

How to use the Center Stage feature on iPhone 17 – The selfie camera rotates vertically and horizontally, extremely convenient

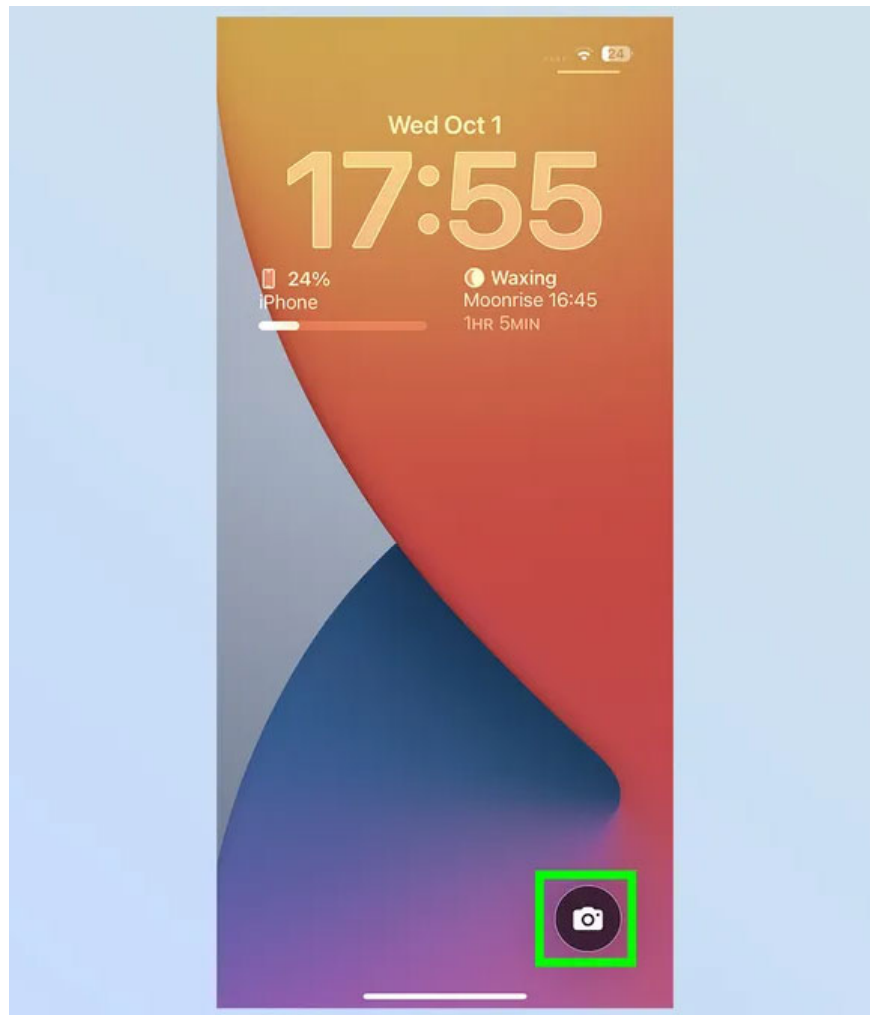
The iPhone 17 is equipped with an 18MP 'Center Stage' selfie camera that allows you to automatically switch between portrait and landscape modes without having to rotate the device. Check out the detailed instructions on how to use this feature to take more beautiful and convenient photos.

The iPhone 17 brings some big changes to the selfie camera, replacing the old 12MP TrueDepth lens with a new 18MP 'Center Stage' camera. 1. Open the Camera app

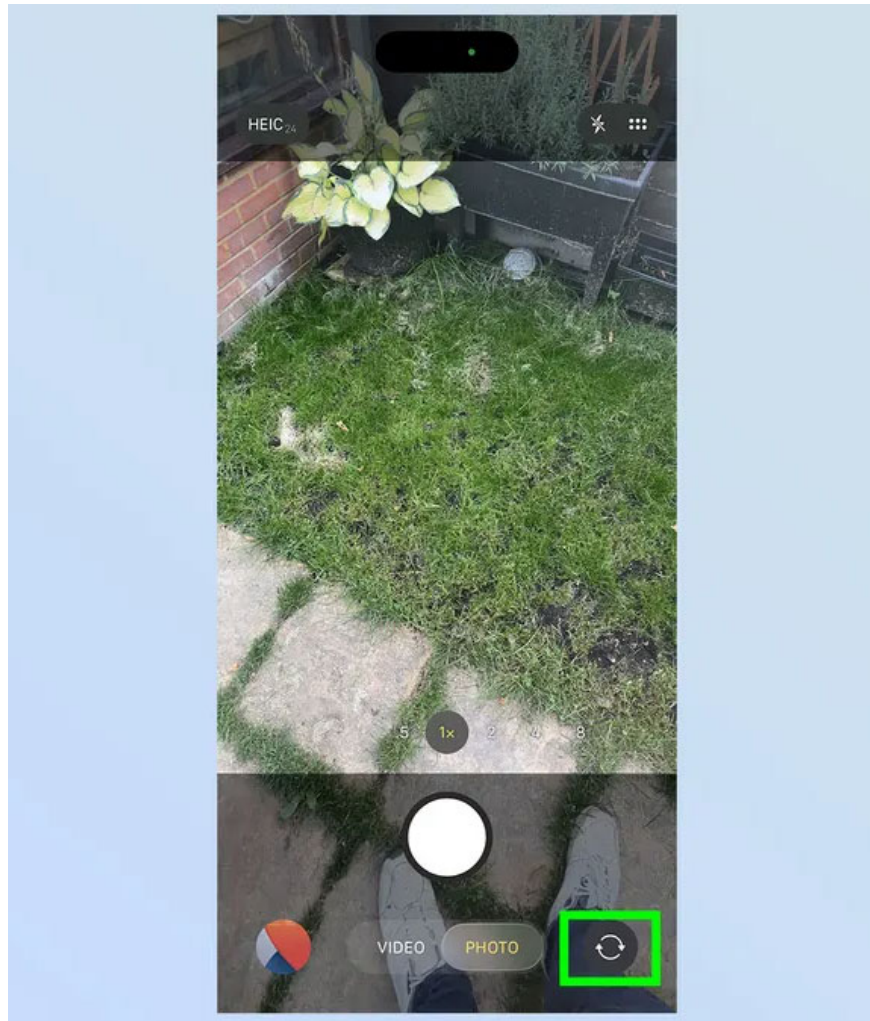


First, open the Camera app in your favorite way:

1. Tap the **Camera** icon on the home screen
2. Tap **Camera Control**
3. Or swipe from **the lock screen** to quickly turn it on

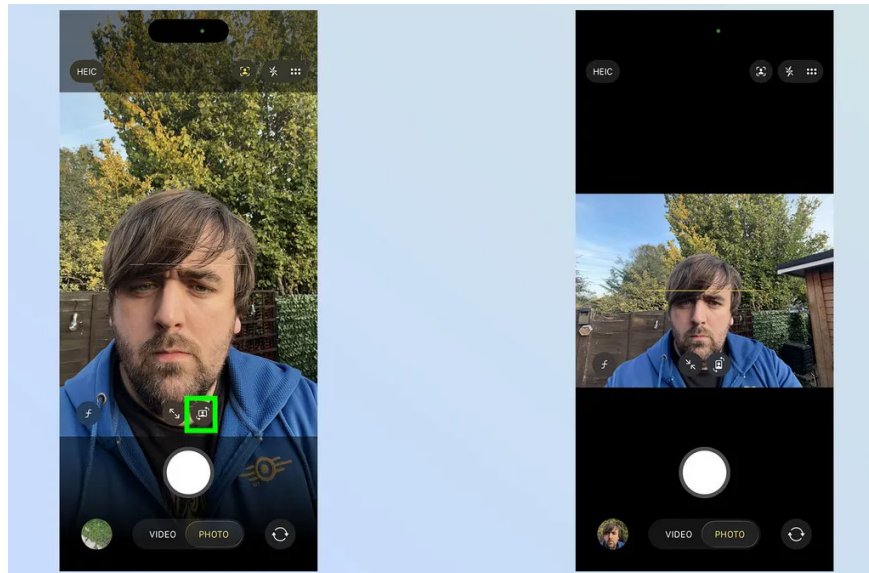
All methods work the same, so you can choose whichever one you like.

2. Switch to front camera



Next, switch to the front camera by tapping **the camera switch icon** in the bottom right corner of the screen.

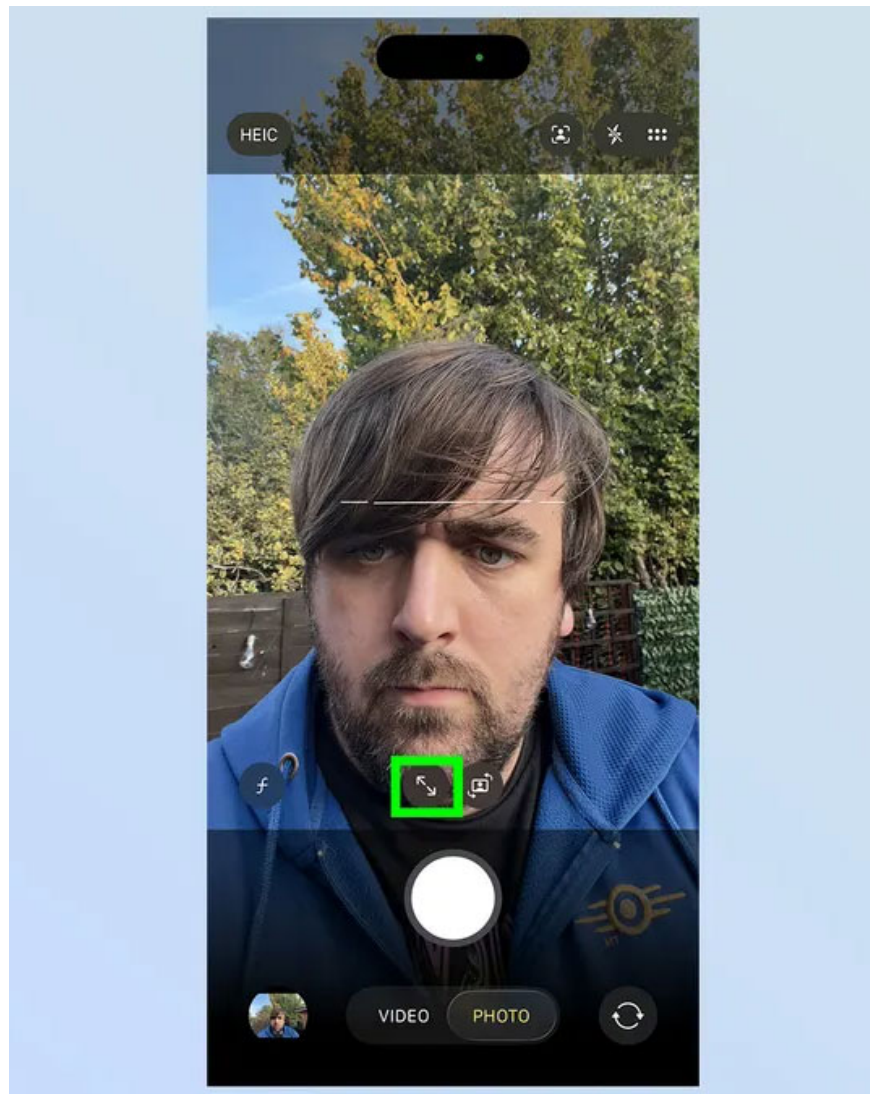
3. Press the Orientation switch



Once the front camera is on, you'll see **the navigation button** located just above the camera shutter button (the large white circle at the bottom of the screen).

Tap it to switch between **portrait** and **landscape mode** , no matter which orientation you're holding your phone.

4. Zoom in/out

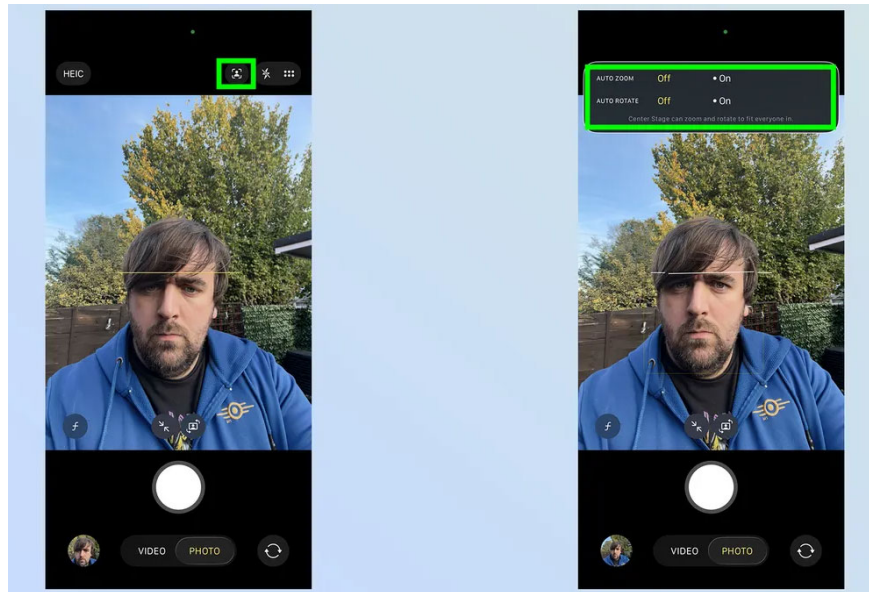


Right next to the navigation button is **the Zoom button** .

It works similarly to the zoom feature on previous iPhones, but **doesn't display a specific zoom parameter** .

1. Click once to **zoom out**
2. Click again to **zoom in**

5. Customize automatic features



Look up at the top corner of the Camera app, next to **the quick settings menu** , and you'll see an icon of **a person in a square** .

Tap it to open the **Center Stage** option .

Here you can enable or disable features:

1. **Auto Zoom**
2. **Auto Rotate**

Note that if you enable these two features, you **won't be able to use the Zoom or Orientation buttons manually** — and conversely, if you adjust manually, the automatic options will be turned off.

The iPhone 17's 'Center Stage' camera is one of those underrated but incredibly useful features .

It gives you **creative freedom to shoot from any angle** , no matter how you hold your phone.

With just a few simple steps, you can take full advantage of the versatility of this new selfie camera.
