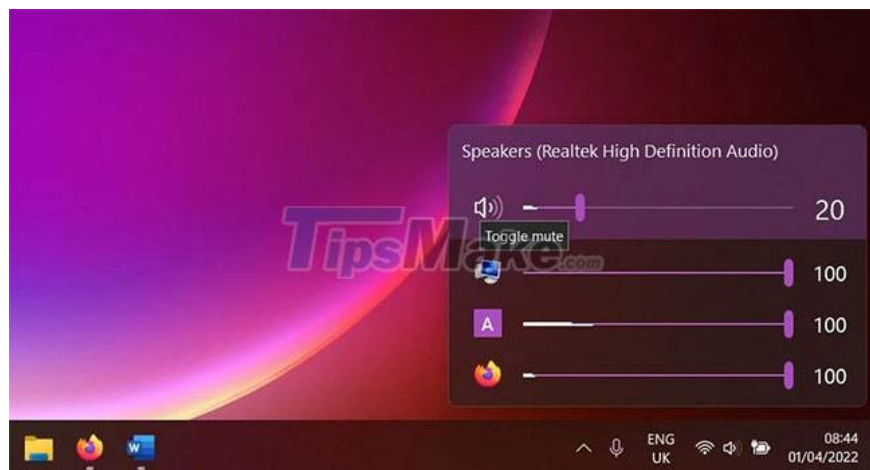


How to use EarTrumpet to adjust the volume of Windows 11

Step 1. Download and install the free EarTrumpet app from the Microsoft Store.

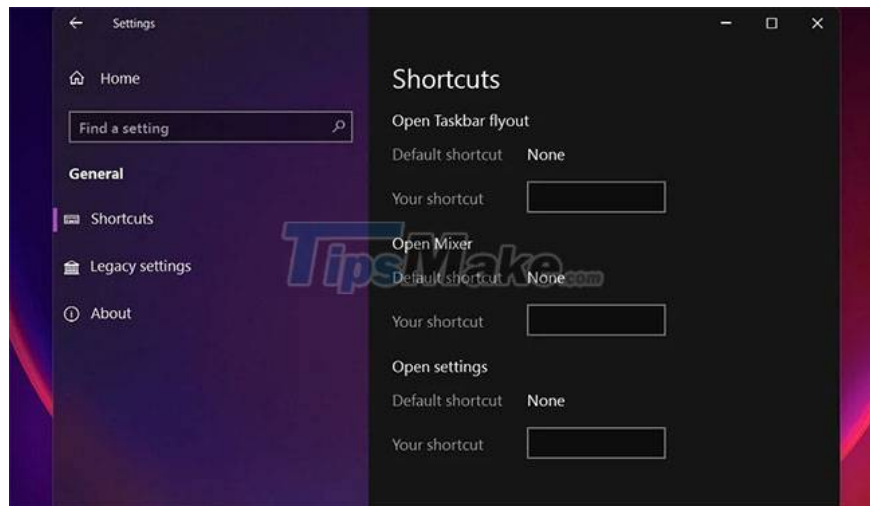
Step 2. Once in the system, find the application on your taskbar. It looks like the sound icon, but provides additional tools.
