

How to use separate app sounds on Samsung

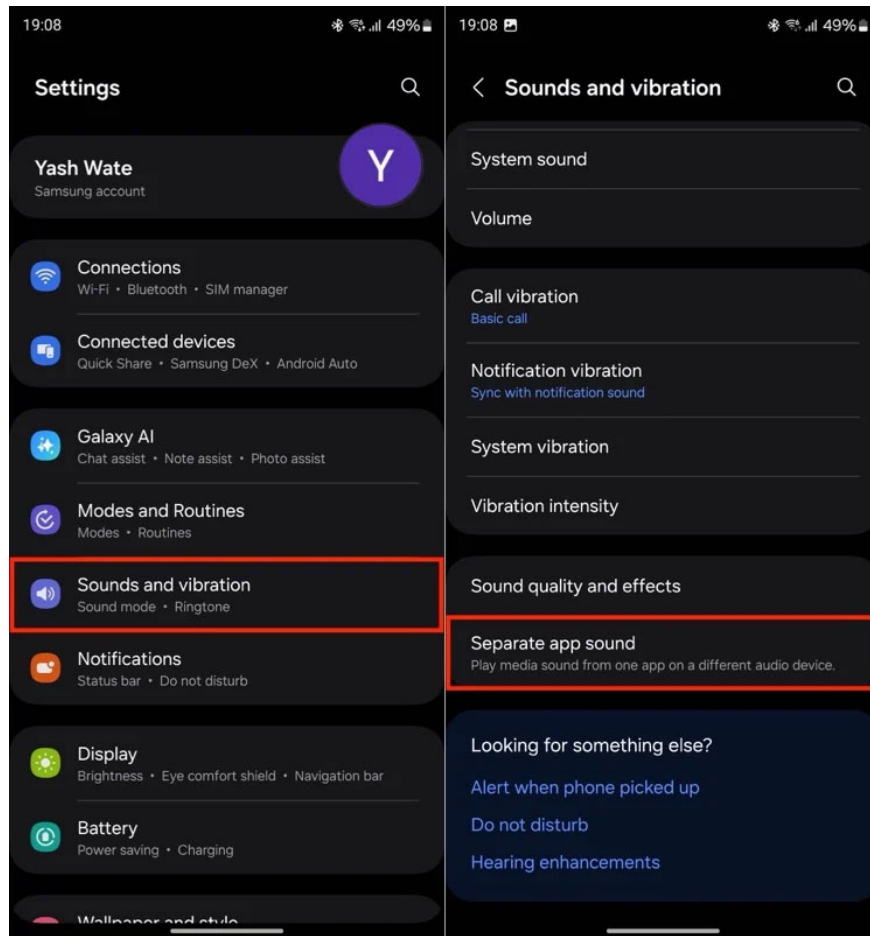
With Samsung phones, you should use the separate app audio feature to avoid this annoyance. For example, you can play Apple Music and your phone will route the audio through your car's speakers.

How to use separate application sounds on Samsung

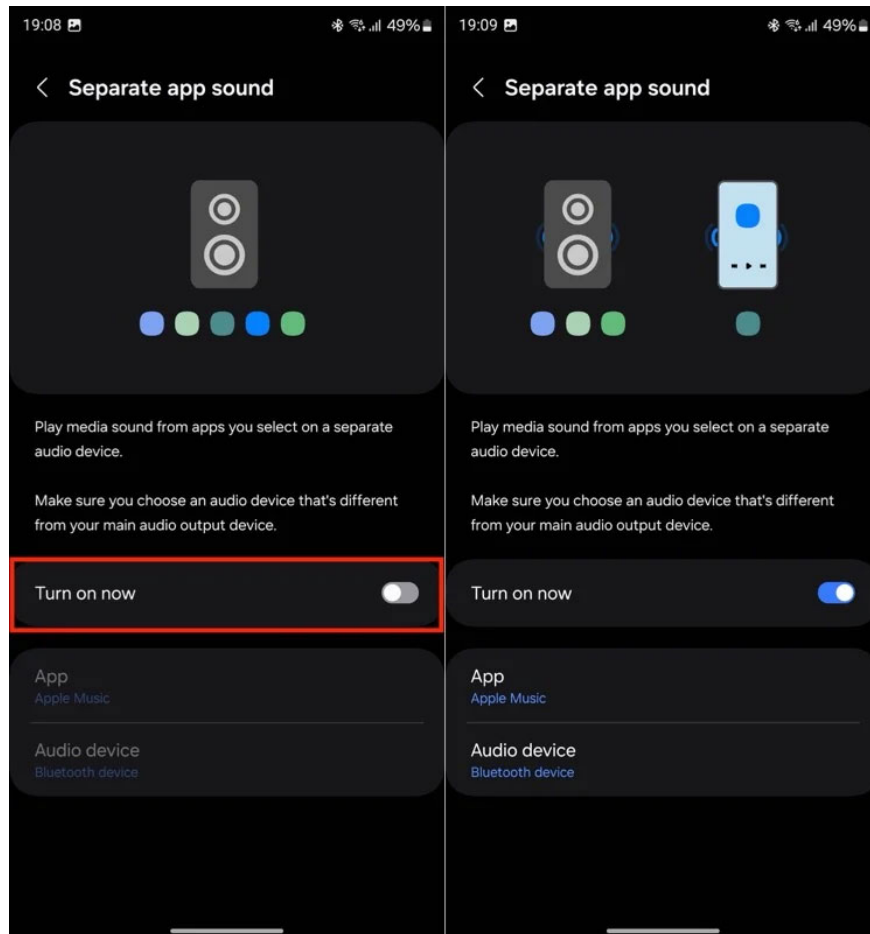
Step 1:

You access **Settings** on your phone and then click on **the Sounds and Vibration setting** . Continue. you select **the Separate App Sound feature** .



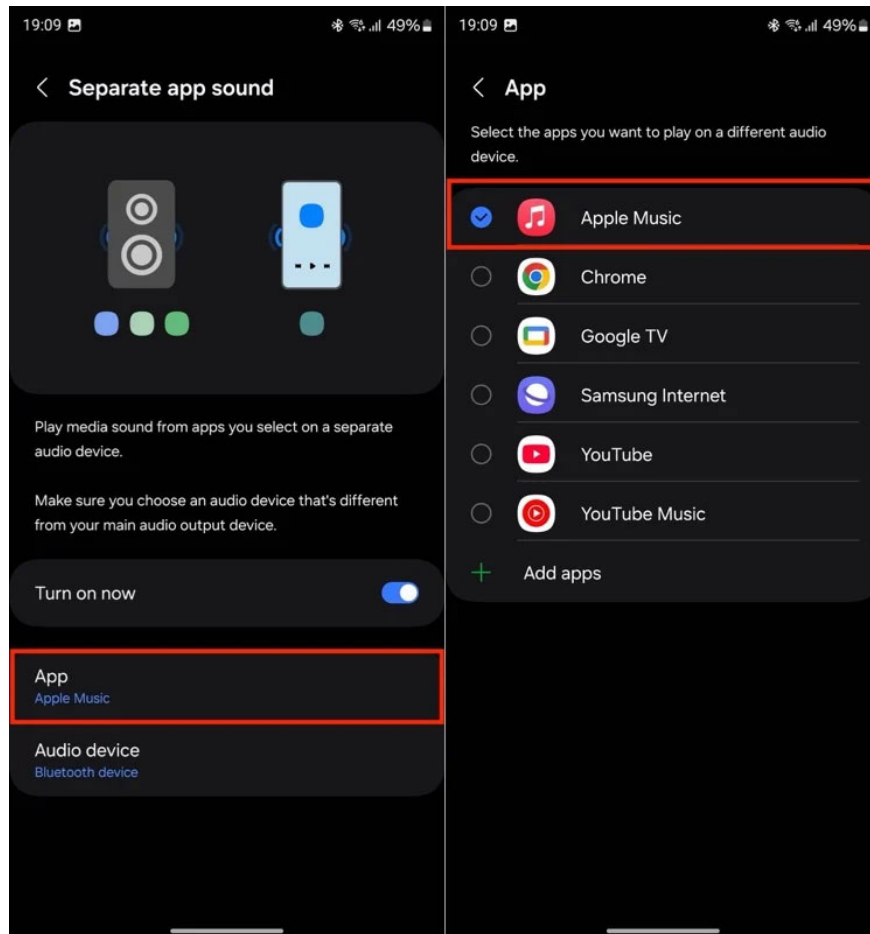
Step 2:

Now you need to enable this feature on your Samsung phone to use it.

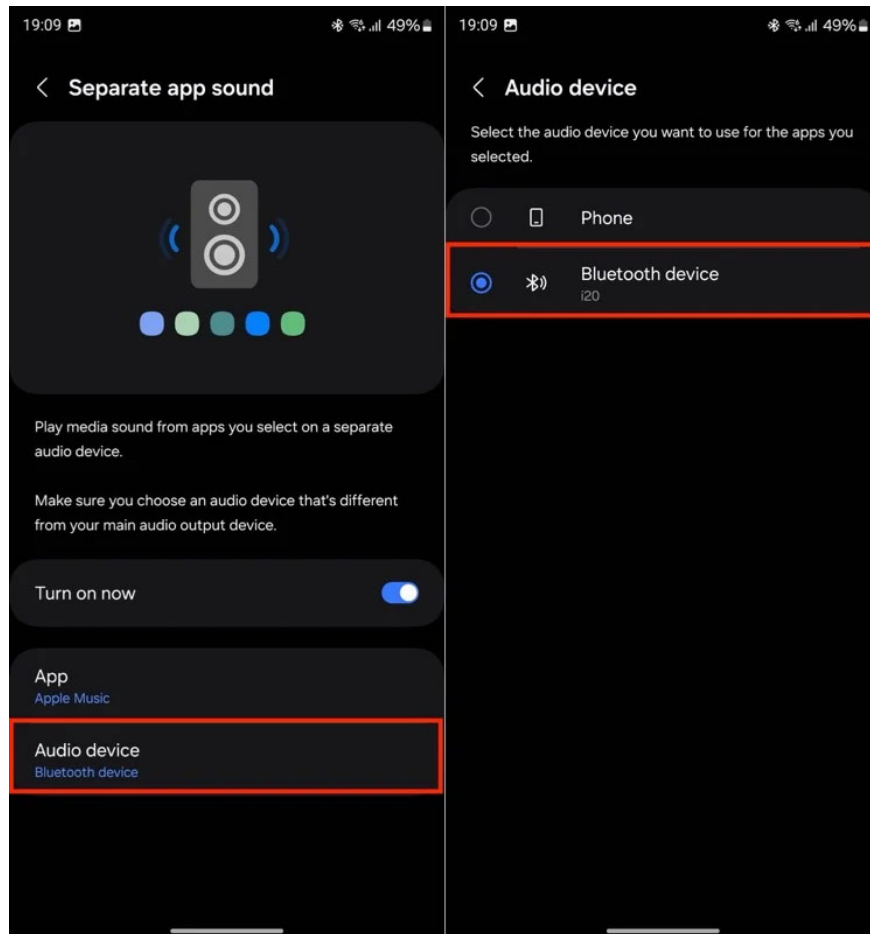


Step 3:

Click on Audio Device then select Bluetooth Device.
