

How to unblock messages in Facebook Messenger

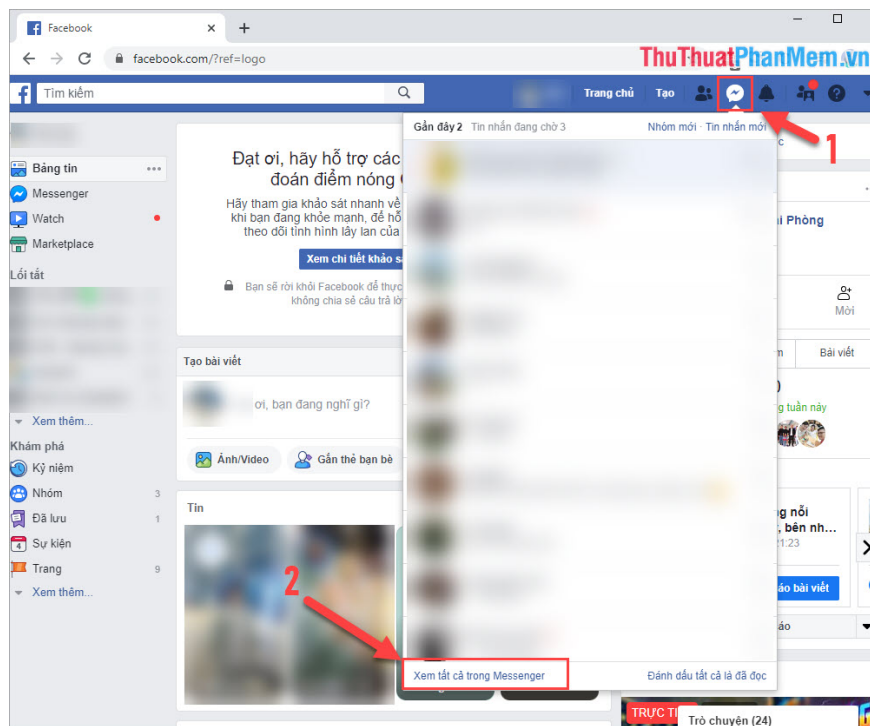
If you block a person on Facebook Messenger, both of you will not be able to message each other but only see each other's personal pages, to solve that problem, you just need to unblock on Messenger.

1. How to unblock messages in Facebook Messenger on computers

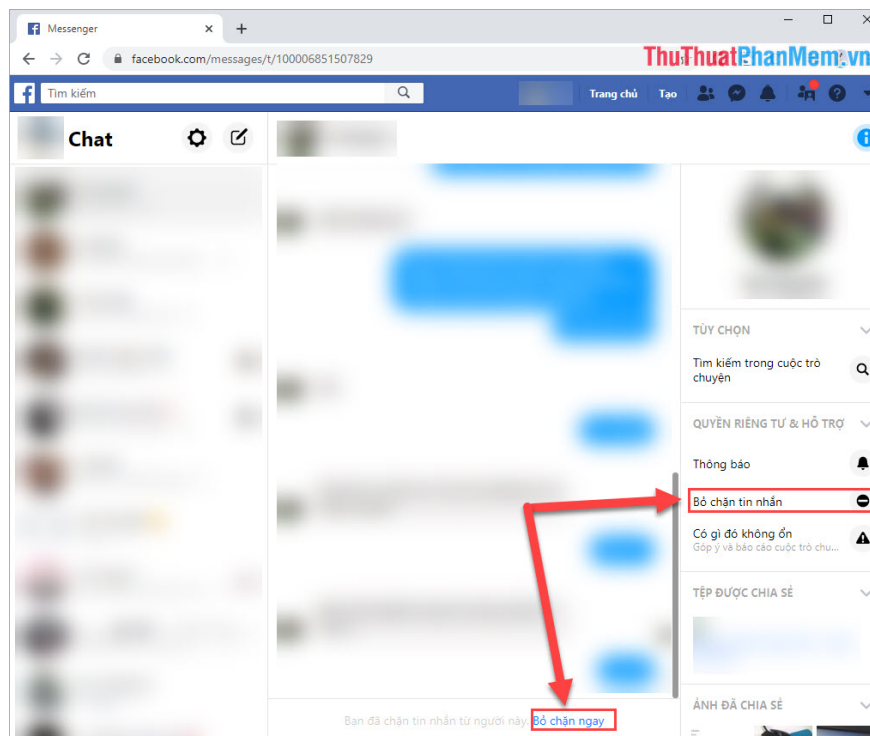
Step 1: You open Facebook on your browser, then select **Messages** and select **View all in Messenger** .



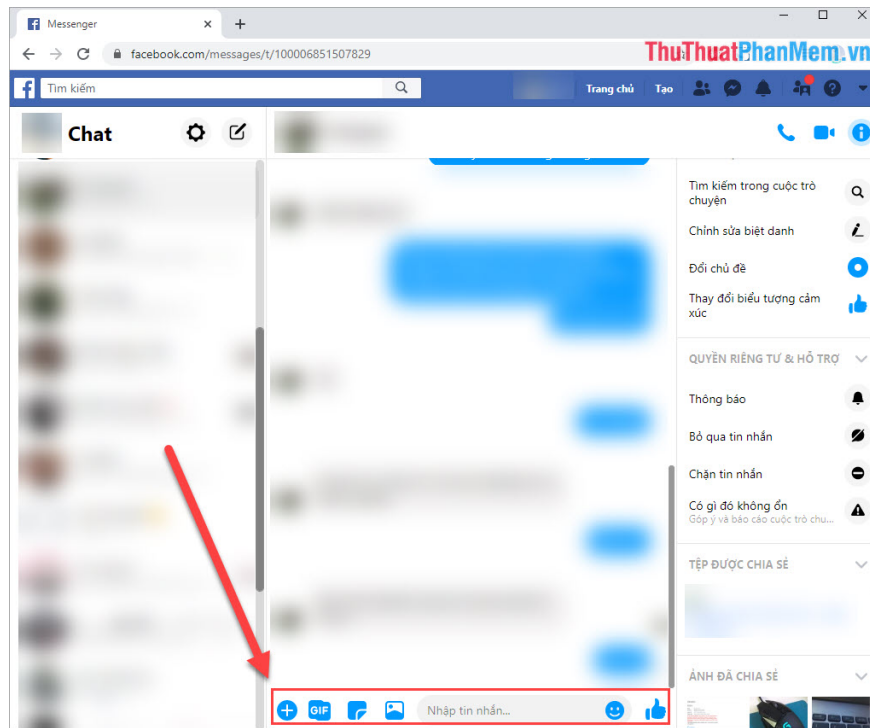
Step 2: Next, navigate to the conversation you want to unblock on Facebook Messenger and choose one of the following two options:

Both of these options have the same purpose of unblocking on Facebook Messenger so you can choose any.



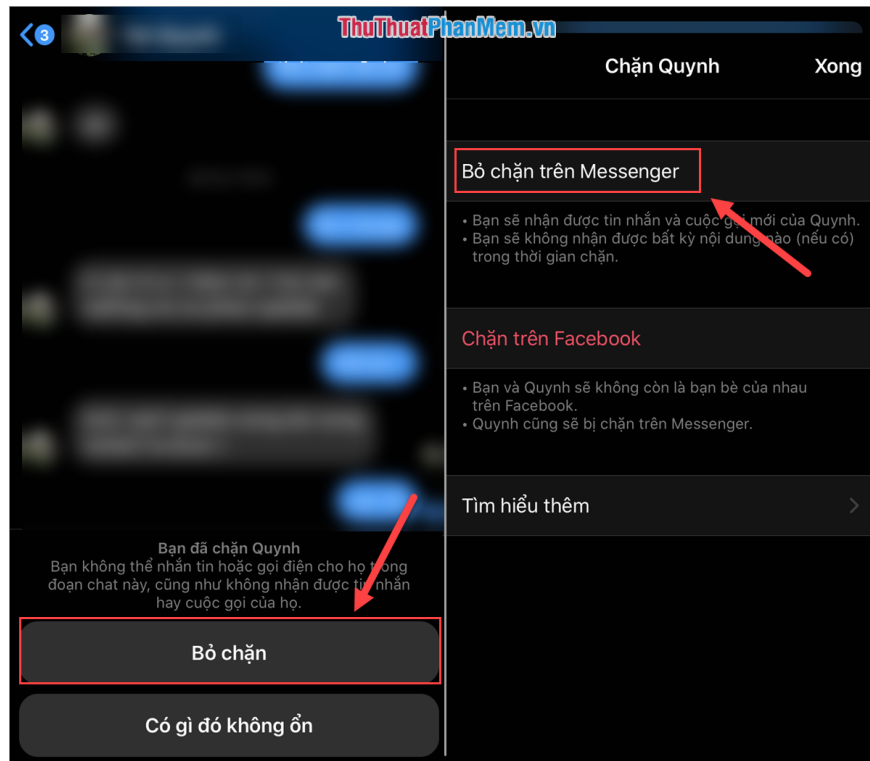
Step 3: So you have successfully unblocked on Facebook Messenger! Now you can chat and text with that person normally.



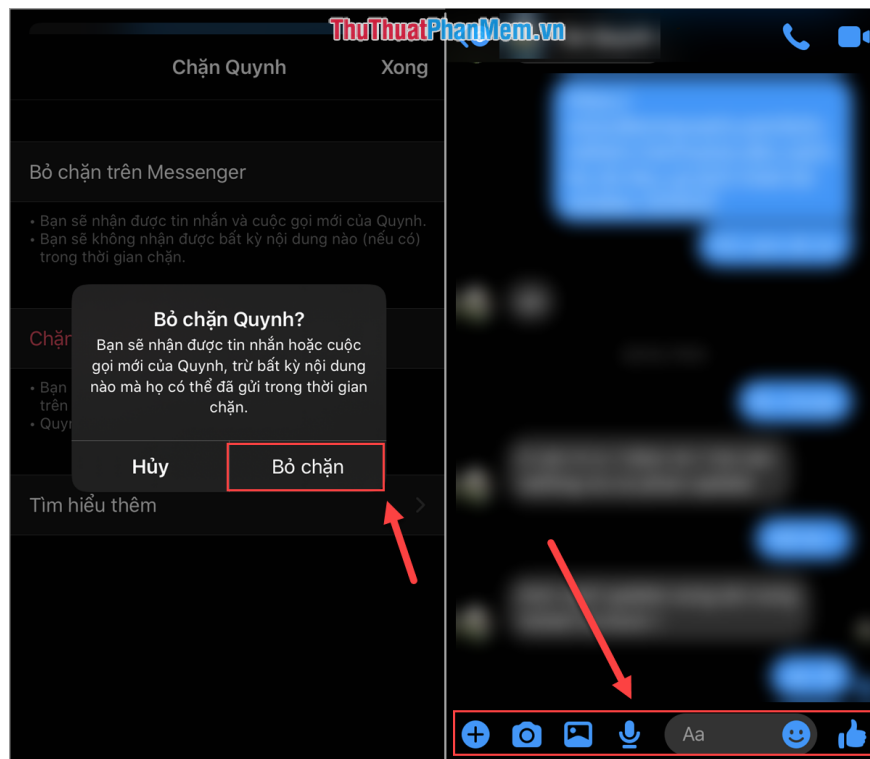
2. How to unblock messages in Facebook Messenger on the phone

Then, a window to block users will appear and you select **Unblock on Messenger** .



Step 2: Next, you confirm with **Unblock** and you and that person can text normally together.
