

How to update drivers for Windows 10

There are many options to help you update drivers for Windows 10 to ensure all functions such as graphics card, sound card, Wi-Fi network, etc., work most effectively. How to update drivers for Windows 10

Step 1: There are many software programs that help you update drivers for Windows 10. One of them, which TipsMake will introduce in this article, is iObit Driver Booster, currently the most effective automatic driver search software. Please download and install Driver Booster on your computer.

Step 2: After successfully downloading Driver Booster, open it but don't install it yet **because Driver Booster supports Vietnamese** . Switch the installation process to Vietnamese to easily install the software.



Step 3: Don't rush to click "Accept and Install." Instead, click "**Customize Settings** ." There are some parameters you might want to change.



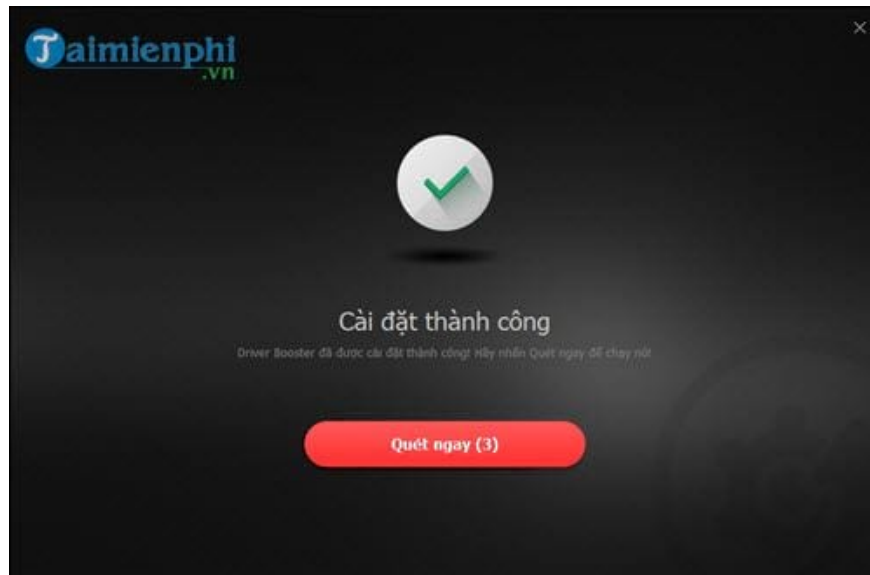
Step 4: Here you can save the Driver Booster installation path as you wish, and you can also create an icon on the desktop or taskbar. Think carefully before choosing, then click **accept and install** .



The installation process will only take you **about 1 minute** , so just let the software install itself.



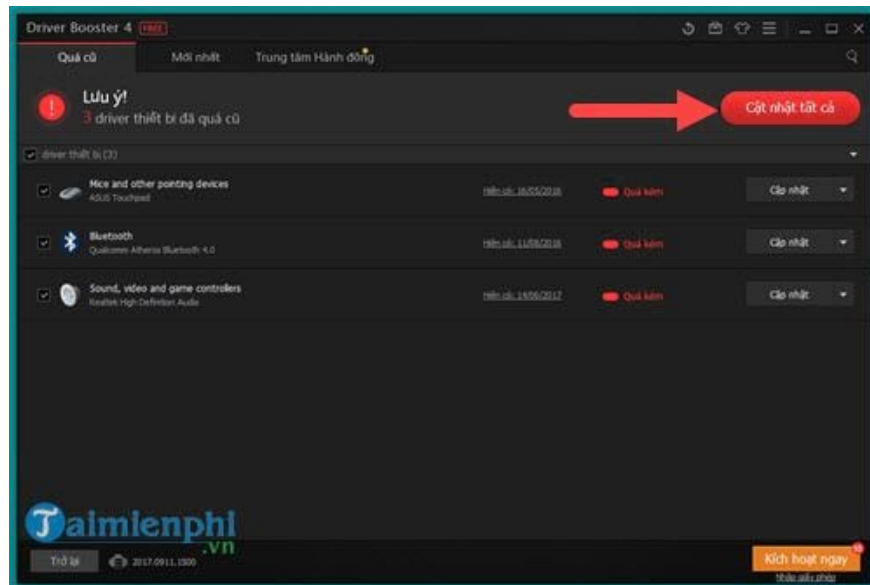
Step 5: After installing Driver Booster, click "**Scan Now**" to update the drivers for Windows 10.



Step 6: Immediately afterwards, the Driver Booster software will automatically scan all your Windows 10 drivers. This process is quite fast, so you can wait and receive the results right away.



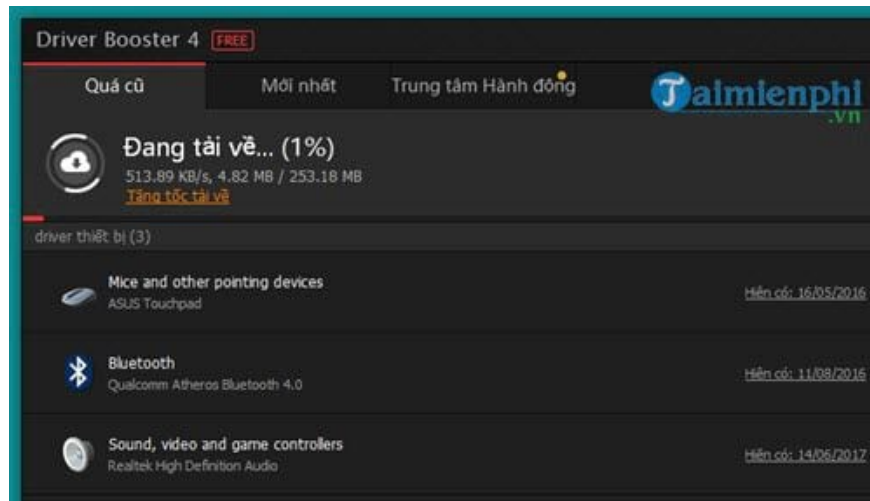
Step 7: The results will show drivers that are not yet updated to the latest version. To update drivers for Windows 10, click on " **Update All**" .



Step 8: Driver Booster will display a notification warning users about potential issues that may arise during the Windows 10 driver update process; simply **click "Agree"** .



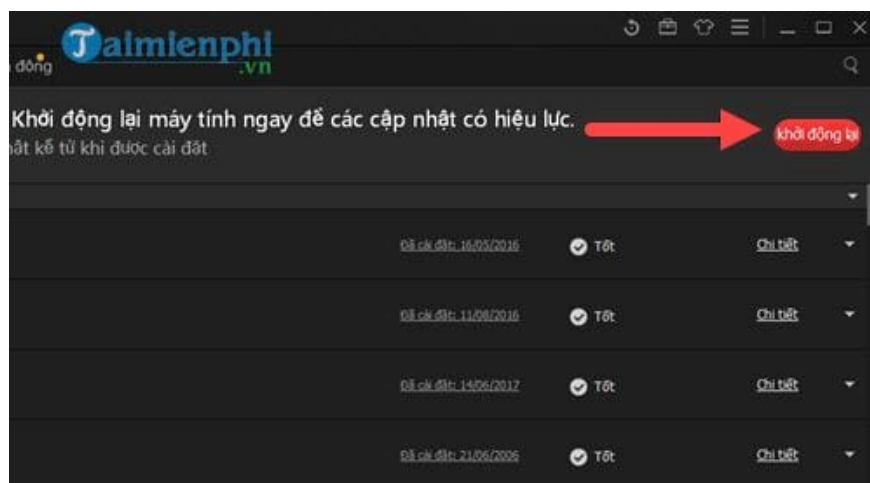
The download process depends entirely on the size of the driver; the download speed is quite high, so you can rest assured and leave your computer running until the download is complete.



Step 9: After the drivers have finished downloading, Driver Booster will ask you again if you want to back up your drivers before updating the new Windows 10 drivers. You should **click "Agree"** to back up your old drivers in case the new ones encounter errors.



And just wait for the Windows 10 driver update process to complete; you only need **to restart your computer** for the update to take effect.



Completing all the steps above means you've finished updating your Windows 10 drivers. Driver Booster also helps you always have the latest drivers thanks to its management tool; you just click and download whenever a driver is available.
