Step 1:

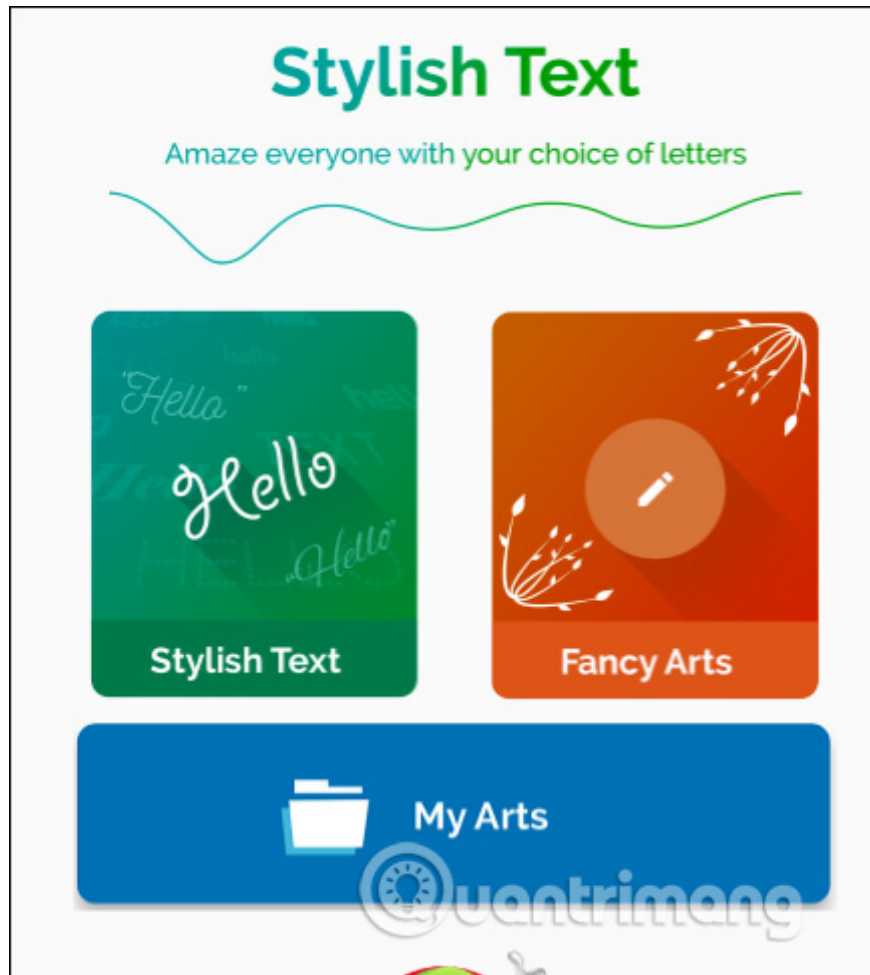
We install the Stylish Text app for Windows 10 by following the link below and proceed with the installation as usual.

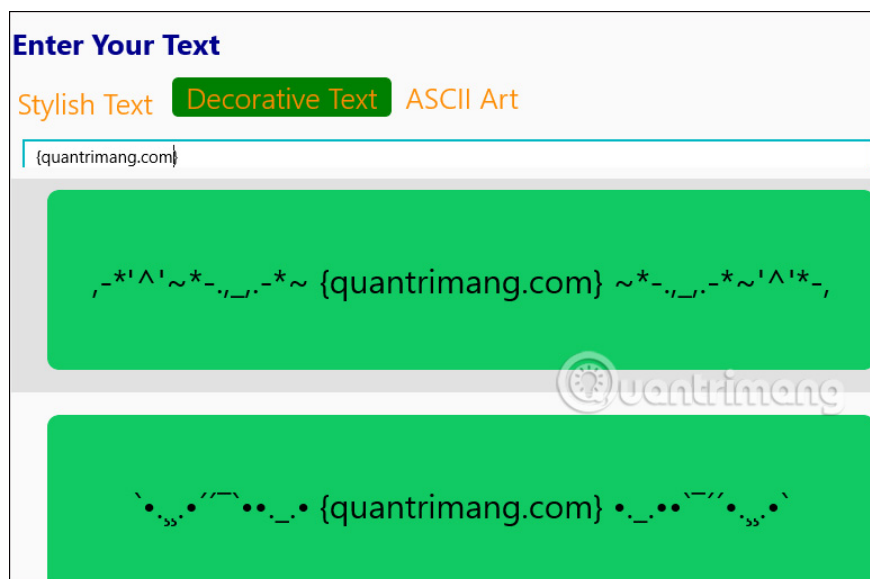
Step 2:

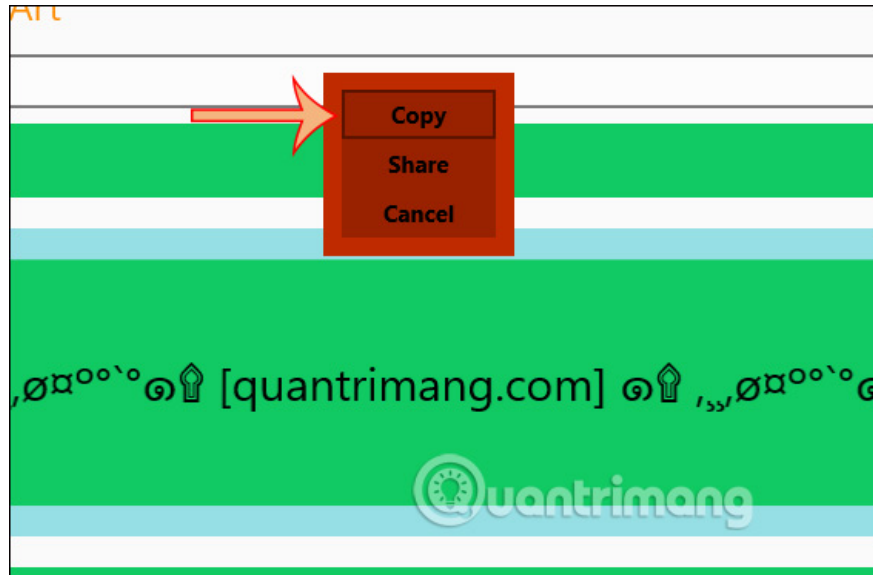
Step 3:

In the Stylish Text section, we will see the typefaces with different font models, including ASCII characters. First we will **enter the content** you want to write, then select the type of font shown below.



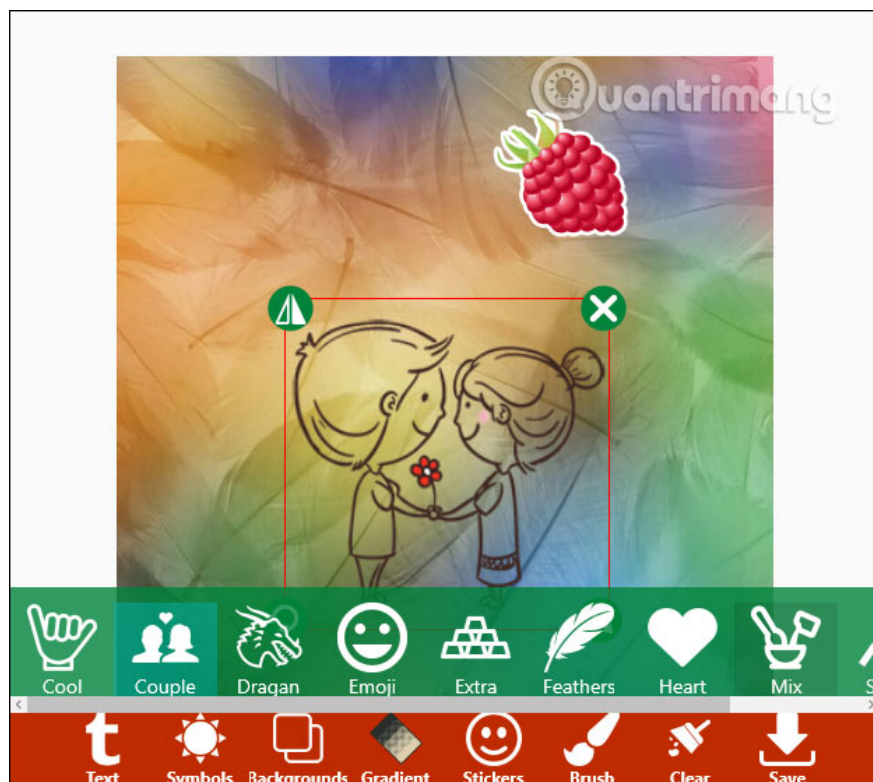
Step 4:
