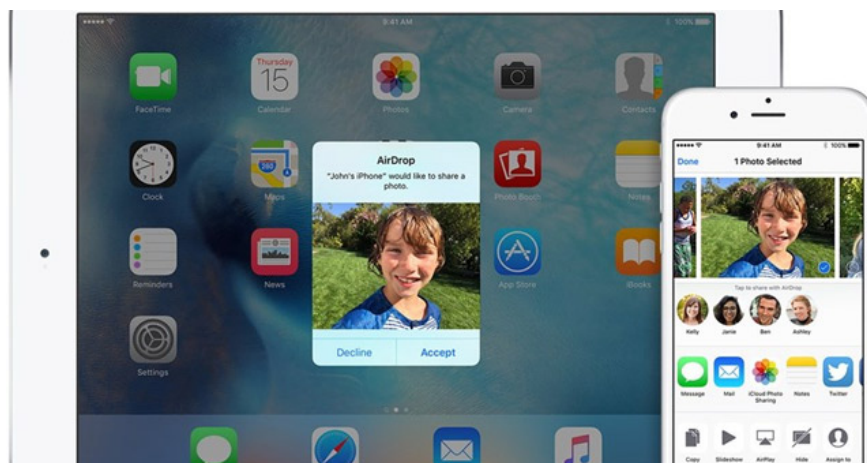

## Note:

Practical experience shows that users of iPhone 7 may experience some problems during Bluetooth connection (this error does not happen to previous iPhone models such as iPhone 6S, iPhone 6, iPhone 5S, .). In addition, users must ensure that peripheral devices and iPhones have a distance of no more than 10 meters to connect successfully.

## Use Bluetooth to share data with other iDevice



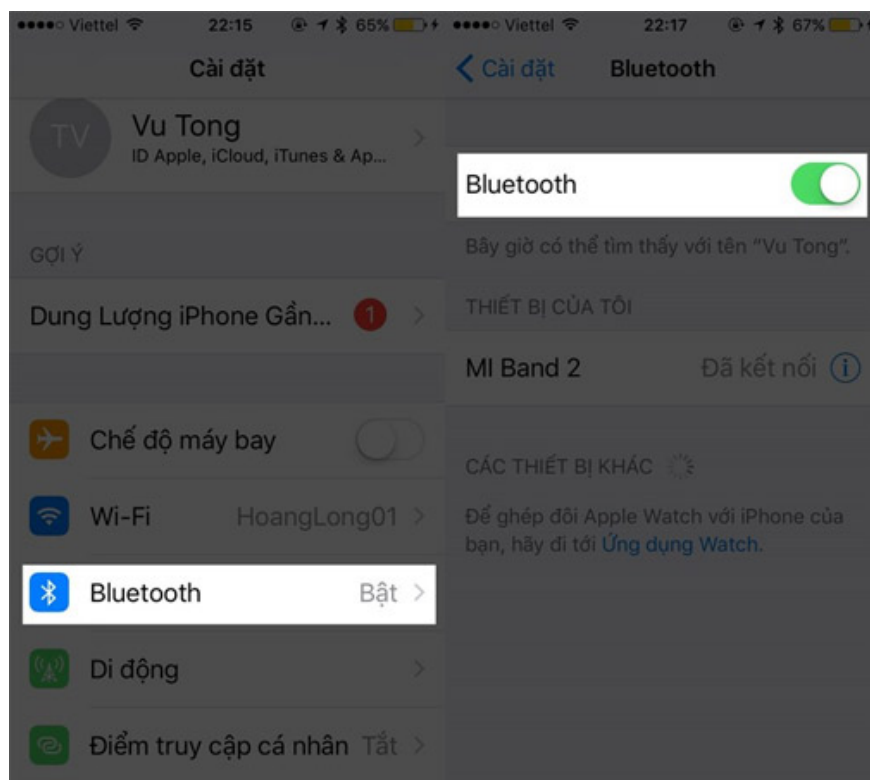
Bluetooth on iPhone, starting from iPhone 5 and above, has a way of working like Android devices. Accordingly, users cannot use it to transfer data to each other and if you want to transfer data between Apple devices, you need to use AirDrop tool.

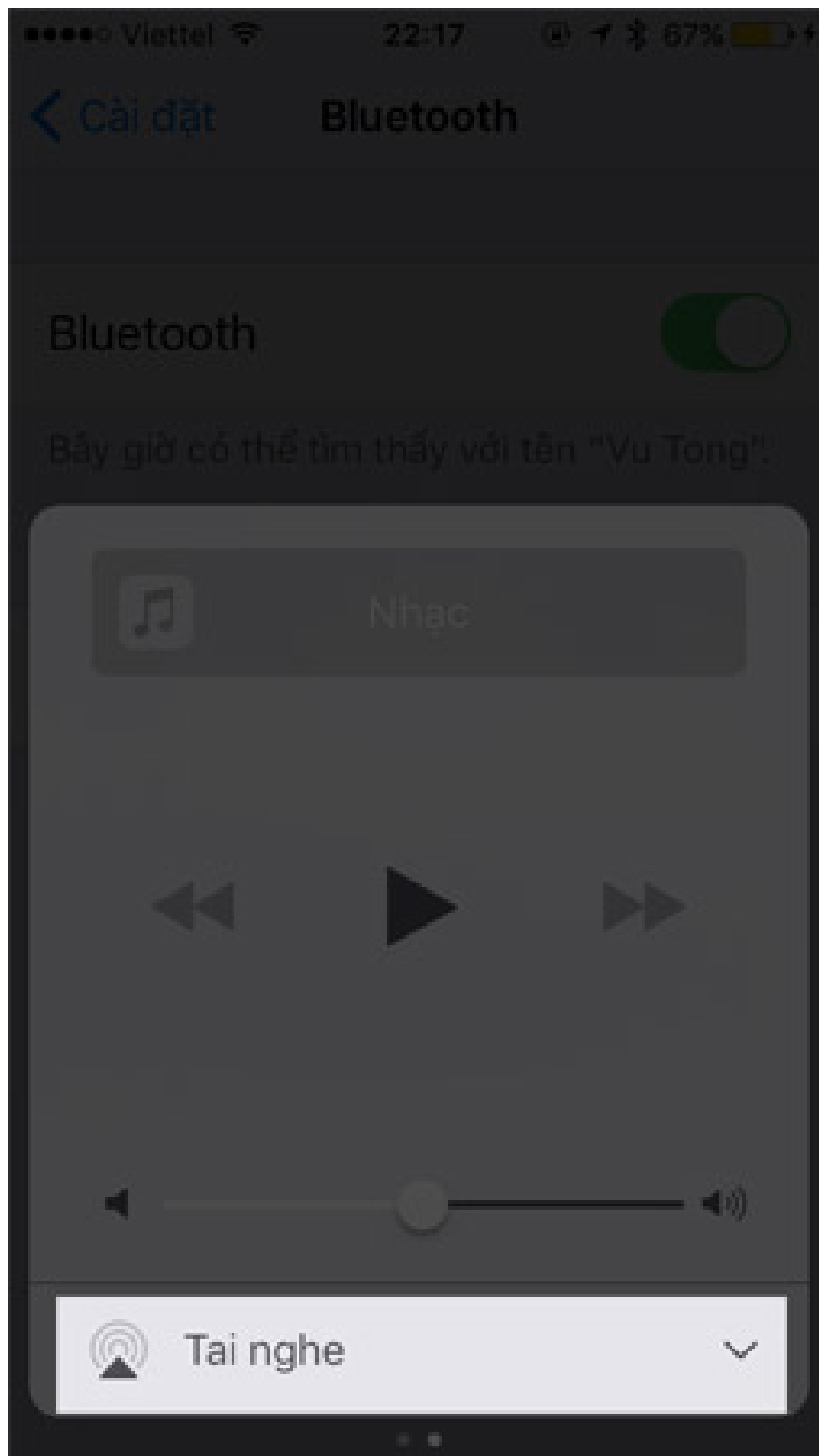
## Use Bluetooth iPhone to connect peripheral devices

In the current day, peripheral devices using Bluetooth to connect more and more appear. Unlike other Android-based devices, connecting speakers, headphones with iPhone are a lot more complicated. Specifically, you have to go through a lot of operations to connect, transmit sound to speakers, ear to hear.

When you want to connect peripheral devices to iPhone, first go to *Settings* > Find to *Bluetooth* > Swipe right to turn on Bluetooth > Find and select the device you want to connect.



In case you want to connect speakers and Bluetooth headsets to your iPhone, you must perform a speech switch in the *Control Center* .
