

How to turn on Touch ID fingerprint lock on iPhone

Touch ID on iPhone is a new security technology, in addition to entering the password on the device. Users will press their finger on the Home button to open the device.

Users are still familiar with creating mobile password security mode, with 4 or 6 digit characters. However, according to the development of technology as well as the need to increase security, Touch ID fingerprint security system was born on high-end devices such as iPhone.

First released on iOS 7 and iPhone 5S, Touch ID on iPhone device offers new options for device security via fingerprint sensors. Touch ID will be integrated directly into the physical Home button to open the device when just press your finger on the Home button. Currently, the Touch ID security feature is used on models from the iPhone 5S and above, until now it is iPhone X. The following article will guide you how to turn on the Touch ID fingerprint lock on iPhone.

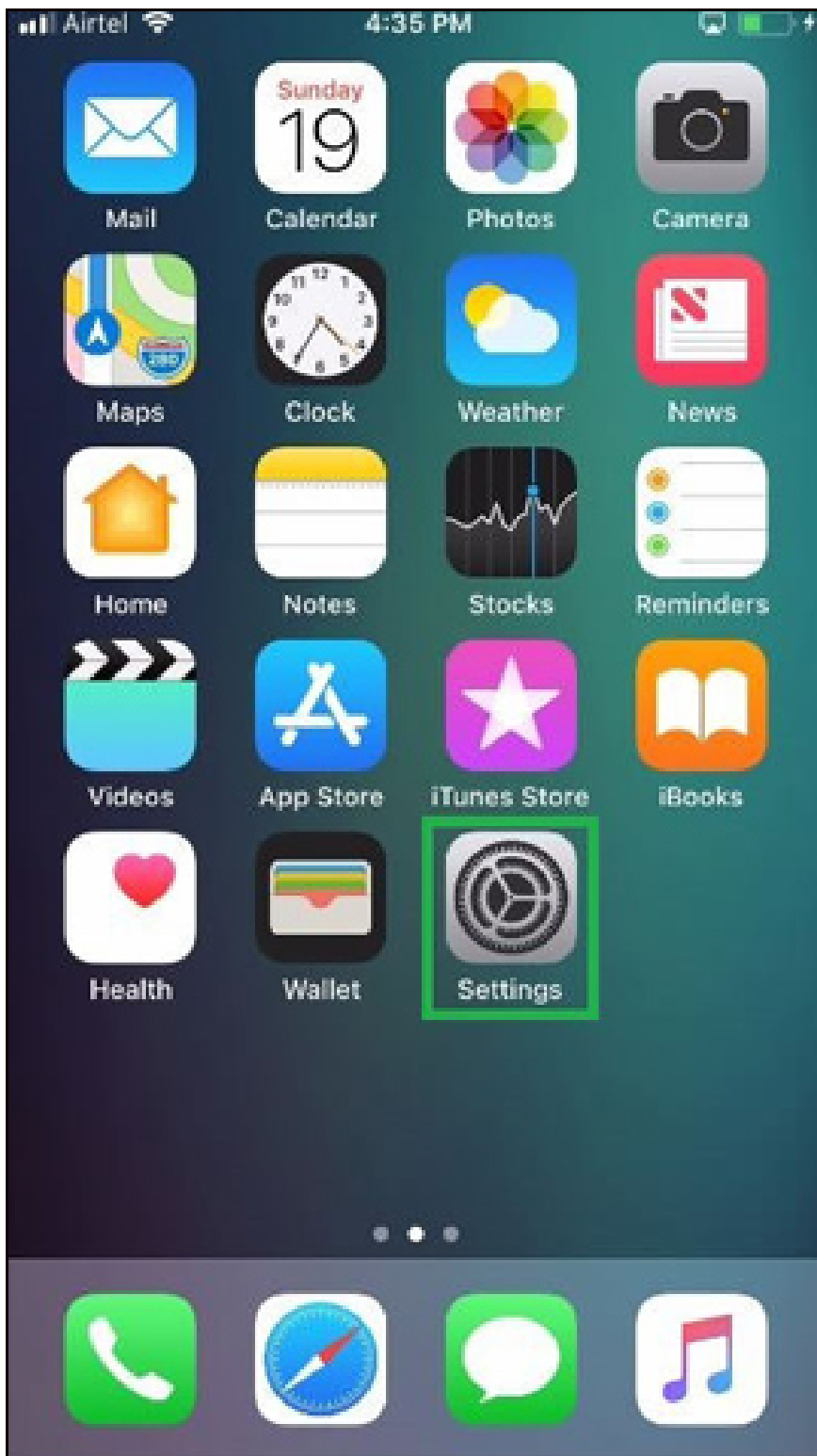

How to activate Touch ID on iPhone

Step 1:

First click on **Settings** on the device. In this new interface click on the **Touch ID & Passcode** (Touch ID & Password) option.

In the device field where the security password has been set, you will be asked to enter a password. Otherwise, switch to the next screen.





Step 2:

Next click the **Add a Fingerprint** option at the bottom of the interface. When the Touch ID interface appears, **place your finger on the physical Home button** to enable the Touch ID feature on the device to recognize.

Switch to the **Place Your Finger** interface, press again on the Home button with the same finger you used earlier.

Note when pressing on the Home button, moderate pressure is not too strong or too light. When the device vibrates, it means that the first time the fingerprint has been successfully set, lift the hand off the Home button.



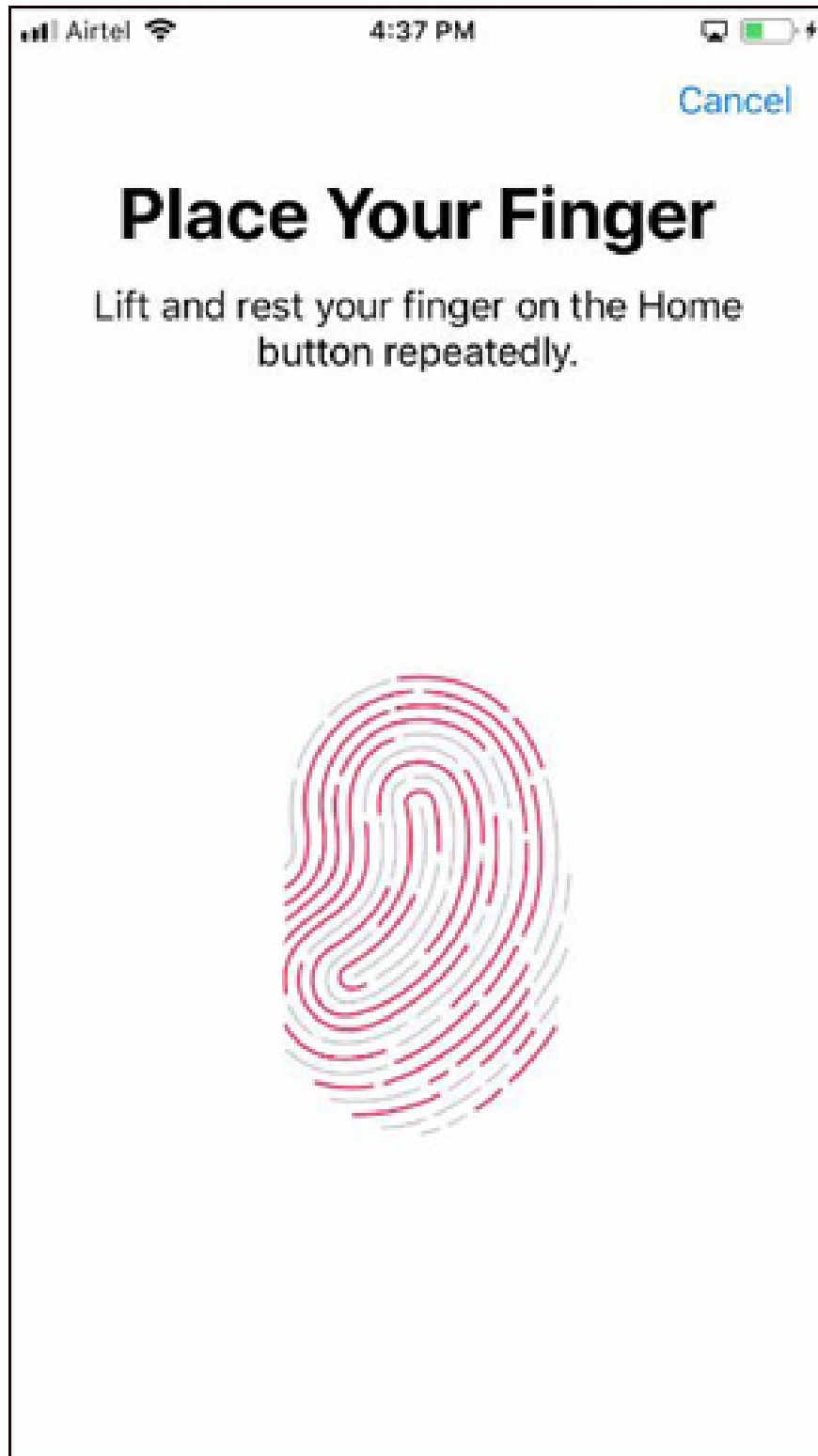

Use your fingerprint in place of your passcode or Apple ID password for purchases.

Start by placing your finger or thumb on the Home Button.





Step 3:

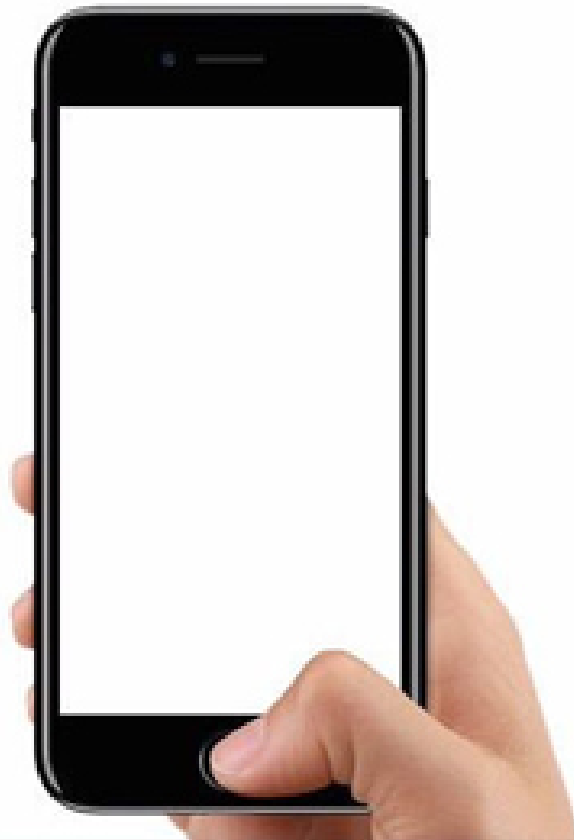
Next go to **Adjust Your Grip** interface, press the **Continue** button. The user will then be asked to press the Home button so that the Touch ID feature can identify the more obvious angles of the finger. Go to the **Complete** interface, click **the Continue button** below.

of your print.

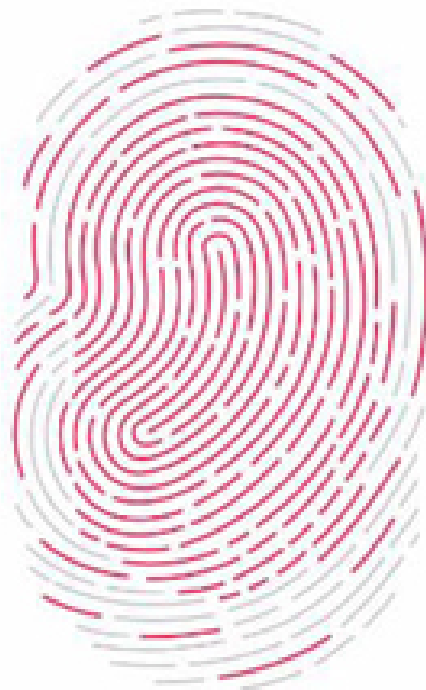

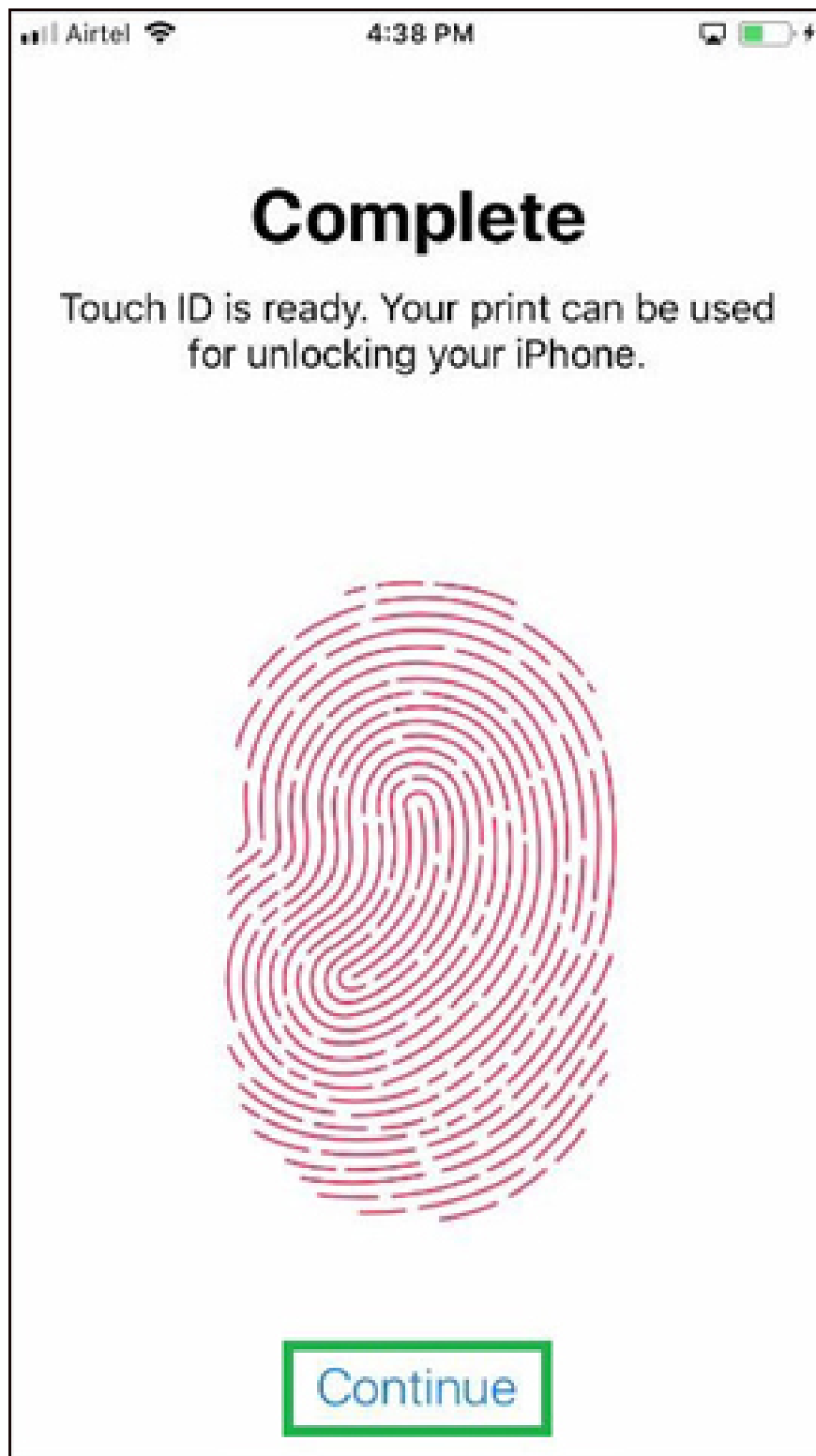

Lift and rest the edge of your finger on the Home button repeatedly.





Step 4:

In the **Set Passcode** interface, enter the password with 6-digit characters to ensure security for the device. This password may be a backup unlock method if the fingerprint lock feature is problematic.

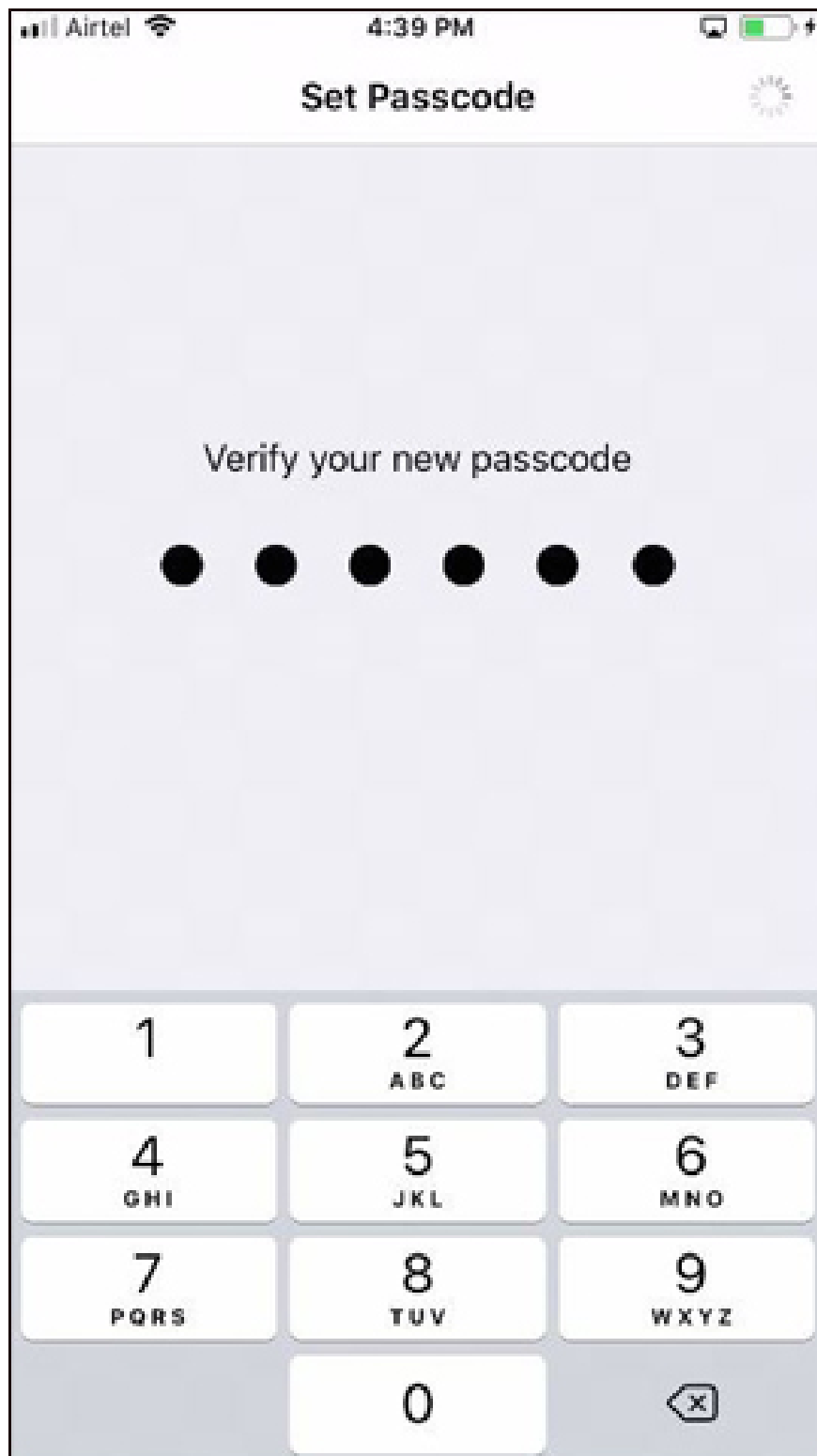

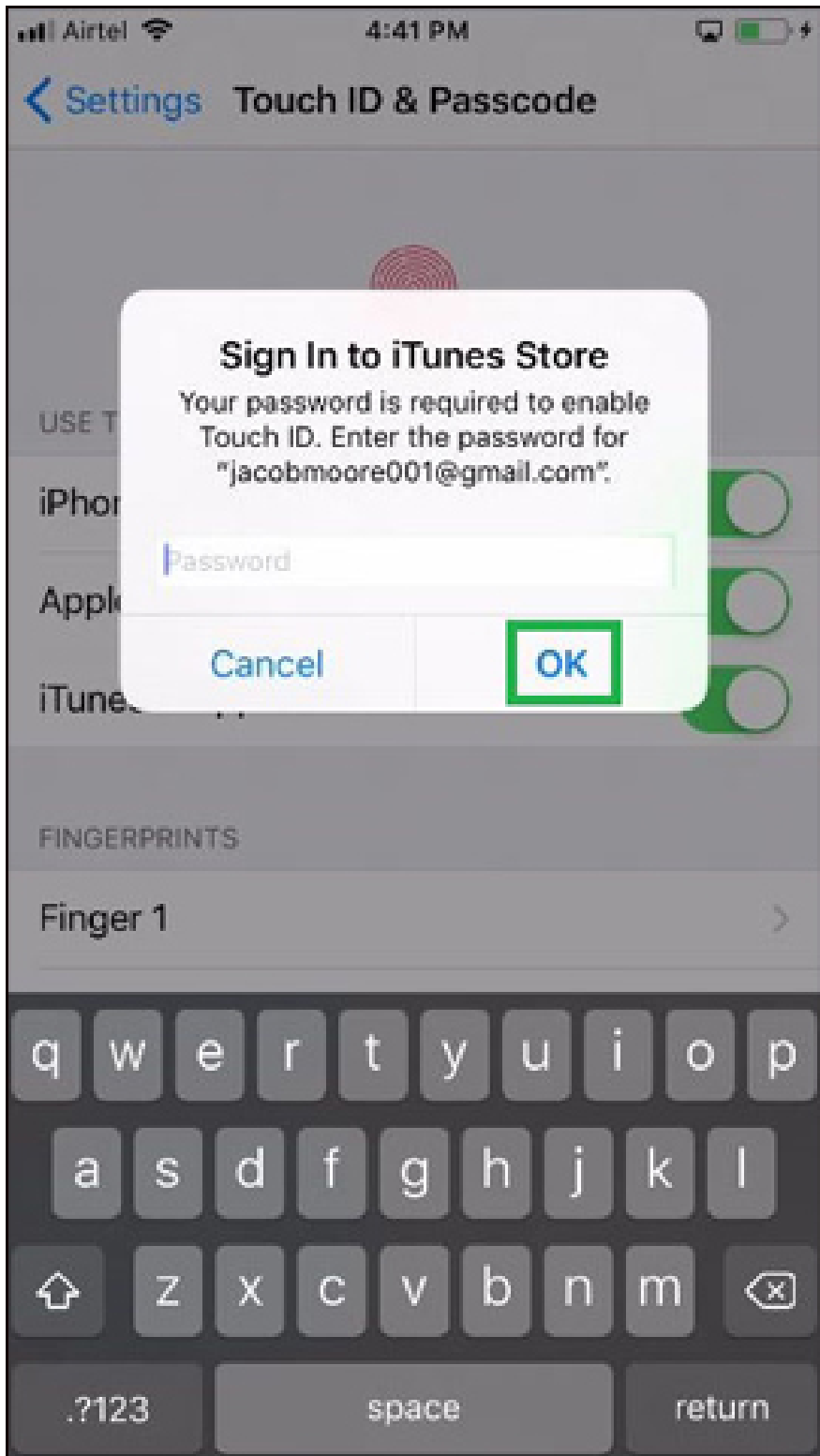
Step 5:

Return to Touch ID interface & Passcode (Touch ID & Password). Here you can turn on the options you want to use the lock for hands, especially **iPhone Unlock** (Unlock iPhone).

If you want to lock App Store with Touch ID, activate iTunes & App Store. Enter your Apple account password and click OK. So when you open App Store, you will see a message to enter the fingerprint to access the App

Store.

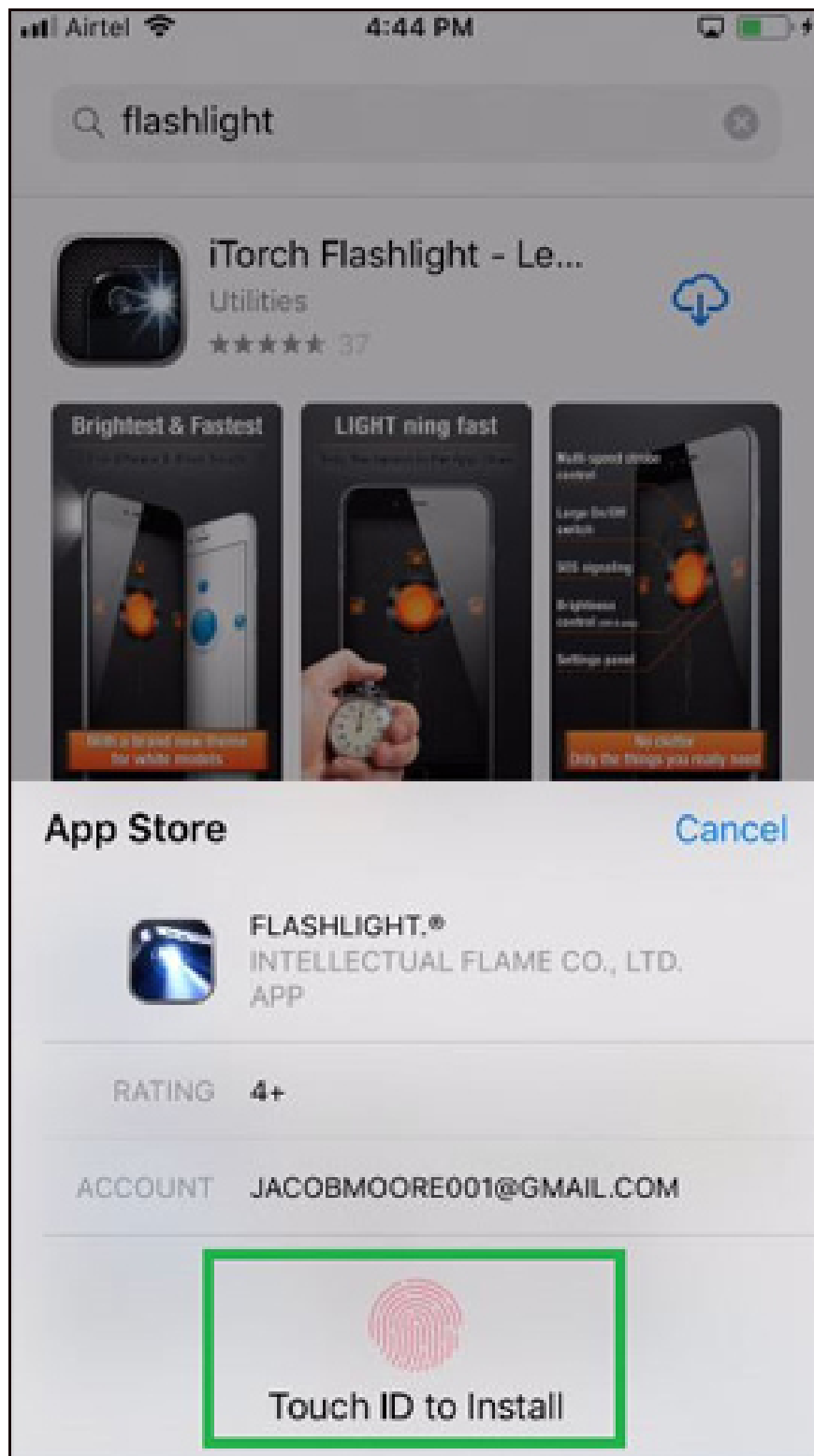
