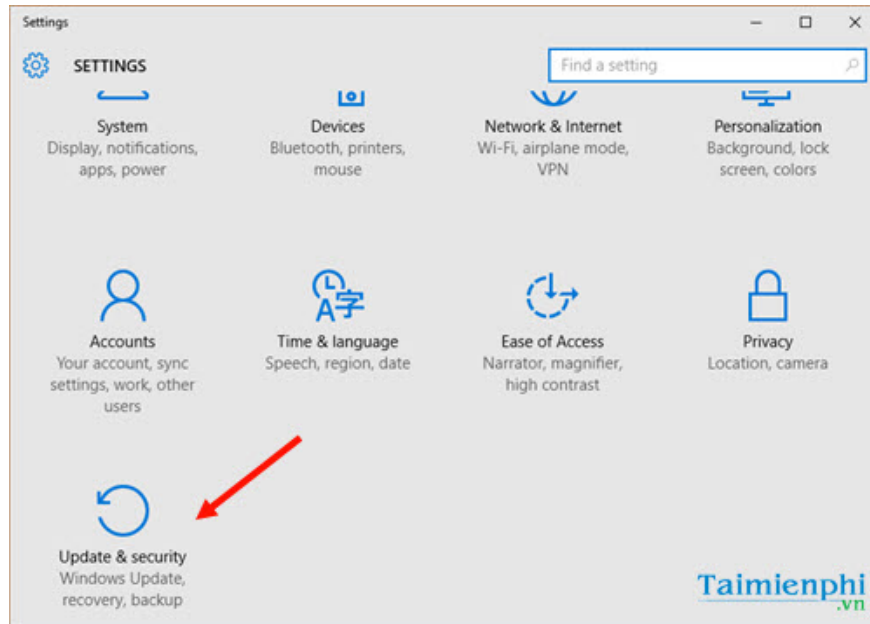
Use the system updater on Windows 10.

This is the simplest way for you to upgrade to Windows 10 Creators Update without worrying about losing data. The advantage of this update is that users can update simultaneously while working without fear of interruption, and it requires minimal steps because the update is installed automatically.

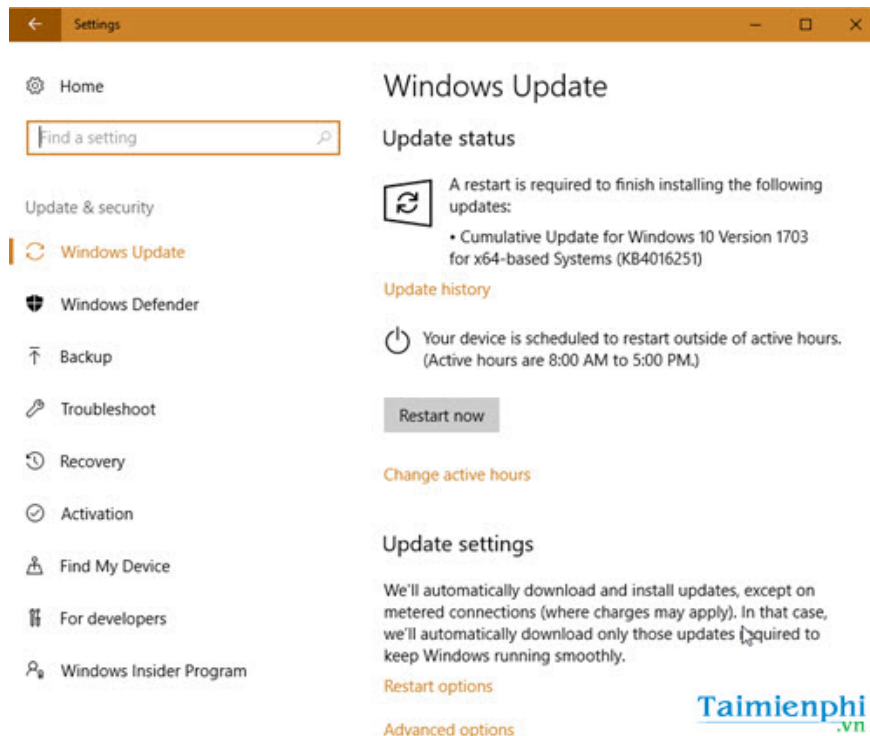
However, the update may be delayed compared to other machines because Microsoft will only release updates to groups of customers at a time to reduce system load. Users also need to have all previous versions fully updated before they can upgrade to Windows 10 Creators Update.

Here are the steps to update to Windows 10 Creators Update.

Step 1 : Press the **Windows + I** key combination to open the **Settings app** , then click on **Update & Security**.



Step 2 : Click **Windows Update** . System updates will appear when you are eligible to upgrade to Windows 10 Creators Update.



After the upgrade is complete, you can use Windows 10 Creators Update normally without losing any data.



Use the Windows 10 Update Assistant software.

This is official Microsoft software that helps you update to the latest Windows 10 version without using the default Windows updater.

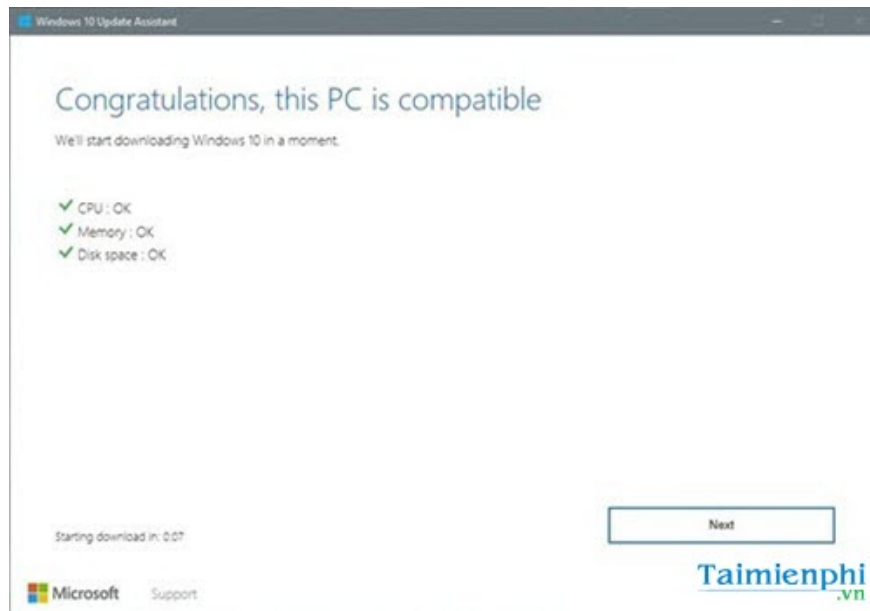
The operation is very simple.

Step 1 : Download and install Windows 10 Update Assistant

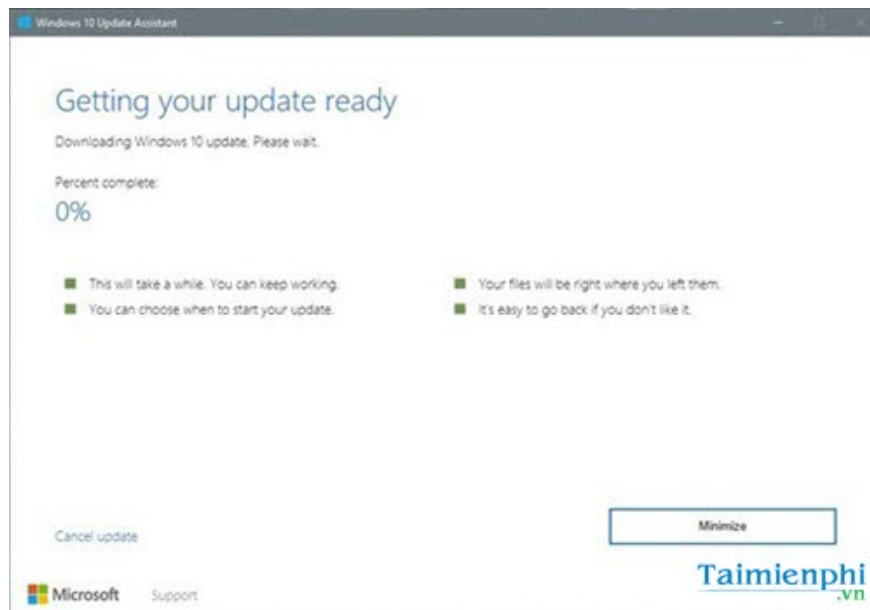
Step 2: Launch the software, wait for the update to appear, then click **Update Now**.



Step 3 : The system checks the hardware to ensure the computer is eligible for the update. If it is eligible, click **Next** to continue.



Step 4 : The update download process will begin. During this time, you can work on your tasks simultaneously. Once the download is complete, the system will prompt you to restart to install the update until it is finished.



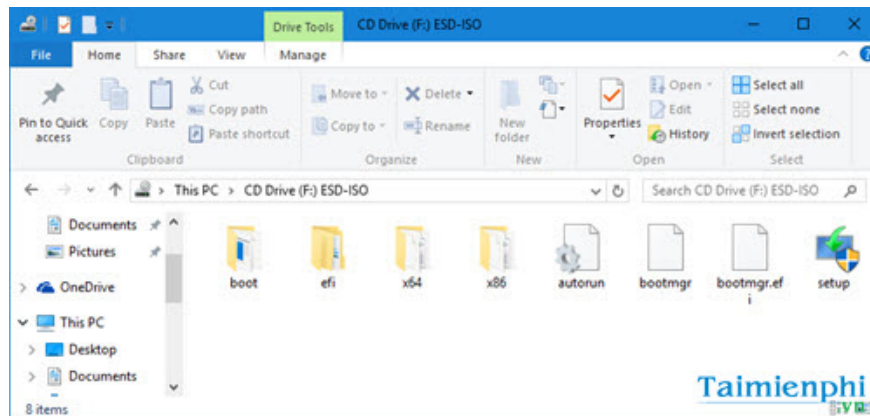
Therefore, updating through the Windows 10 Update Assistant is very easy and will not cause data loss on your computer.

Upgrade to Windows 10 Creators Update directly via ISO file.

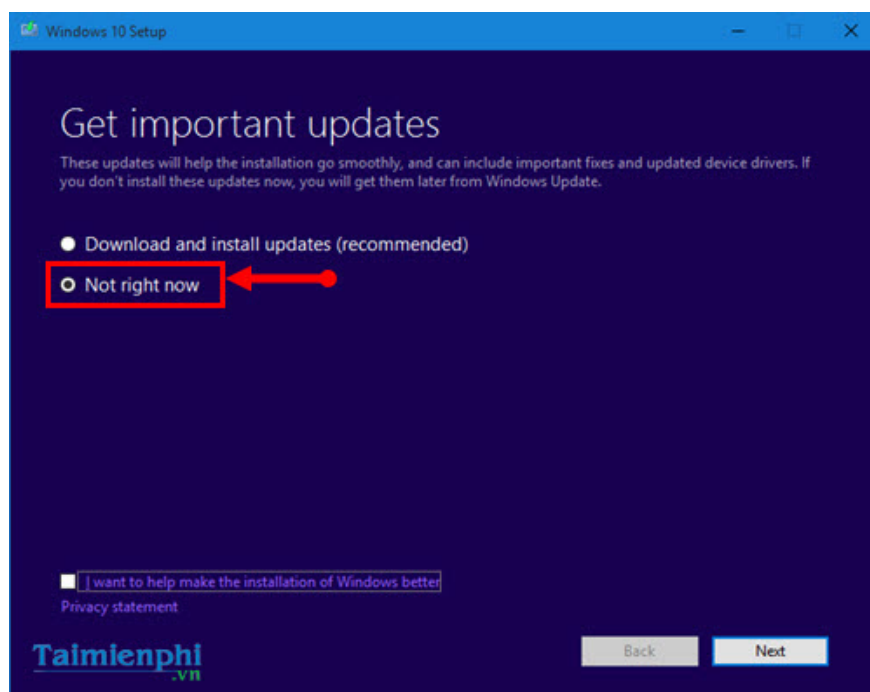
This method is similar to using the Windows 10 Update Assistant, however, the difference is that you will upgrade via the ISO file of the Windows 10 Creators Update itself.

Step 1 : Download **the Windows 10 Creators Update ISO.**

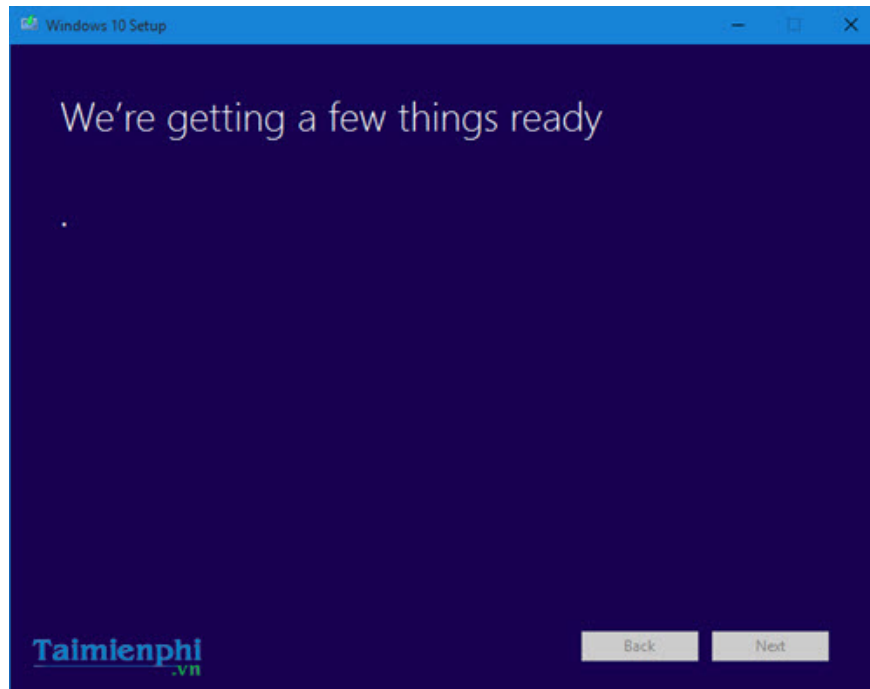
Step 2 : Run the downloaded ISO file.



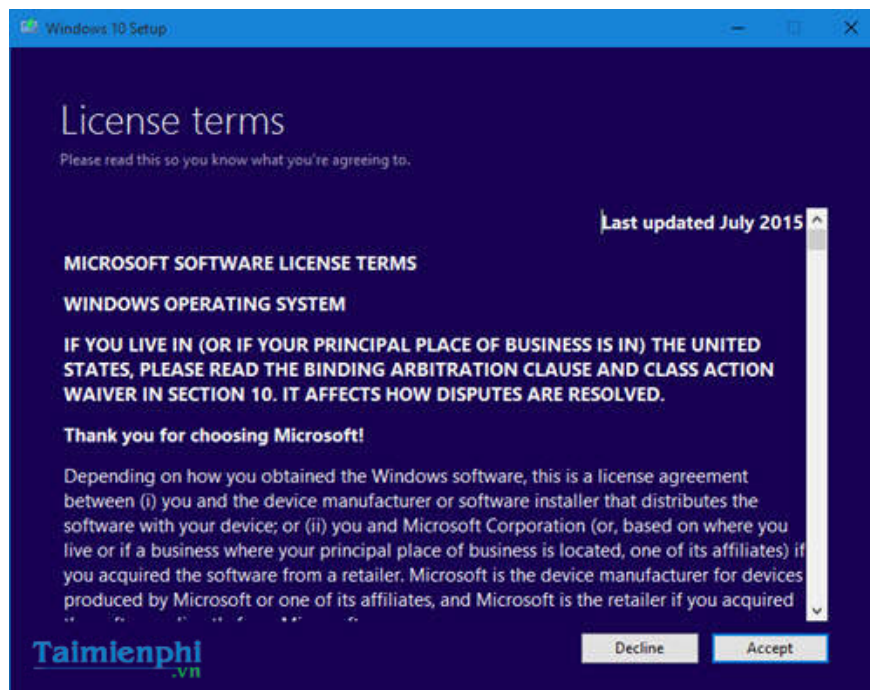
Step 3 : The system will prompt you to download the new updates. Check the box labeled **"Not right now ,"** then click **"Next. "**



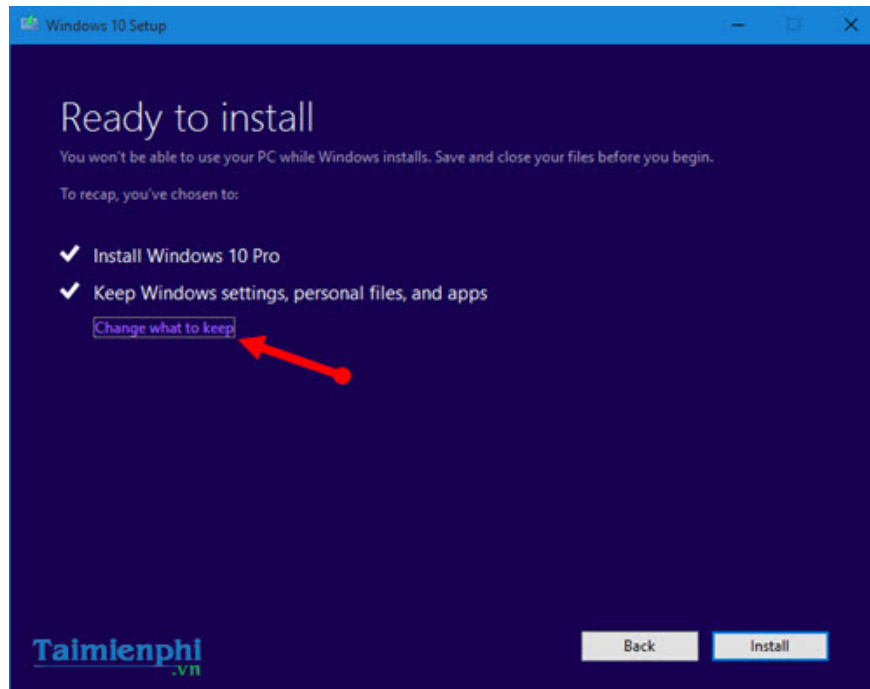
Step 4 : Check your system before installation (BIOS version, RAM capacity, etc.)



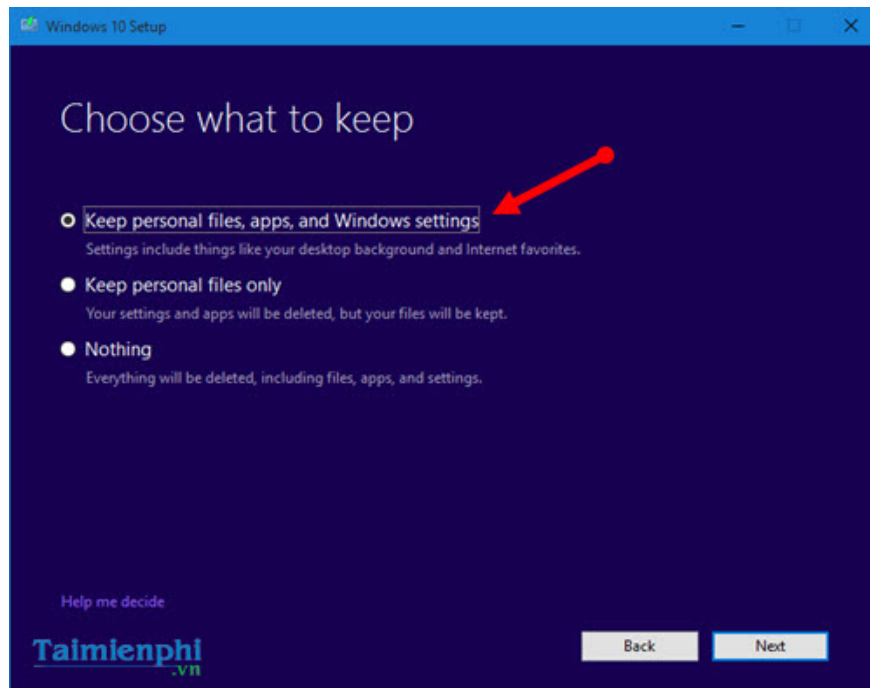
Step 5 : Check the **Accept** box to agree to the terms of use.



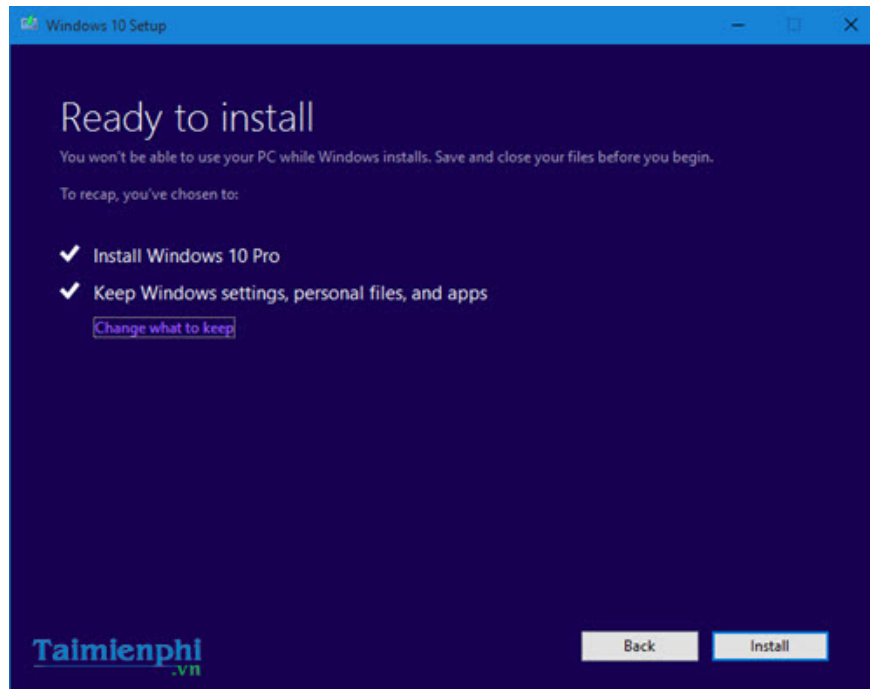
Step 6 : Check the box for "**Change what to keep**".



Step 7 : Check the first box, "**Keep personal files, apps, and Windows settings**," then click **Next** . (Please note that this step is the most important; you need to select the correct option to avoid accidentally deleting system files.)



Step 8 : Click **Install** to begin the installation.



Once the installation process begins, the system will automatically upgrade and retain all data on your computer.
