

How to turn on automatic registry backup in Windows 10

Microsoft has automatically performed registry backups, but this feature has been disabled silently in Windows 10.

Microsoft has automatically done registry backups, but this feature has been disabled silently in Windows 10. If you want to regularly back up the registry to the **RegBack** folder , you will have to manually turn on the backup feature. registry in Windows 10.

Windows 10 versions 1803, 1809 and the latest version 1903 do not automatically back up the registry. The lack of a registry backup in Windows 10 is not an error and that is to reduce the overall disk space of the operating system.

Currently, the **RegBack** folder is empty or contains many registry files without any content. 'Redmond giant' recommends using Windows 10 to use the system restore point instead of the traditional registry backup system, but you can still force the system to use the same registry backup function, if desired. .

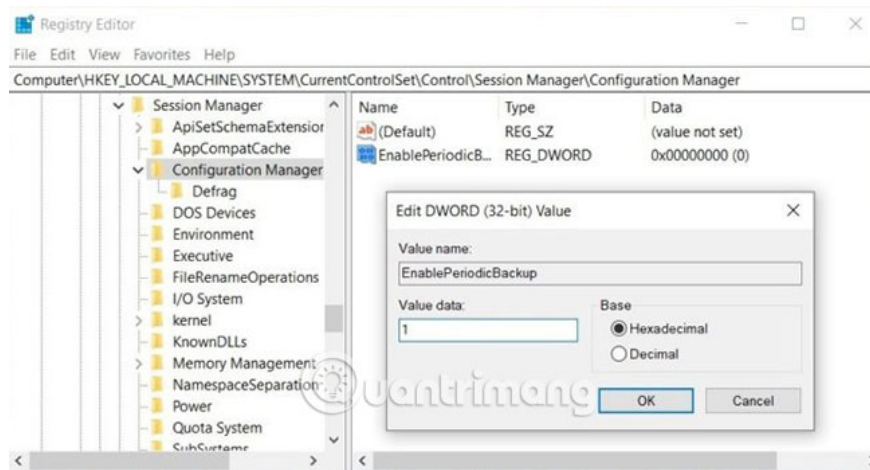
In this article, we will walk you through the steps to automatically back up the registry to the RegBack (**WindowsSystem32configRegBack**) folder.

How to enable automatic Registry backup in Windows 10

1. Open the Start menu.
2. Search for **Registry Editor**.
3. Browse to the following link:

```
HKLM\System\CurrentControlSet\Control\Session Manager\Configuration Manager
```

4. Right-click on the right frame.
5. Select **New > DWORD (32-bit) Value** .
6. Enter **EnablePeriodicBackup** in the **Value Name** field .



7. Double-click the **EnablePeriodicBackup** entry .

8. Change the value to **1** .

9. Click **OK**.

After editing the Windows Registry, restart the system to apply the changes.

It is important to note that incorrect registry editing can cause problems and many other problems. If you usually edit the registry on a Windows PC, you should also maintain the system restore point.

Changes to the Windows Registry

As mentioned, Microsoft confirmed that the lack of a registry backup is deliberate action, in order to reduce the overall capacity of Windows drives.

Instead of backing up, Microsoft advises users to maintain Windows 10 system restore points and use it to revert changes to the registry.

A corrupted Windows registry can also cause boot errors and other serious problems. In such a case, the system restore point will be more reliable than the traditional backup feature.
