

How to use uTorrent Web to download torrents in the browser

uTorrent Web is a browser torrent download tool like Chrome, Firefox, Microsoft Edge, Opera ...

To download torrent files, you can choose from a variety of torrent download tools like uTorrent, BitTorrent, etc. Recently, BitTorrent has officially released uTorrent Web tool, which supports torrent downloads on popular web browsers like Chrome. , Firefox, Microsoft Edge, Opera . Especially when the user has turned off the web browser, the tool will continue to download the file. The tool basically works via the WebUI interface on the browser, reducing the resources used on the system when dragging the torrent file to download. The following article will guide you how to use the uTorrent Web tool to download torrent files.

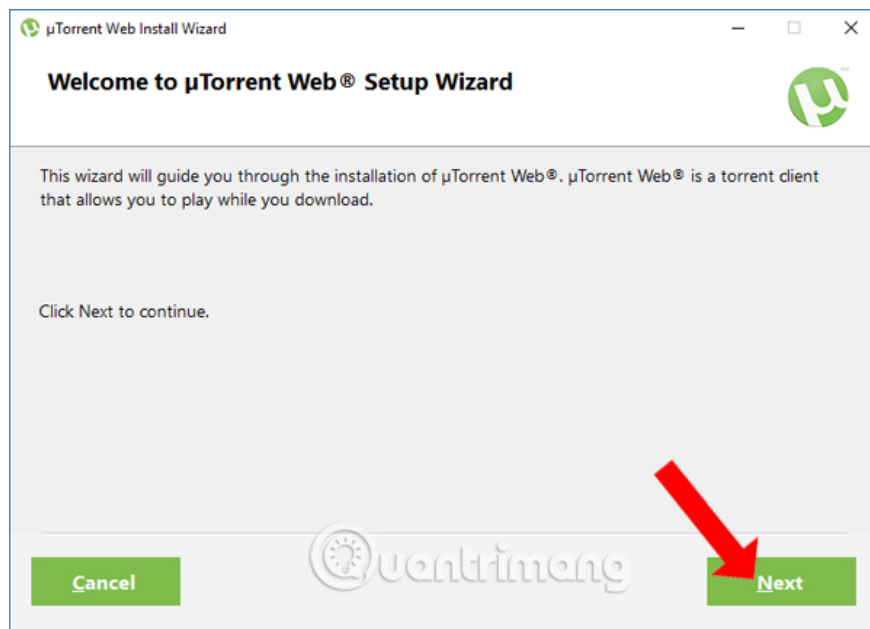
Instructions for downloading torrent using uTorrent Web

Step 1:

Users click on the link below to install the uTorrent Web tool on their computer.

1. <https://www.utorrent.com/utweb-index>

Click on the download file and proceed with the installation as usual. In the first interface click Next to continue.



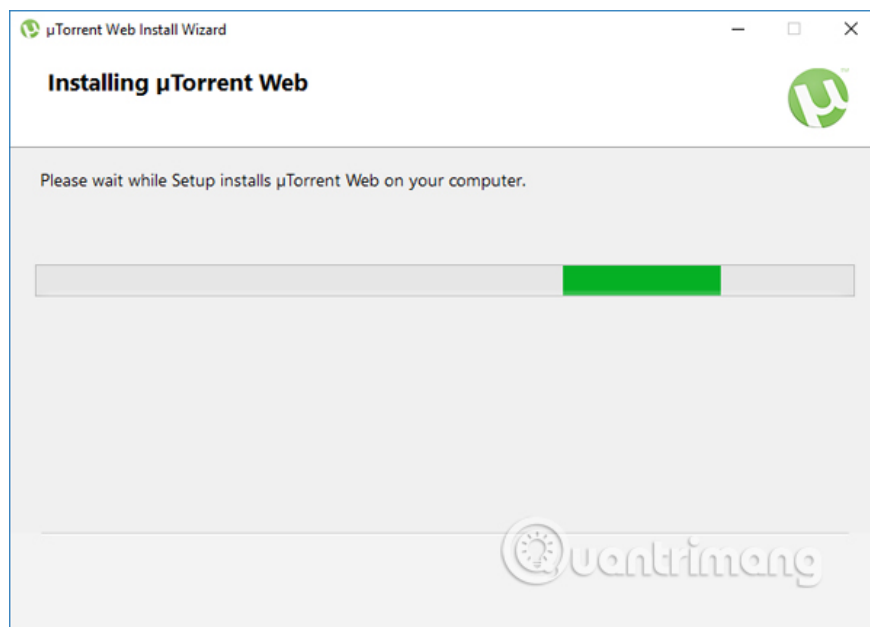
Note in the process of installing the tool, you will see the interface suggest installing antivirus program, removing the check mark at By accepting this offer, you agree to Adware Antivirus Free . Click Next to continue.



Continue to **press Decline** on the suggested interface and install the second Avast Free Antivirus software.



Finally we wait for the uTorrent Web installation process to complete.

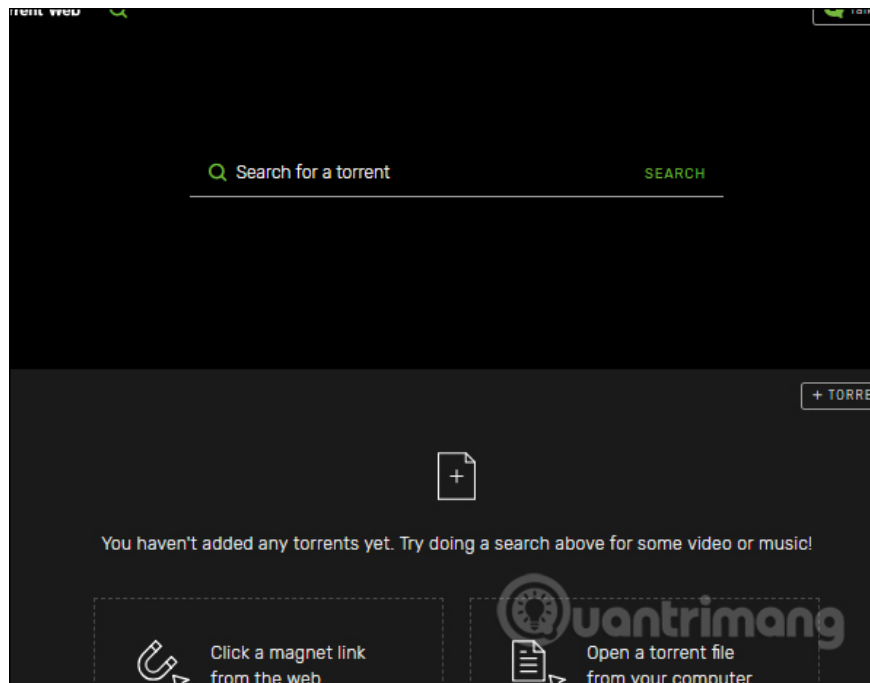


Step 2:

After installation is complete, we will see the software automatically run in the background and displayed in the system tray.

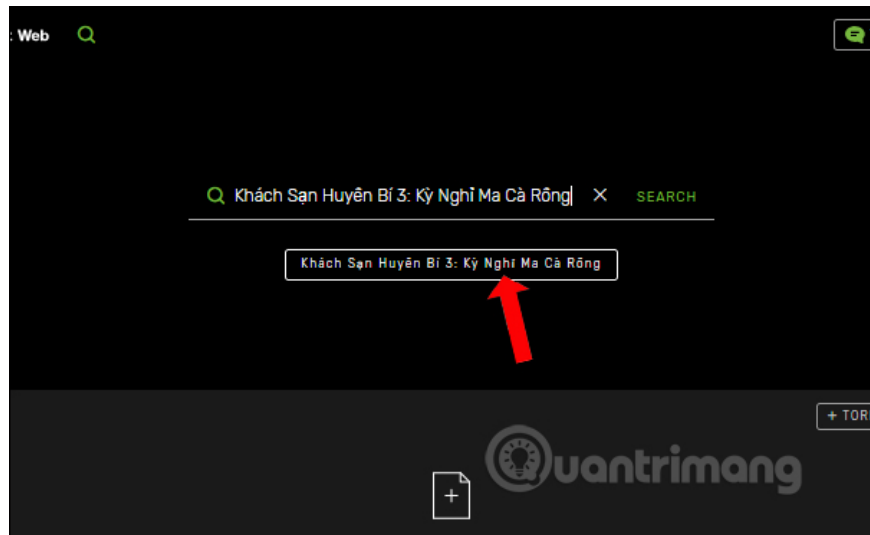


The uTorrent Web web interface will now open on the system's default browser with the interface shown below. If the service requires you to install the Browser Safety extension, skip the request.

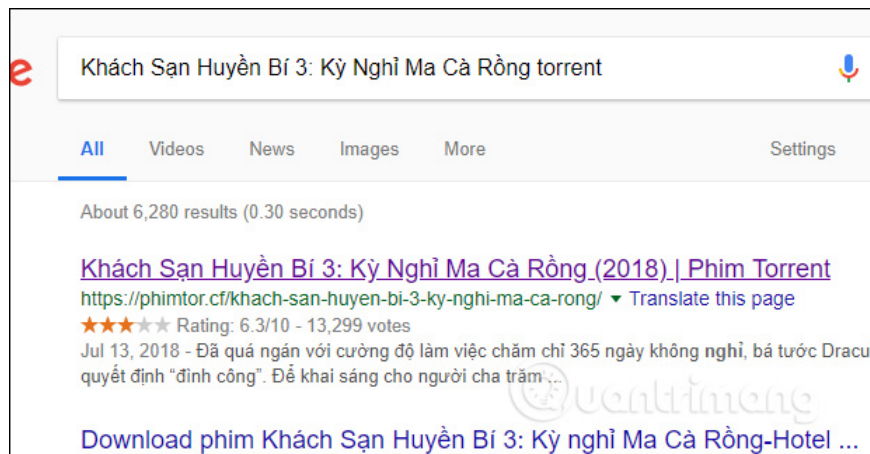


Step 3:

With **the search bar** on the same interface, users can enter the torrent file name into the Search for a torrent box, then press Enter. Click on the name displayed below the search box.

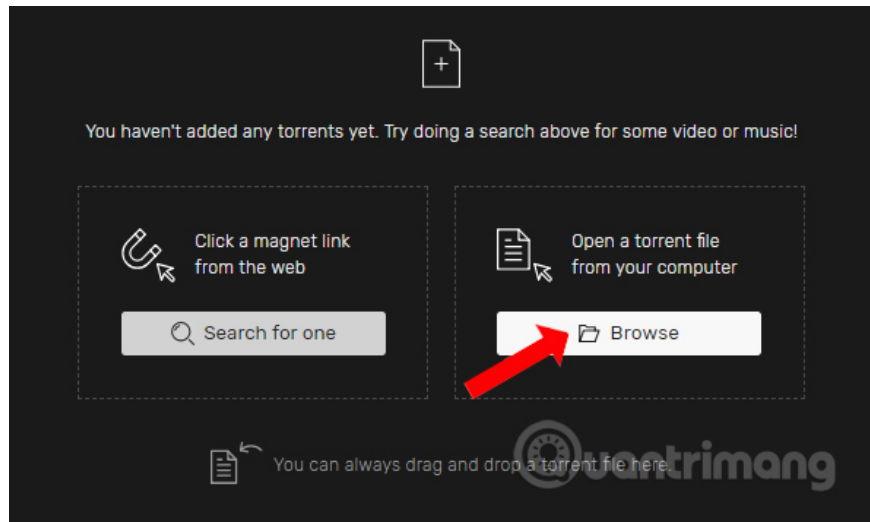


Search results will appear on Google for you to copy the link magnet or download torrent files.



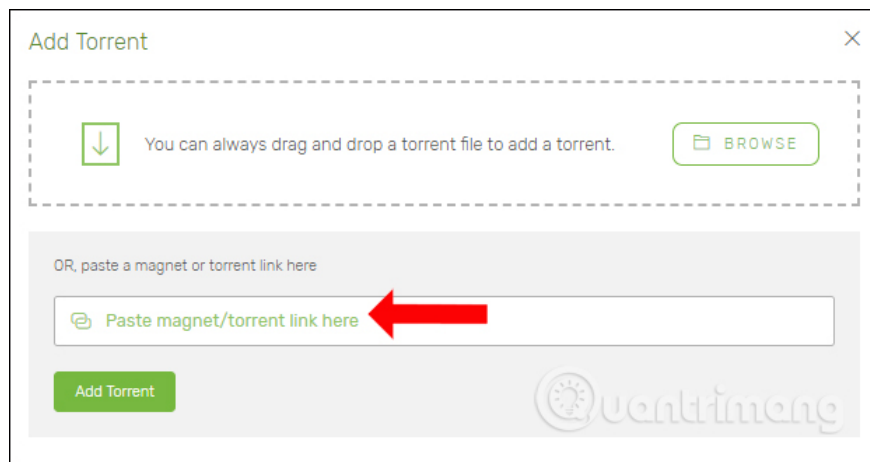
Step 4:

In case the user already has a torrent file on the computer, we just need to drag and drop the file into the interface. Or click the Browse button to open the folder containing torrent files.

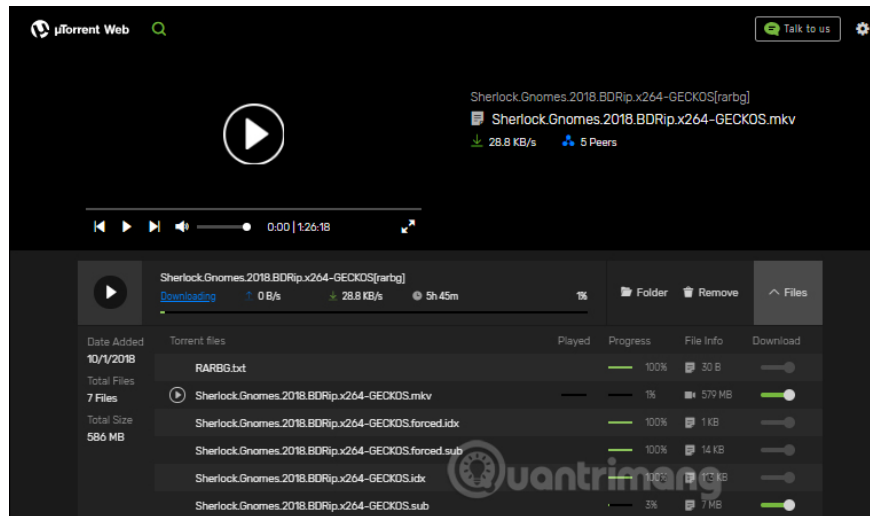


Step 5:

To paste the magnet link of the selected file into + **Torrent** . Display Add Torrent interface and **paste the link to Paste magnet / torrent link here** and click **Add Torrent** to download.



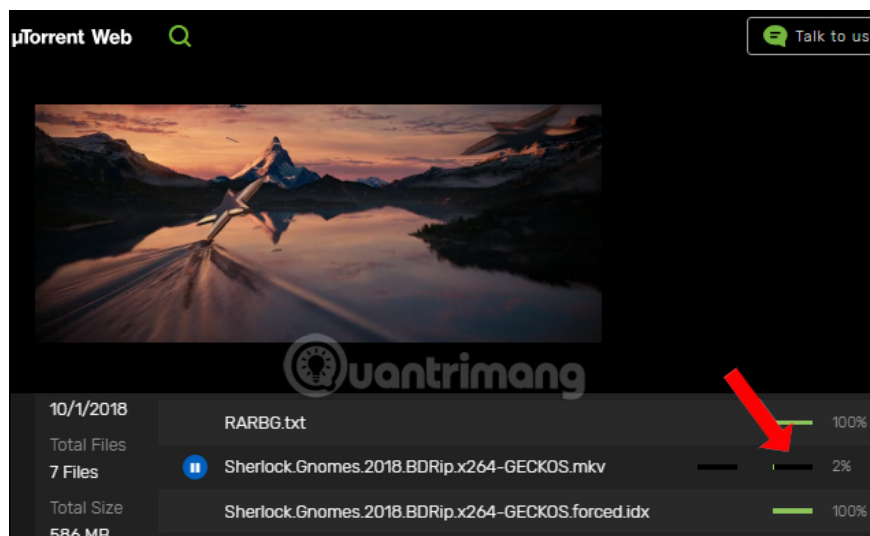
The torrent download process will proceed shortly. In the interface click the Files button to see the download status of each file, if it contains many files. Or pause the download for the file by pushing the horizontal bar to the left at Download.



Step 6:

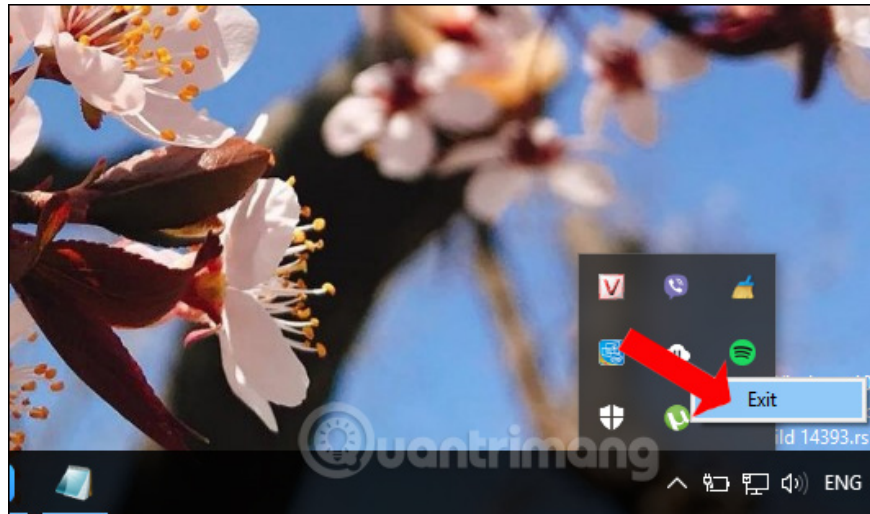
Also at this interface, users can view the video content of the file being downloaded on uTorrent Web. The content of the video will display corresponding to the % load shown in the **Progress status bar**.

The video playback speed as well as the video quality will depend on the downloaded capacity, network speed, the number of machines with the full copy of the file and uploading it.



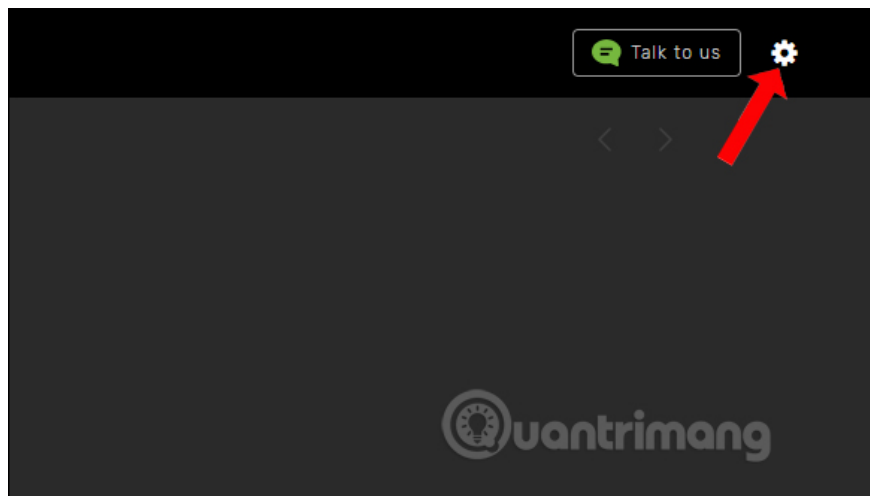
Step 7:

During the download process you can completely exit the browser run by uTorrent Web in the system. To reopen, simply click the uTorrent Web icon in the system tray. If you want to pause the download process, right-click the icon and select **Exit**.



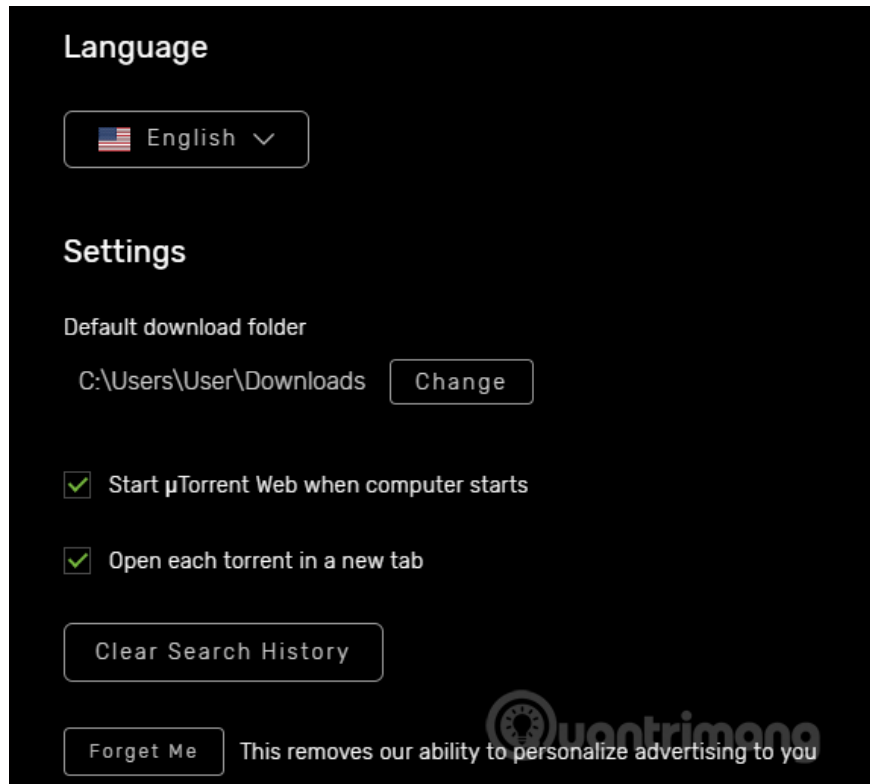
Step 8:

To customize uTorrent Web settings, in the interface click on **the gear icon** in the right corner of the interface.



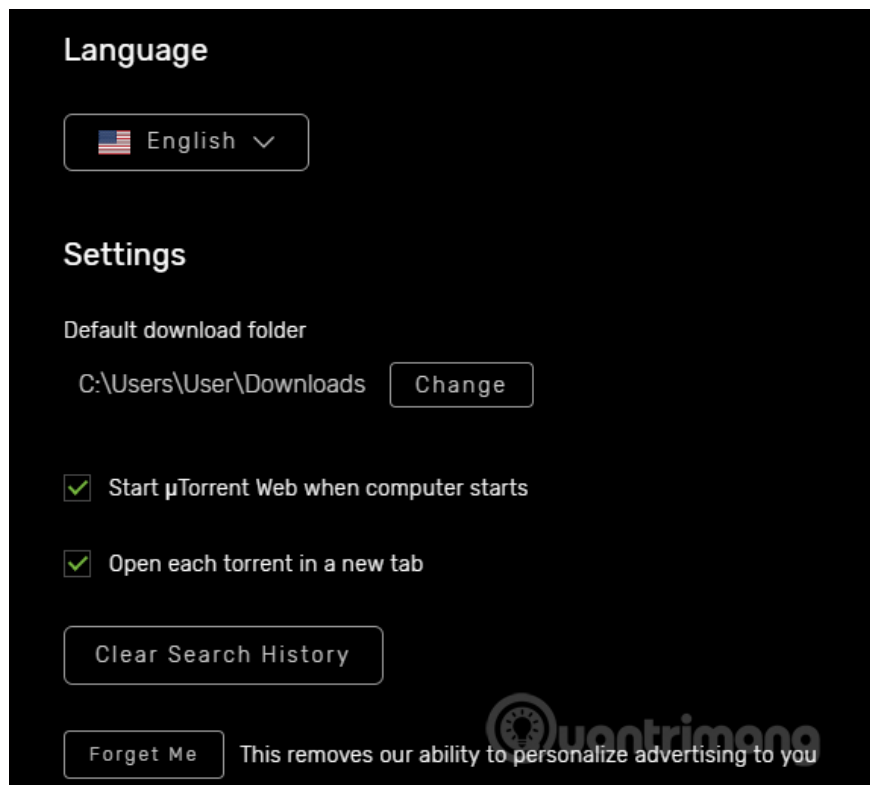
In the basic setup interface, there will be changes to settings including:

1. Language: Change the interface language. By default, English will be used.
2. Default download folder: Click Change to change the location for the downloaded file. Default Downloads folder.
3. Start uTorrent Web when computer starts: Default uTorrent Web starts with Windows.
4. Open each tab in a new torrent: Uncheck if you don't want the browser to open a new tab when downloading a new torrent.
5. Clear search history: Clear search history.



Scrolling down to the **Advanced Settings** section will have 2 more options:

1. uTorrent Web is your default torrent client: Using uTorrent Web is the client to download the default torrent.
2. Manage Bandwidth: Set download / upload speeds on uTorrent Web.



Above is how to use the uTorrent Web tool to download torrents on current popular web browsers. The tool will not take up much system space to pull torrents, due to the use of the web interface to download. uTorrent Web will be integrated with the default web browser on Windows.
