

How to use Media Lock to hide files on Windows 10

The Media Lock application helps you hide files on your computer to avoid being viewed by others and is protected by a password range.

In order to keep a few personal files secure on computers or phones, many people choose to install some additional hidden applications. **Media Lock** is a hidden application that hides files on Windows 10, helps you hide videos, audio, document files and images according to each type of file separately. Users can also create individual albums to categorize and manage files when hidden. Password setup application to secure all hidden files and need to enter the correct password when you want to open it. The following article will guide you how to use Media Lock to hide files on Windows 10.

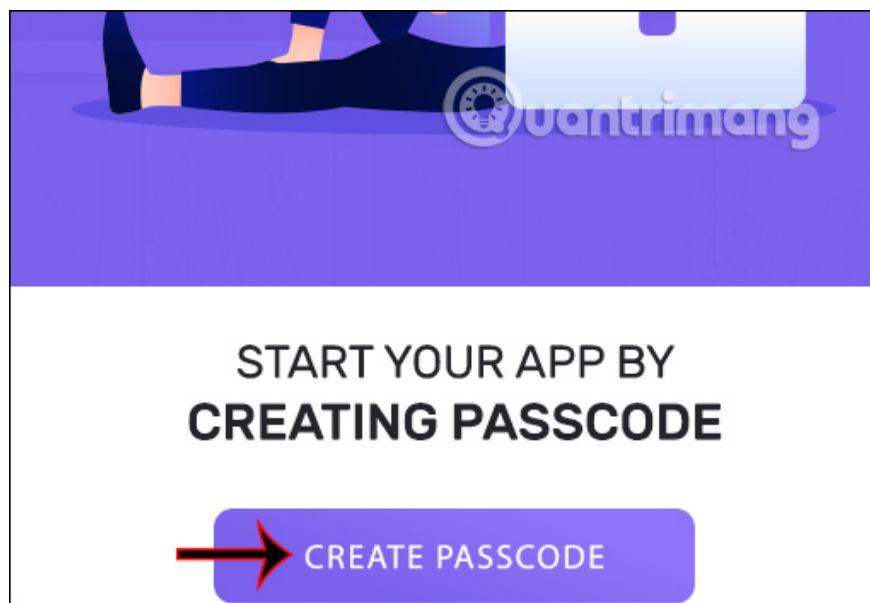
Instructions to hide files on Windows 10

Step 1:

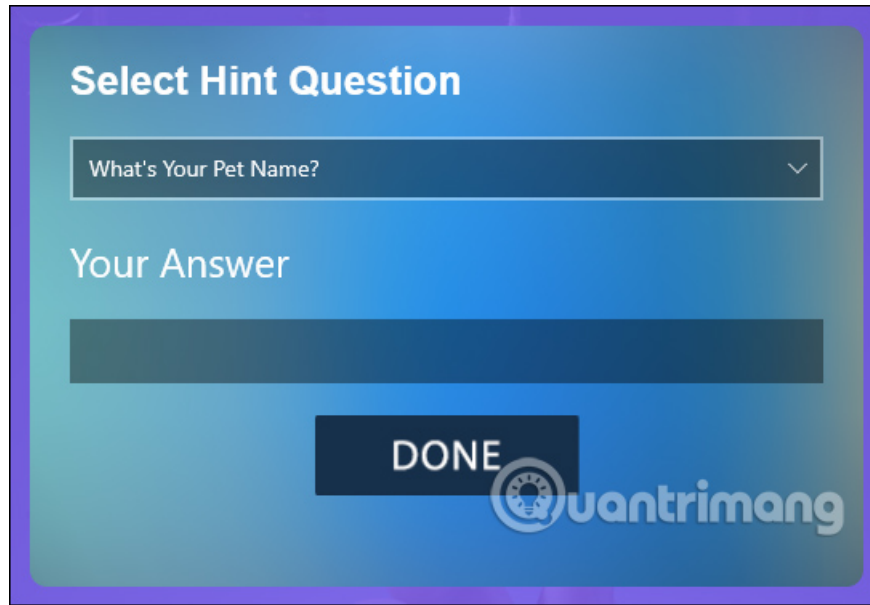
Users download Media Lock application for Windows 10 by following the link below and proceed with the installation as usual.

Download the **Media Lock** Windows 10 application
<https://www.microsoft.com/en-us/p/app/9n0v973z1pt0>

At the interface we **click Create Passcode** to create a password to open the application with 4 digits.



In addition, the application also has a secret question in case you forget your password.



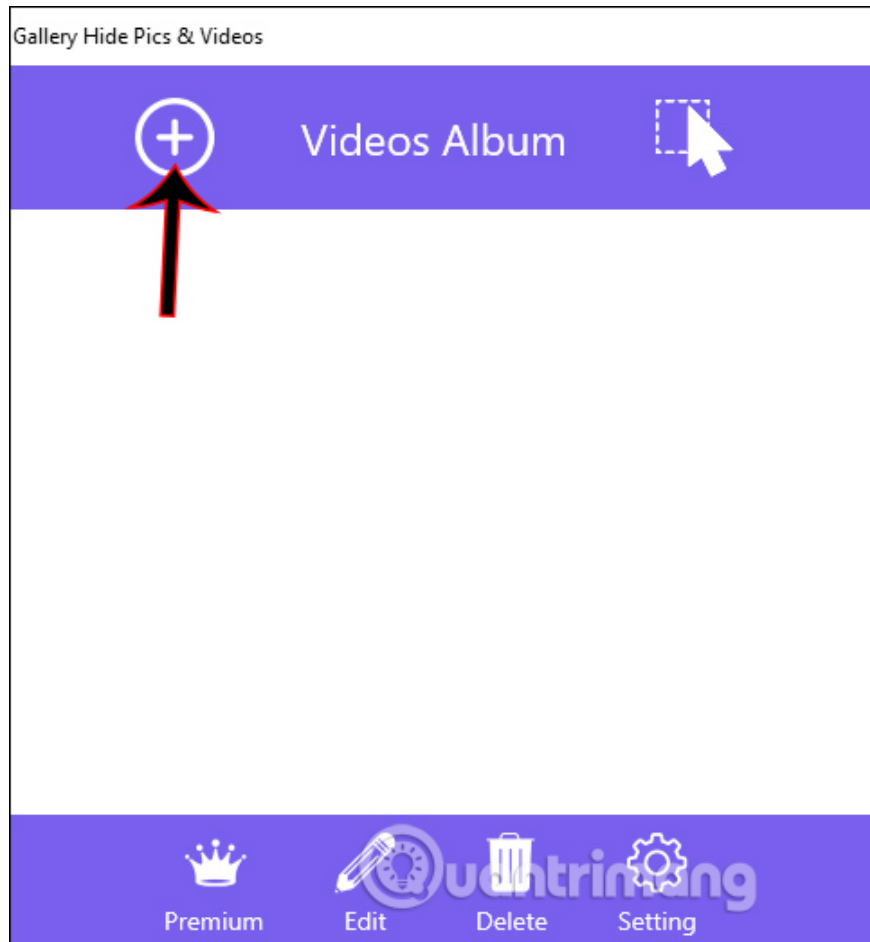
Step 2:

This is the main interface of the application with 4 file types that Media Lock supports to hide on the computer. Click on a file type to proceed offline.



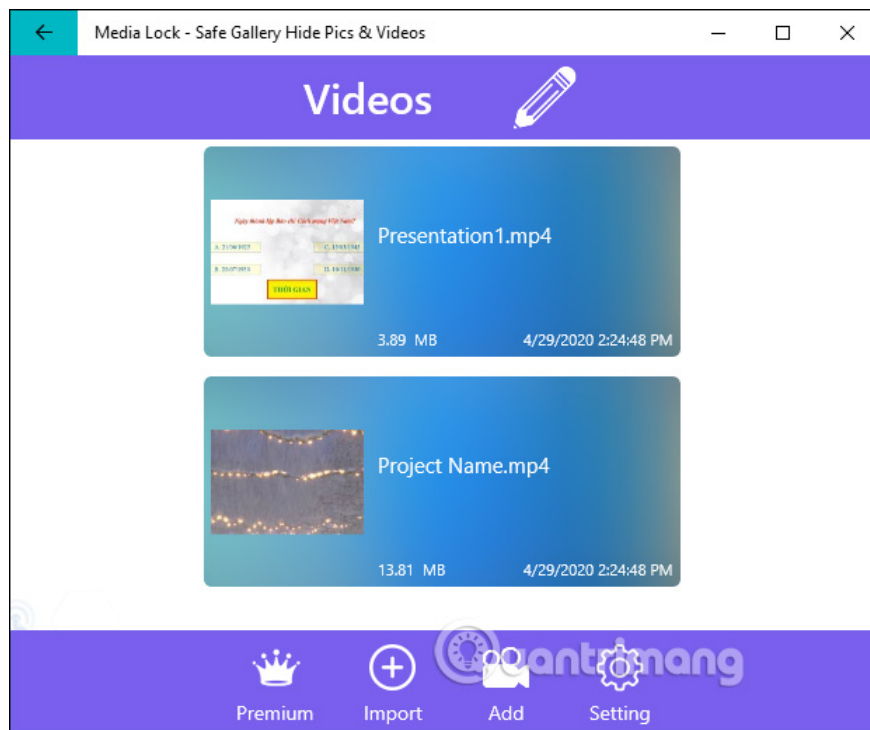
Step 3:

First of all at the user interface click on **the plus icon to proceed to create albums** to save the files you want to hide. Then **click Import** to add the files from the computer to the interface to hide. Media Lock will **ask if you want to delete this file in the root directory** , click Cancel to hold the file or OK to agree.



Step 4:

You continue to perform the above operation with other file types to hide.



Step 5:

To change the application password or delete the content, click **the gear icon** to enter **the setting interface** on the application.
