

How to use the shortcut key to reset the video card quickly

How to use the simple video card reset shortcut key, helping you operate in the fastest way.

Is your Windows computer crashing due to a faulty graphics card? A quick fix is to reset the graphics card in your computer, which includes a keyboard shortcut, but there are other ways to fix the problem. Let's discuss the graphics card **reset shortcut** and other ways to fix it .

What is video card reset?

For those who regularly use computers, the video card, also known as the graphics card, is certainly no stranger. This is the part that helps handle all tasks related to speed, graphics. and all operations that users frequently use during use.



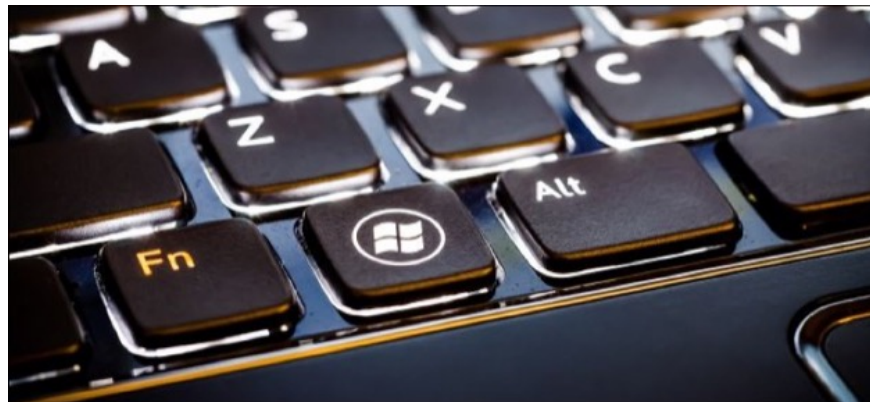
If you only handle simple tasks such as watching videos, typing words or using the internet, the video card will still work well. But if you want to use more software with heavy configuration such as graphic design, playing games. the computer will lag and stop working. At that time, resetting the video card will help the computer work quickly depending on each case.

How to restart the video card quickly

Restart video card with shortcut key

This is the most popular solution used by users. With easy and effective operations. Users when encountering a case of computer lag will use this method.

The most commonly used shortcut key combination to **reset the video card** is Windows + Ctrl + Shift + B. To use it, users just need to press the combination of 4 keys at the same time, the black flashing phenomenon will appear on the screen. In addition, the device will emit a small 'beep' sound. After finishing, your screen will start working again and the operation will become smoother.



Note: Using the key combination to reset the video card only applies to computers using Windows 8 or higher operating systems.

Restart

Press Ctrl + Alt + Del and wait a few seconds. The screen will turn black or blue depending on your previous settings. Press the power button on the bottom right and select the Restart option. This will restart your computer immediately, but you may lose any open and unsaved work. Alternatively, you can press and hold the power button to initiate a hard reboot or force a reboot.

Restart Graphics Card

Regular gamers know the drill all too well. A quick way to reboot your graphics card is to press the Windows key + Ctrl + Shift + B shortcut. This will only reboot your graphics card but will not close any open applications or games. The screen will go black for a moment and you may hear a beep but that's it. The shortcut works for all graphics cards from AMD, NVIDIA, and even Intel.

Turn off the separate VGA if available

If your computer has a separate **VGA and your CPU** supports graphics, you can try to disable 1 of the 2. You also go to the Device Manager above and disable 1 of the 2. If you disable the separate VGA and the computer works normally, then it is possible that the separate VGA is damaged.



Task processing

If your computer has used **the video card reset shortcut key** and the video card reset buttons but still cannot fix it, you must immediately apply the task processing procedure. Below are 2 basic tasks for users to refer to and perform as follows:

Open the Task Manager app to find the app that is launching and causing your device to have problems by pressing Ctrl + Shift + Esc. Navigate to the problematic app to deal with it by pressing Alt + Tab or Windows + Tab.

One note when using this method is that the shortcut key combination should only be used in cases where your application has not shown signs of being completely frozen.

Conclude

If you have tried every **way to reset the video card** but it has not been successful, you can try reinstalling Windows. If this method still cannot help you fix the problem of freezing, freezing, and lagging due to the network card, take your computer to a reputable repair facility or warranty center to fix it.
