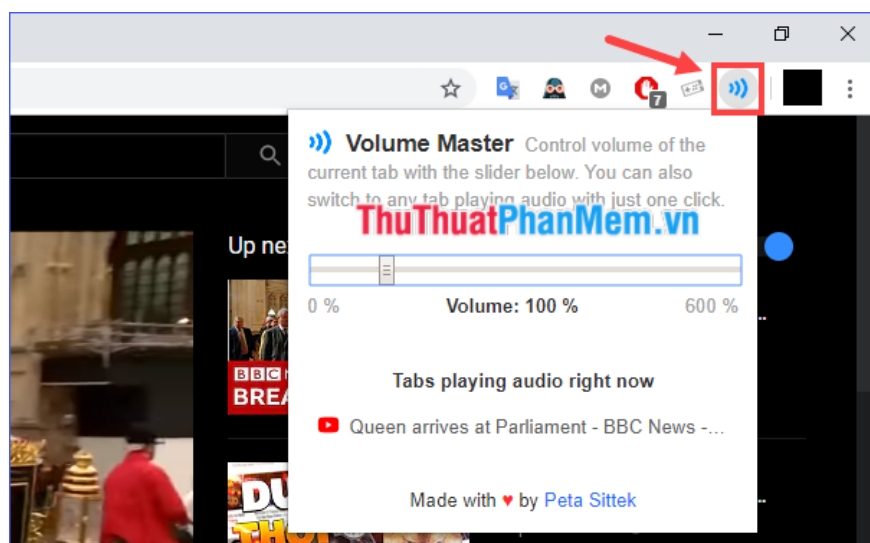


- A notification to confirm, click **Add extension** .



Step 2: Adjust the volume on each tab

- Open the tab to adjust the volume. Click the *Volume Master* icon in the upper right corner of the Chrome window, then drag the volume bar to your liking.



- Do the same with the other tabs.

As you can see, the *Volume Master* can increase the volume up to 600%. A great possibility for those who want to experience the thrills of sound!
