

# How to use ThreatSlayer to block malicious websites on Chrome

The ThreatSlayer utility helps users to browse the web on Chrome browser from malicious websites, websites that can attack your computer with software or ads containing malicious content.

The ThreatSlayer utility will evaluate each website a user visits, immediately notify if the site has problems and block them. Here are details on how to use the ThreatSlayer extension to block malicious websites on Chrome.

## Instructions for using the ThreatSlayer utility to block malicious websites

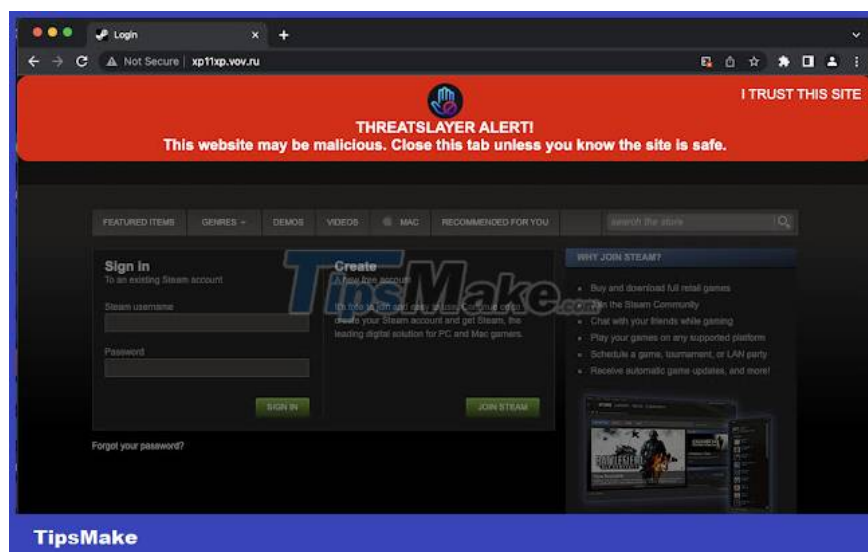
### Step 1:

First, users will install the ThreatSlayer utility for Chrome browser according to the link below and then install it as usual.

### Step 2:

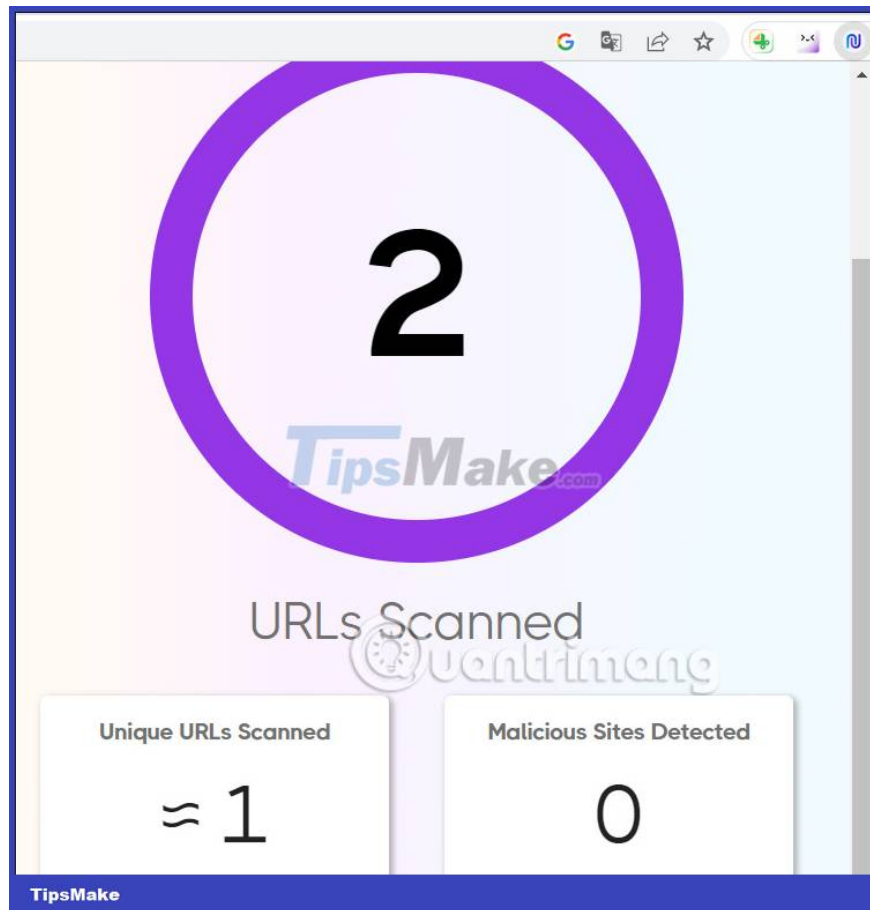
After we successfully install the ThreatSlayer utility, you do not need to do any action. The utility automatically checks each website that we visit. Websites that the utility checks will all undergo a rigorous inspection process, thereby detecting browser-based threats, phishing, .

If the site has problems, users will see a message like the image below.



### Step 3:

In addition, when clicking on the ThreatSlayer utility icon on the browser address bar, the user will see the total number of URLs scanned and how many malicious websites have been detected and shown in the Malicious Sites Detected section.
