

How to use the command to create a Guest account on Windows 10

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If you are facing the problem of sharing a computer or you lend your computer to someone else to use, they can access to view personal data, saved passwords in the browser . or even Lice are interfering with system settings.

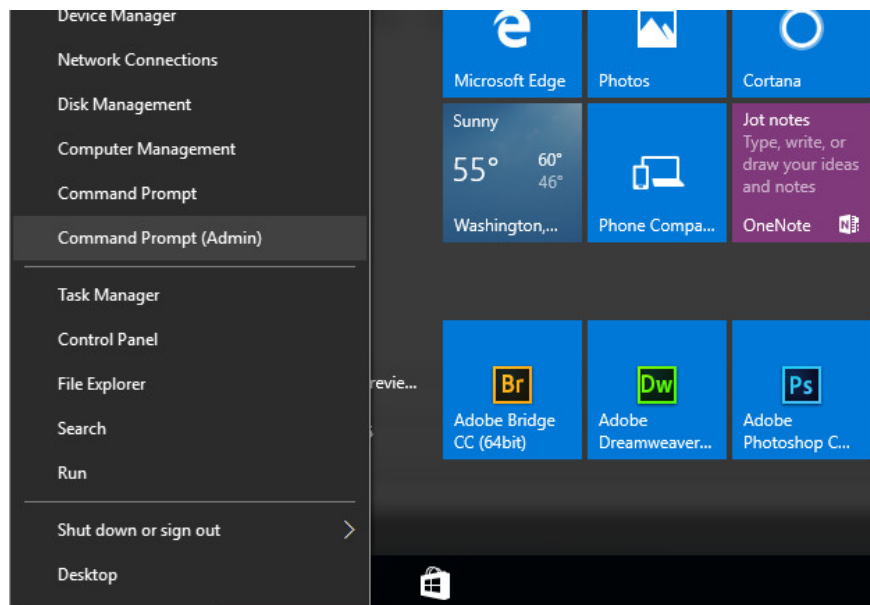
At that time, using the Guest account will be the best solution for you. Guest account users can only use everything available that cannot interfere with any data or settings on the system. So you no longer have to worry about personal data security on your computer.

In the following article, the network administrator will show you **how to create a Guest account on Windows 10 using the Command Prompt command** .

Steps to create a Guest account on Windows 10


1. First, you must open the Command prompt under Admin. To do this, press the **Windows + X** key combination to open **Power User Menu** , then click **Command Prompt (Admin)** from the menu.



2. If the dialog box that appears includes a message asking if you want to allow the application to change on the device (Do you want to allow this app to make changes to your device?). Click **Yes** to continue.
3. On the Command Prompt window, enter the command below and press Enter:

```
net user Visitor / add / active: yes
```

This is to create a **Guest** account called **Visitor** .



```
Administrator: Command Prompt
Microsoft Windows [Version 10.0.14393]
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
C:\WINDOWS\system32>net user Visitor /add /active:yes
The command completed successfully.

C:\WINDOWS\system32>
```

4. Enter the following command into the Command Prompt window and press twice when asked for a password.

```
Visitor net user *
```

This is to create a blank password for the Visitor account.



```

The command completed successfully.


C:\WINDOWS\system32>net user Visitor *
Type a password for the user:
Retype the password to confirm:
The command completed successfully.

C:\WINDOWS\system32>
```

5. Now that a Guest account named Visitor has been created, this account has the same permissions as other user accounts. So the next step is to move this account to the Guest account group. To do this, you must first **delete the Visitor account** from the Users account group, then "move" to the Visitor account group.

To delete the visitor account, enter the following command into the Command Prompt window:

net localgroup users Visitor / delete



```
Administrator: Command Prompt
Microsoft Windows [Version 10.0.14393]
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C:\WINDOWS\system32>net user Visitor /add /active:yes
The command completed successfully.


C:\WINDOWS\system32>net user Visitor *
Type a password for the user:
Retype the password to confirm:
The command completed successfully.

C:\WINDOWS\system32>net localgroup users Visitor /delete
The command completed successfully.

C:\WINDOWS\system32>_
```

6. Next enter the following command to add this user account and the Guest account group:

net localgroup guests Visitor / add



```
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C:\WINDOWS\system32>net user Visitor /add /active:yes
The command completed successfully.

C:\WINDOWS\system32>net user Visitor *
Type a password for the user:
Retype the password to confirm:
The command completed successfully.

C:\WINDOWS\system32>net localgroup users Visitor /delete
The command completed successfully.

C:\WINDOWS\system32>net localgroup guests Visitor /add
The command completed successfully.

C:\WINDOWS\system32>_
```

7. Finally, close the Command Prompt window by clicking the **X** icon in the top right corner or entering the "exit" command into the Command Prompt window and pressing **Enter** .

```
Administrator: Command Prompt
Microsoft Windows [Version 10.0.14393]
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C:\WINDOWS\system32>net user Visitor /add /active:yes
The command completed successfully.

C:\WINDOWS\system32>net user Visitor *
Type a password for the user:
Retype the password to confirm:
The command completed successfully.

C:\WINDOWS\system32>net localgroup users Visitor /delete
The command completed successfully.

C:\WINDOWS\system32>net localgroup guests Visitor /add
The command completed successfully.

C:\WINDOWS\system32>exit
```

8. You can now switch to the Guest account to use if others ask to borrow your computer to use.
