

# How to turn off Update Win 11 permanently, block the latest update 2024

Turning **off Windows 11 updates** not only helps you control your computer flexibly but also avoids unwanted annoyances. To do this, you can use Services, Group Policy Editor or perform fine-tuning steps through Registry Editor

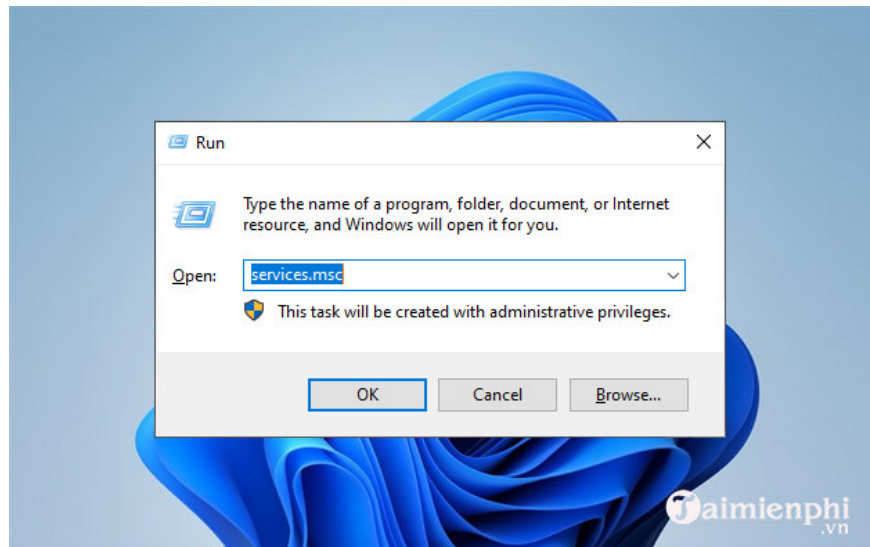

## *1. How to turn off Windows 11 update via Services.msc*

Discover how to use Services.msc to customize update services and prevent them from running automatically. Leverage the power of Services.msc to gain full control and maintain your **Windows 11 PC** the way you want it

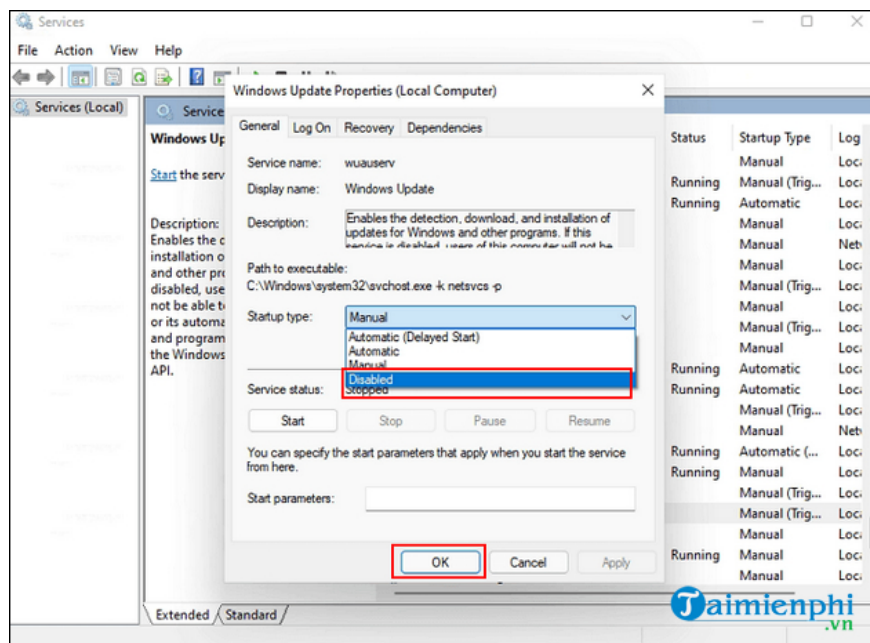
**Step 1:** Press the **Windows + R** key combination to open the **Run dialog box**.

**Step 2:** Enter **services.msc** and press **Enter** to open the Services window .



**Step 3:** Find **Windows Update** from the list of services and click the **Stop** button.

**Step 4:** In the **Startup Type** section, select **Disabled** from the drop-down menu. Then, click the **OK** button to save changes.



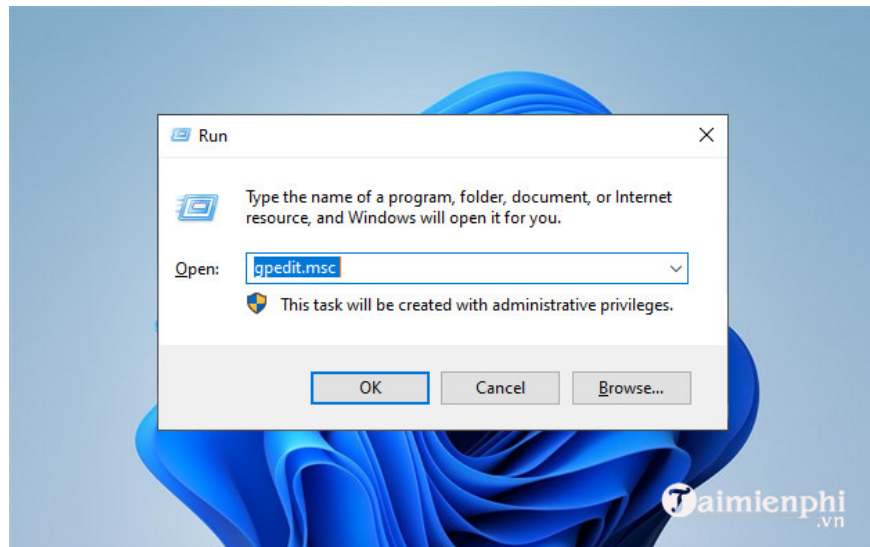
Besides, if you update Windows 11 to a new version and encounter errors, you can also uninstall the new update and return to the old version to wait for the errors to be fixed.

## ***2. Turn off Windows 11 updates using Group Policy Editor***

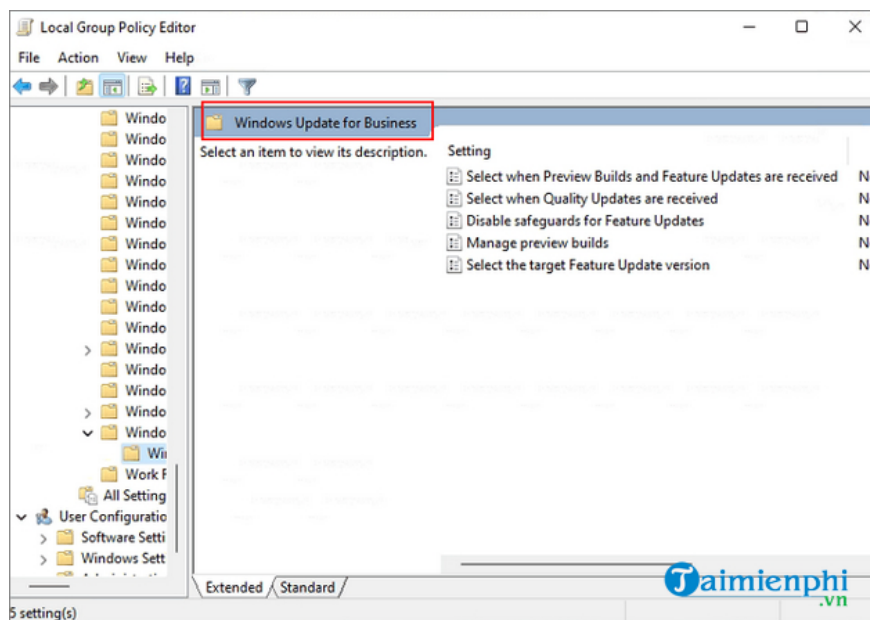
If you have ever turned off Windows 10 updates using Group Policy Editor, you probably know how to do it, but for newbies, this is not easy, specifically as follows:

**Step 1:** Press the **Windows + R** key combination to open the **Run dialog box**.

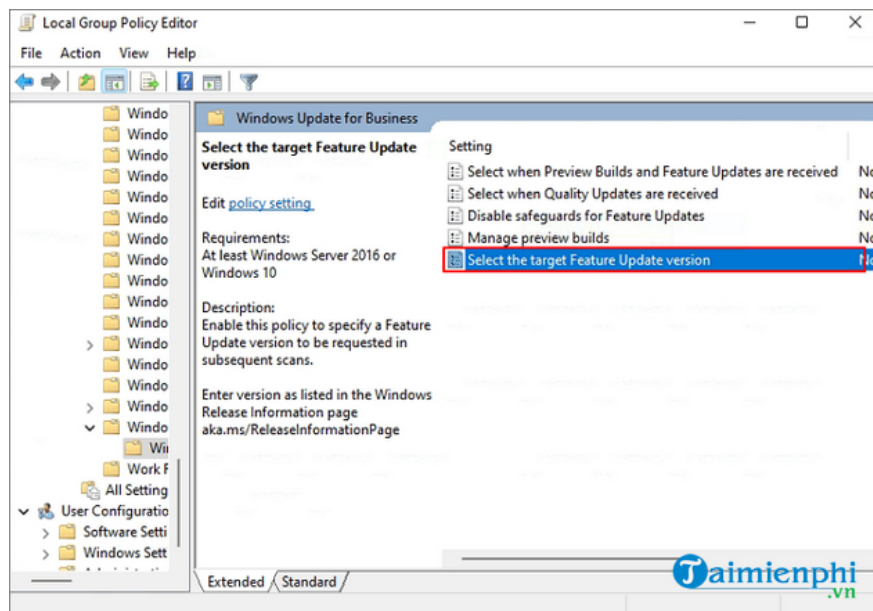
**Step 2:** Enter **gpedit.msc** and press **Enter** to open the **Group Policy Editor** window .



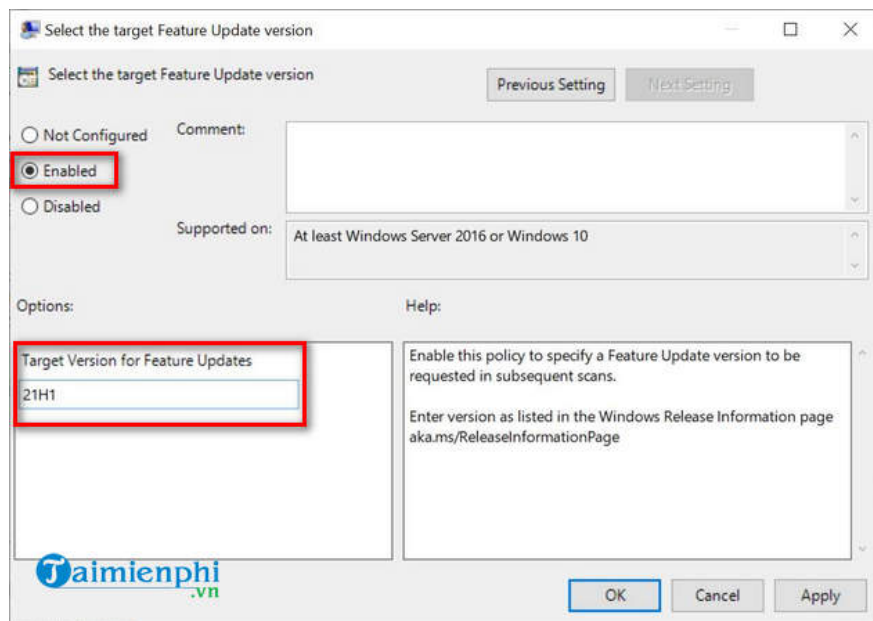
**Step 3: In the Local Group Policy Editor window , go to Local Computer Policy > Computer Configuration > Administrative Templates > Windows Components > Windows Update > Windows Update for Business.**



**Step 4: Double click on the setting Select the target feature update version.**



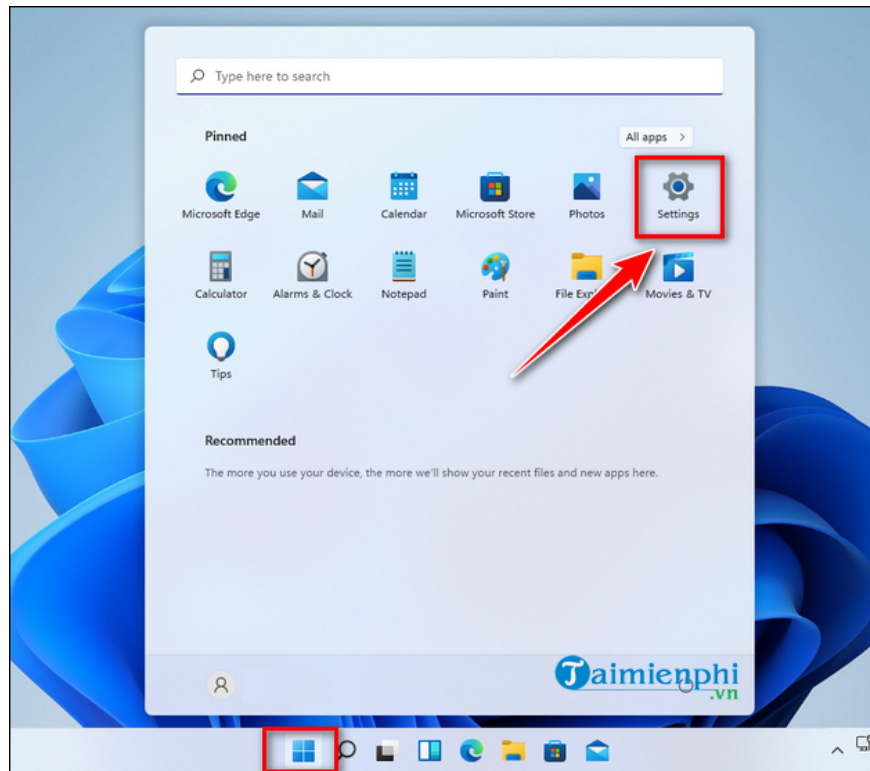
**Step 5:** Select **Enabled** and enter **21H1** in the **Target Version for Future Updates** field. Click **OK** to save changes.



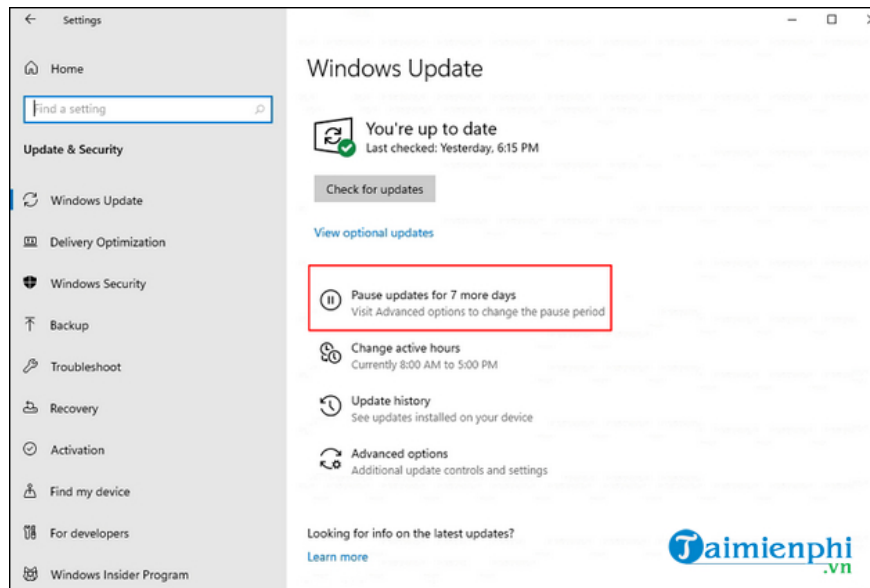
### ***3. How to turn off Windows 11 update while updating***

Another way to turn off Windows 11 updates is to pause weekly updates. You do the following:

**Step 1:** Click on **the Windows icon** on the taskbar and select **Settings** or **press the Windows + I** key combination to open **Settings**.



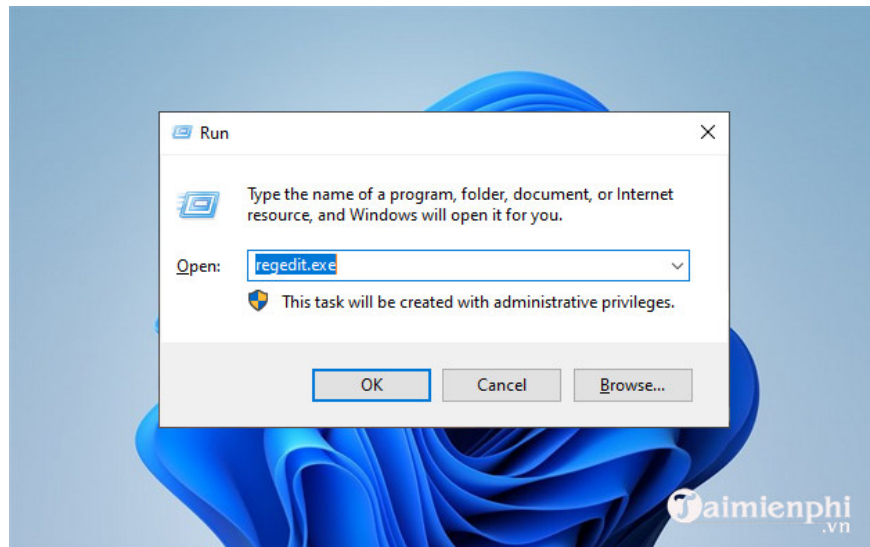
**Step 2:** Select **Update & Security** and click on the **Pause updates for 7 days** option .



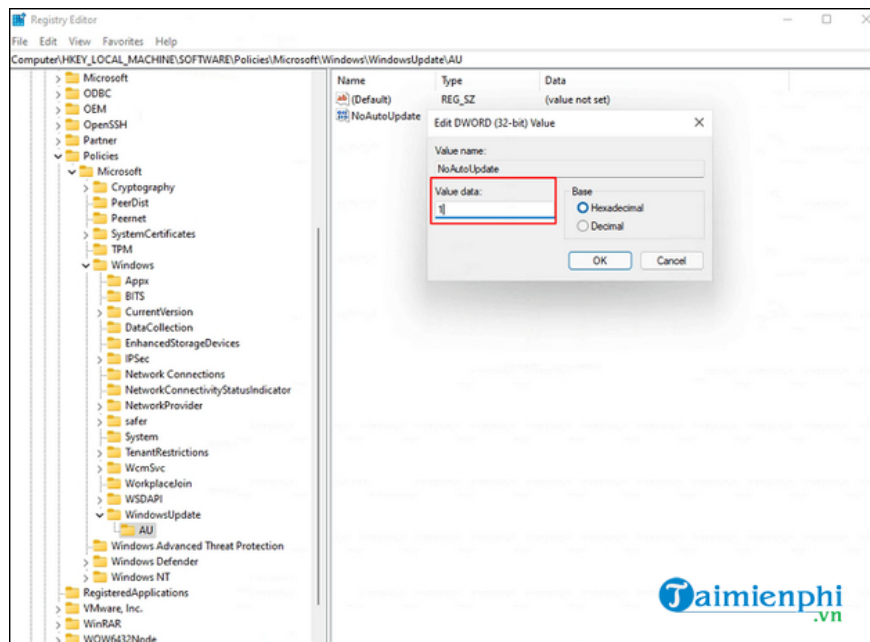
## ***4. How to turn off Windows 11 updates using Registry Editor***

**Step 1:** Press **Windows + R** to open the Run dialog box .

**Step 2:** Enter **regedit.exe** and press **Enter** to open the Registry Editor window .



**Step 3:** Go to **HKEY\_LOCAL\_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Policies\Microsoft\Windows\WindowsUpdate**.  
**Step 4:** Set the **DWORD (32-bit)** value to **1**.



If this value does not exist, right-click **Windows Update** and select **New > Dword (32-bit) Value** . Then set the value of **TargetReleaseVersionInfo** to **21H1** .

- **Note:** You should backup your Registry settings before repairing to restore to the original state if you encounter an error.

## ***5. Some questions when turning off Windows 11 Update***

### **5.1. How to safely turn off Windows 11 updates?**

To turn off automatic updates on Windows 11, you can go to "Settings," select "Windows Update," then adjust the options in the "Advanced options" section to schedule updates or turn them off.

## **5.2. What risks are there when turning off Windows 11 updates?**

Turning off updates can put your computer at security risk, as you won't receive new security and bug fixes from Microsoft, increasing your risk of malware or virus attacks.

## **5.3. Is there any way to keep the system safe and secure while still turning off Windows 11 updates?**

You can increase your security by using third-party security software, maintaining a strong firewall, and browsing the web safely. However, this is no substitute for updating the operating system.

## **5.4. How to control and schedule direct updates instead of auto update Windows 11?**

In the "Windows Update" section of "Settings," you can select "Change active hours" to specify how long the system should not update automatically. You can also select "Advanced options" to control update options.
