

How to Unblock Default Ads on Chrome - Preset Default Settings

Chrome has a default ad blocker when surfing the web. However, if you want to turn off ad blocking for websites on Chrome, how do you do it?

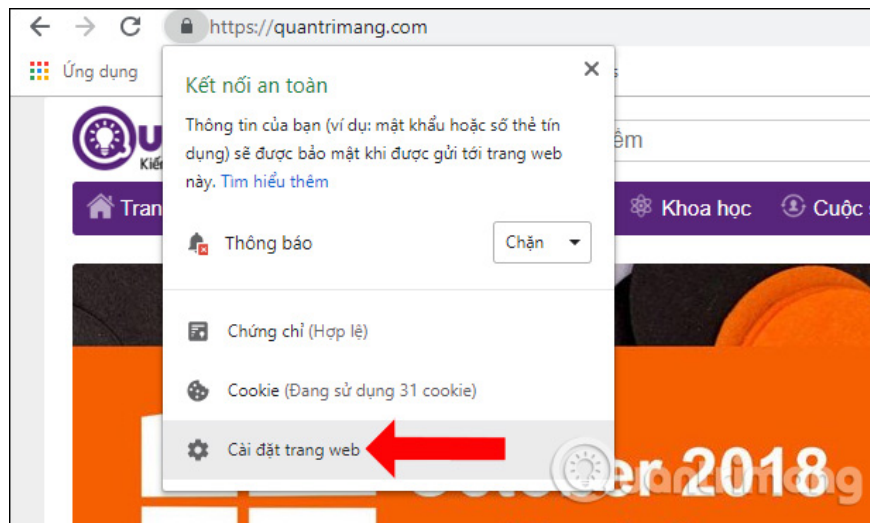
Chrome has a built-in ad blocker when surfing the web, so users do not need to install an additional ad blocker for the browser. This will eliminate annoying ads for viewers, such as pop-up ads, videos, etc. However, on some pages, ads provide useful information for viewers, such as free key giveaway programs for gamers, etc. If users want to unblock default ads on Chrome on a certain website, they can customize the settings in Chrome.

Instructions to unblock website ads on Chrome

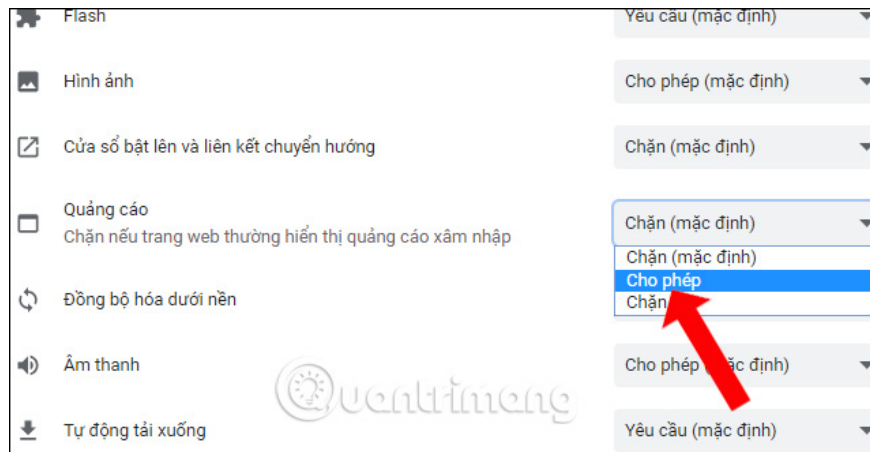
Step 1:

Users access the website they want to unblock ads by default on the Chrome browser. Click on **the lock icon** (or the letter i) in the address bar on the browser. Select **Site Settings**.



Step 2:

In the settings interface on the user page, go to the Ads section. By default, the website is set to Block mode. To unblock, click **Allow** .



Blocking ads on browsers including Chrome will improve your web browsing experience and eliminate unnecessary ads. However, there are websites that you trust and want to see advertising banners, so you can disable ad blocking on Chrome.
